This is an exclusive interview with Pastor. Bennet Christopher, who was born into a Christian family as the son of a church pastor and was raised in devotion to God from a young age. Yet, in his youth, he fell into an obsession with cricket, only to be set apart by God for His purposes. Today, he lifts the name of the Lord high through songs and worship, many of which he received as divine inspiration.

Could you share about yourself and your early childhood?

I was born into a Christian family in the Coimbatore district as the son of a church pastor. Our family consisted of my father, mother, younger brother, and me. When I was just a year and a half old, a life-threatening incident occurred. While I was drinking milk, it accidentally entered my nasal passage, blocking both my nose and mouth, and I stopped breathing. For five minutes, I was completely without breath. During that critical moment, my mother prayed fervently, saying, "Lord, if You give my son his life back, I will dedicate him for Your service." Graciously, God restored my life, and from that moment, I was raised with a deep commitment to serve Him.

I grew up on a church campus, surrounded by a community that nurtured my faith. The campus also housed an orphanage with 35 boys, who became my playmates. My childhood was filled with joy, enriched by the love

of my family and the bond I shared with these friends. Being the son of a pastor, I was brought up with a strong foundation in devotion to God, which shaped my early years profoundly.

After being dedicated to ministry as a child, how did your studies go?

From a young age, I was a diligent student, consistently excelling in academics and ranking first in my class. However, because my parents had already dedicated me to ministry, they were wary of celebrating my achievements, fearing I might pursue a career instead of following God's call. Even when I scored perfect marks, there was no applause or encouragement from them. This lack of appreciation deeply saddened me, to the point where I hesitated to show my progress reports to them. Yet, by God's grace, I remained steadfast in my studies, and He blessed my efforts abundantly.

What did you do when, despite being a bright student, you didn't receive appreciation from your parents?

At that time, my focus shifted to cricket. I discovered my talent for the sport and became so passionate about it that I behaved like a fanatic. I would sleep with my bat by my side and even carry it to shops. I idolized

Sachin Tendulkar to the extent that if someone spoke ill of him, I was ready to pick a fight. My obsession was that intense. Seeing my growing interest in cricket, my parents became increasingly anxious, fearing I might abandon ministry. By the time I turned I5, my cricketing skills had impressed many, and they urged my parents to enroll me in professional cricket training. My father, however, vehemently opposed the idea. He was so furious that he beat me severely, resulting in a scar on my eyebrow from a fall onto the bed. That scar remains to this day. My father would often say, "I'm not asking anything else from

you in this world. My only desire is that you serve the Lord." Since this was God's calling for my life, my parents were deeply committed to ensuring I fulfilled His purpose.

When cricket was your life, when did you develop a passion for ministry?

It was during my 10th grade that I began to feel a burden for ministry and the Church. Watching those who served the Lord filled me with a sense of dissatisfaction. A relentless thought stirred within me: "Someone must stand for the Lord. Who will stand by God's side? No matter what is lost—opportunities, positions, or comforts—someone must stand unwaveringly for Him. Why can't that someone be me?" The Lord continued to deepen this conviction within me. That season became the foundation for both my spiritual journey and my life in ministry.

Alright, Pastor! When did you first begin writing songs after feeling the burden of ministry? How did this grace for songwriting emerge?

> I was around 15 years old when a preacher visited our church and delivered a sermon based on the verse, "Against You, You Only, have I sinned and done what is evil in Your sight." On my way home after the

service, I felt the overwhelming presence of God. That verse came to me with a tune, and I sang it over and over again. When I reached home, I sat down and wrote the lines that the Lord placed in my heart in a notebook. To ensure I wouldn't forget the tune, I must have sung



it at least a hundred times. That was the first song the Lord gave me.

From the age of 15, the Lord continued to bless me with many songs. By the time I turned 18, He had given me more than 20 songs. That's why I always say, "I don't write songs; I receive them." Whenever I'm in the presence of God, it feels as though someone is placing the lyrics and the tune in my heart. It's not my effort but a gift I receive from Him. I've often tried to write songs on my own, but no matter how hard I try, I simply cannot. How then can I claim that I write songs? It is purely by His grace that I receive them, not by my ability.

Certainly, Pastor! Recently, the songs "Unga Naamam Uyaranum" and "Avar Naamam Yesu Kristhu" have captured hearts by exalting the name of the Lord. Could you share the inspiration behind these songs?

The song "Unga Naamam Uyaranum" didn't begin with those exact lyr-

ics. Initially, I received the tune for the Hallelujah chorus, along with the words "Aaviyanavare, Aaviyanavare" (Holy Spirit, Holy Spirit). Whenever I sang that chorus in various anointed gatherings, people would experience a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit. I kept repeat-



ing those words over and over. One day, during my prayer time, as I was immersed in singing "Aaviyanavare, Aaviyanavare," the lyrics suddenly shifted to "Hallelujah, Hallelujah." Shortly thereafter, God gave me the new words "Unga Naamam Uyaranum" along with the tune, and the song was complet-

ed that very day.

No matter where I am—whether travelling or at home—I have a habit of constantly worshipping and praising the Lord. During such moments of worship, I often feel a distinct divine presence, and that's when God places new songs in my heart. One day, as I was meditating on the greatness of God's name, He gave me the song "Avar Naamam Yesu Kristhu." This song carries a powerful message: in a world where people search for different remedies for different problems and worship multiple gods for various needs, there is only one name that is sufficient for every situation, every need, and every healing. That name is Jesus Christ, the name that leads us to eternal life and victory over every circumstance.

