And also I have a son now and he is becoming short-tempered like me. It's heartbreaking to see him carry on my traits which I'm trying so hard to get rid of. The only hope I have now is

God and I'm fasting and praying for him for some time now. Can I be redeemed of this?

Dear brother Rahul! I understand your problem. Your temper is not just affecting you but also the people around you including your son. And I understand that's bothering you very much.



Rahul, This temper is an emotion. This represents a struggle going on within yourself. So, let's focus on that problem now. For example, let's say a friend whom you love so dearly is insulting you in front of everyone. You will express your anger. But actually what you will be experiencing internally will be betrayal or hurt. And instead of expressing that hurt, you get angry and spill hurtful words or actions.

Rahul, you can be healed from this short temperedness. You can be free of this too. You just have to follow some guidelines to make the process easier. Don't be disheartened.

First of all, think of the situations that made you angry

- Some people get angry when their home is not maintained neatly.
- When someone speaks less of yourself
- When someone blames you for a mistake that you didn't commit.
- When someone doesn't do the thing they were asked to.
- Some people hate when others speak loudly.
- Some people hate it when someone always keeps complaining about things.



- When someone doesn't take responsibility.
- When people don't believe in you.
- When someone keeps on questioning you.

There are so many things like this that could make people angry. When are you getting angry? Why? Think about this and write it on a paper. Write down where all you can control your anger and when you are losing control.

I also want to tell you the bad outcomes of getting angry

- Your physical health will be affected. (Like your blood pressure, digestive system, heart functions etc..)
- Your people will get intimidated by you and start maintaining a distance.
- Your family will get affected. Because the love they deserve from you is not given or expressed, it will create a kind of hatred and fear in their hearts and that could even lead them to leave you.

Things you can do to keep your Temper under control

1. Exercise:

When you are physically active your body secretes some hormones that will make you happy and stress-free. When you do workouts or walking or jogging for at least 30 minutes a day, it will keep your anger issues in check.



2. Time out

When you go out into nature and enjoy the green trees and plants, it creates a sense of calmness in you. So, whenever you get angry try to come out of that place and go somewhere quiet and calm. This will give you some space to think and act instead of getting angry on the spot.

3. Self-awareness

Being aware of everything you do will help you with controlling your temper. Being aware means being mindful about what you think and how you act when you face situations.

Things to avoid when you are angry

Phone calls, people, work. Avoiding these things will help you be aware of the situation. And that awareness can help you control your temper.

Rahul! When you follow things like these, it will help you handle your anger with wisdom and your health can be guarded, you can see a change in yourself and most importantly you can see a change in your son. You cannot teach him something that you are not able to follow.

God of Justice

Millions of people live in this sprawling world. It is quite hard to pick someone who never made a mistake among them. Mistake is natural. But the man who regrets for his mistake receives grace in the eyes of the Lord. At the same time God's righteousness is also reflected in the life of man who commits a crime. The word "righteous" means following a protocol



In general it is known that a person who does not sin is called righteous. Man who can differentiate between the right and the wrong does not mean he does everything right. Sin is always within him. Since there is no man who have not sinned, the Bible says **"There is no one righteous, not even one; All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good."** (Romans 3:9,10)

David who was dear to the heart of the Lord, after becoming the King saw a woman from the roof of his palace, sent messengers to get her and sinned with her.

In order to hide his sin, David called upon Uriah from the military campaign and asked him to go to his house. But Uriah slept at the palace. So David with a hardened heart, sent Uriah back to the military campaign,

made him stand in front where the fighting was fiercest and made others withdraw suddenly which made Uriah struck and die. Thus David devised a well planned murder like an accident. After the death of Uriah, David took his wife as his wife. Though David was able to hide this from the eyes of people he couldn't hide it from the Lord. **"But the thing David had done displeased the Lord."** (2 Samuel 11:26)



Was David punished for the crime of prostitution and murder by the righteous God? Or did God of mercy, forgive him on hearing his pleading apology? As per the Old Testament, the punishment for murderer

is to be killed. That is the justice. But when God made David realize his sin through Nathan he said **"I have sinned against the Lord"** and sought the apology from Lord. The Lord took of his death sentence and granted him a life imprisonment. Are you wondering about the death sentence and life imprisonment? When David repented Nathan said **"The LORD has taken away your sin. You are not going to die"**. (2 Samuel 12:13) In case if David had not repented for his sin, he would have been killed by the Lord for murdering Uriah. Since he repented, God spared him from death but turned His sword towards his family. The sword that will never leave his house is the life imprisonment. We can see this punishment getting fulfilled in David's life. As God said the sword of the Lord started working in David's family. A fight arose between his children. David's own son rises against him and he was pushed out of the palace despite David being the king. Even today many youngsters wrongly believe that God of mercy will forgive and free them for their sins and hence sin fearlessly. David was punished for ignoring God though he was warned about his sin many times. God does forgive our sins and shows mercy, but at the same time we should not forget that He punishes us for our sins and justifies us righteously. Let me go over and cut off his head."** (2 Samuel 16:9). Do you know what David said? **"Let him curse, for the LORD has told him to. It may be that the LORD will look upon my misery and restore to me His covenant blessing instead of His curse today."** (2 Samuel 16:11,12) God honoured the patience and words uttered by David. As David said when he returned as the king, Shimei said **"May my lord not hold me guilty. Do not remember how your servant did wrong on the day my lord the king left Jerusalem. May the king put it out of his mind."** Similarly when you are patient and trust that God is righteous, just like Shimei who cursed

David but later humbled before him, fulfilling the verse **"For the LORD is a God of retribution; He will repay in full."** (Jeremiah 51:56)

A New **HEART!**



Grace



Heart surgery is a matter of fear. We might have little courage if it is a hand or leg surgery. Heart surgery? Many times? Did they do heart surgery within three months after birth? Such questions kept coming in my mind. I am sharing the miracles and challenges faced by my friend Grace. Here is the conversation with my friend Grace from Malaysia, just for you all.

Could you share about your childhood?

Hi Jishya, I am happy to connect with you after many days. I was born in Malaysia, and I have an elder brother. Until I was born, both my parents were working. After my birth my mom had to take care of me and so she quit her job. My childhood was not like others because within few weeks after my birth doctors said that my heart was not functioning properly.

What was the complication in your heart?

In the third week after my birth, the doctors who tested me diagnosed me with a complex heart condition wherein the right-side artery was on the left and the left-side artery was on the right side. Therefore, the blood flow was also the other way round and so it wasn't functioning in the way it should. The greatest miracle in this is, the doctors were confused as to how I survived three weeks since my birth. I had undergone many surgeries and stayed in the hospital for many days.



Surgery within three weeks of your birth? Can't even imagine. After that were there any issues in your body?

When I was 10 years old, a pacemaker was fixed and for the past 20yrs I am surviving with pacemaker only. Early in those days there were no facilities available in Malaysia where we stayed for such surgeries. Therefore, from three weeks until I was 1.5yrs, I was kept in the hospital and then only they did the open-heart surgery. A point to be noted is that mine was the first complex heart surgery done in Kuala Lumpur. The doctors projected that I had only 10% of chances of survival and even if I survived I would not be able to walk and my body would be immobile. They also said that though I survived, as my heart is weak, the oxygen supply to my brain will be reduced making me a slow learner with difficulty to study and many more such information were told about me. Again, my heart did not function properly and a pacemaker was fixed. To cut short, my entire childhood was spent in the hospital and with the doctors.

It is so hard for me to even listen. You underwent sufferings in your body but how were you emotionally?

I couldn't play or run like other children but whatever I can do, I did all those things. When I was feeling low, my mom would share God's word and encourage me. Why me? What is it happening to me? Why am I in the hospital? When all such question arises, my mom would speak encouraging words to me immediately. I did not go into self-pity but whatever I can do, I did it well with all my strength. I couldn't do physical exercise nor do hiking and it wasn't possible too. These thoughts made me feel burdened but I thank and praise God for all the things that I was able to do.