Can you tell us about your married life?

I was married in 2016 to Sister Percia Mothi. Our marriage stands as a testimony to God's faithfulness and miraculous provision. My wife

> works as an HR professional in an IT company, and we are blessed with two beautiful daughters.

What message would you like to convey to the youth?

In youth, it is natural to desire progress and fame. This yearning is valid, par-



ticularly for those who possess exceptional gifts and talents. However, these aspirations can sometimes make us impatient. I too experienced this. Nine years ago, I released a CD, confident in my talents, skills, and resources. Though I prayed before undertaking it, I failed to seek God's counsel on whether it aligned with His will or timing. The result? I incurred a financial loss of three lakh rupees. That experience taught me a valuable lesson: the importance of waiting for God's timing and will. Since then, I resolved to act only when God instructed. For many years, I waited. Finally, at the end of 2022, God gave me the green light to release songs. With His guidance, I began releasing them one by one. Through this journey, I discovered the immense power and blessings that come with aligning with God's will and timing.

As an elder brother sharing from my own life, I urge the youth to wait for God's appointed time, no matter how talented, resourceful, or full of opportunities you may be. If I had entered ministry prematurely, before being called by the Lord, I might have preached incorrect messages or released songs lacking depth and truth. Therefore, it is crucial to seek God's guidance and wait for His timing to fulfill your calling. I graduated from Bible College 14 years ago, and today, as I reflect on those years, my heart overflows with joy. None of those 14 years were wasted. After my marriage, however, life was far from easy. I didn't have a stable ministry, nor did I earn enough to support my family. Month after month, I had to borrow money from my wife to meet expenses. Many who saw my situation mocked me and spoke words that wounded my heart. Yet, during those difficult days, the biblical account of Aaron's rod that budded became a source of great strength and encouragement to me. When the twelve staffs were placed in the presence of God, only the staff chosen by the Lord sprouted to life. Overnight, it budded, blossomed, and produced ripe almonds. According to human reasoning, planting a dry staff in the ground, watering it faithfully, and waiting years for it to bear fruit might seem logical. But in the presence of God, all it took was one night for transformation to occur. This revelation became a profound source of strength for me. Whenever I heard words that sought to discourage me, I would recall this incident and find renewed courage in the Lord.

To all the young people reading this, I want to leave you with this thought: Wait for the Lord's timing. Trust in His guidance. Our God makes all things beautiful in His time. No matter how talented or gifted we may be, the season when God shapes us is far more essential. It's a season He Himself ordains and anticipates. One more thing I wish to emphasize—if you have been called into God's ministry, there is no need to place your trust in men. No human being has the obligation to elevate or endorse you. If the One who called you is the Lord, He will take care of your path and purpose.

Since then, it has been reaching approximately 3,000 subscribers through postal services. North India Ministries

16.9 Lakh AIDS Patients in India: Report from the Ministry of Health

India is home to 16.9 lakh AIDS patients, according to the Ministry of Health. World AIDS Day is observed globally on December I each year. Marking this occasion, the Ministry released a statement highlighting significant developments in the country's fight against AIDS.

The statement noted that India's battle against AIDS began in 1985. This sustained effort has led to a reduction in the prevalence of AIDS over recent years. To commemorate this year's World AIDS Day, a new awareness campaign has been launched under the theme "Leave No One Behind: My Health, My Right." This initiative aims to educate the public and promote health rights. The World Health Organization (WHO) has set a target to eradicate AIDS by 2030, and the Ministry of Health is actively implementing various strategies to achieve this ambitious goal.

Union Minister of State for Health, Anupriya Patel, in a written response to the Lok Sabha, shared some key statistics. She stated that India had 13.8 lakh AIDS patients in 2019-2020, a number that has risen to 16.9 lakh in 2023-24. Among these, 8.7 lakh are men, 8 lakh are women, and 6,637 belong to the transgender community. Over the past four years, 3 lakh new cases have been reported, reflecting the ongoing challenges in tackling the disease.

Dr. Saima Wazed, Regional Director for WHO Southeast Asia, added further insight. Speaking about the impact on children in the region, she stated, "Over 80,000 children, most of them under the age of 14, are living with AIDS in Southeast Asia. WHO is implementing multiple initiatives to ensure their protection and care."

These figures underscore the continued need for vigilance and robust interventions to combat the spread of AIDS in India and beyond.

Russia's Keen Interest in Manufacturing Trains in India to Meet Domestic Demand



Russia has expressed strong interest in making significant investments in India to fulfill its domestic railway needs. Furthermore, Russia is planning to establish a dedicated production facility in India to manufacture train coaches required for its railway system.

Last week, TMH, one of Russia's largest railway companies, held discussions with Indian Railways officials regarding this initiative. TMH is already involved in producing the sleeper-equipped 'Vande Bharat' trains in India.

A senior railway official stated yesterday, "The demand for trains in Russia is extremely high. As a result, Russia is keen on investing in India, sourcing spare parts, and setting up a manufacturing hub."

In an interaction with Indian journalists in Moscow, TMH CEO Kirill Lipa elaborated on the matter:

"Compared to other countries, interest rates in India are more favorable. Hence, we are planning substantial investments here. We have already entered into agreements with several Indian companies to supply various components required for Russian railways. We share a strong relationship with these firms and aim to increase our imports of parts from them," he said.