If you could speak so boldly, I think it is your mom's prayer and encouragement that had strengthened you. Could share about your mom?

My mom is a prayer warrior. At times when I was admitted in the hospital, she would tell others that Jesus is good. Once before my heart surgery I asked my mother, ***"If I die in this surgery would you still say Jesus is good?"***. She said that God's character never changes even if she had to lose me. He is a good God. This trust in God, her faith in all circumstances were those that strengthened me. When I got back my consciousness after the surgery, I could hear my mom say, ***"Mom loves you, Dad loves you, Jesus loves you."*** It is true that I would not have my full senses, nor would I be able to speak but I could feel what they say. My family was a great support. I could understand the love of Jesus more.

A great salute to your dad, mom and elder brother. You made me cry. Ok, were you able to study?

Just like other students I studied in school as well as in college and scored good marks. God gave me good friends. Some have stayed away from me because of my weakness, and some

have hurt me too. But my mom would say, ***"There are many to love you, make friends with them."*** When I ask God about my future or when I cry pouring out my heart to Him, He would encourage me by saying, ***"I have the best plans for you."***

How are you so joyful? Could you share about your unforgettable moment in life?

I am continuing to learn about how to trust God completely. Unforgettable moment... Hmm, shall tell you. When I was 18yrs old, I completed my schooling and was waiting with some dreams. Suddenly I fell sick and was taken to the hospital. Doctor said that my pacemaker battery was damaged, and I underwent a surgery to change that. When I was a child, the surgery was not a big thing for me but being a teenager, I found it very difficult. Yet God strengthened me. This year also I underwent a surgery. Nothing could stop me from running for my Lord.

Super Grace. What are all the things that you do now?

I am serving amidst the youngsters, children, and youth in a famous church in Malaysia. I share God's love through social media too. Specifically, I share God's love through my testimony to parents of children who are weak like me and to patients who are admitted in the hospitals.

Super... what would you like to say to the youngsters who read this article?

Do not think or murmur saying that only you are suffering in life. Instead, think of the good things that God has done in your lives and thank Him. Do your best unto God in whatever you can and don't forget that God is good.

Sufferings, weaknesses, darkest valleys of death could not stop Grace's race. Even today she is running her race for the Lord. Do not forget that the Lord who is leading Grace Jerald will guide you unto the end ●

THE GOD WHO CALLED ABRAHAM

When God asked Abraham to leave his people and travel to the nation he promised, ***“Abraham went, as the LORD had told him.”*** (Genesis 12:4) God called Abraham and without any question, he obeyed God’s command. An obedient heart was seen in Abraham which was the reason for all his special blessings. Even when so many kings came against him, no one could win Abraham because he was obedient to God’s call.

“As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon alias Peter and his brother Andrew who were fishing. “Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.” At once they left their nets and followed him.” (Matthew 4:18-20) Even though they had a family to feed, owned boats, had a prolific profession, possessed nets and needs, they followed Jesus immediately without any question, leaving behind their boats.

“Going on from there, Jesus saw two other brothers, James’s son of Zebedee and his brother John. They were in a boat with their father Zebedee, preparing their nets. When Jesus called them, they immediately left the boat and their father and followed him. (Matthew 4:21)

When god called Abraham, he did not explore the prosperity of the nation to where he was called or ask how favourable it will be to his family life. He never thought about his security and safety. Instead, Abraham exhibited implicit obedience to God’s call.



In the year 1974, when God anointed me, I received His calling for ministry. I gave excuses to God saying ‘I will serve God part time, on Sundays or after job during week days’. But continuously, God intervened with me. Even though, the high call was from a mighty God who trusted me, I did not obey Him immediately. I was pondering a lot about my personal life and future. After 6 months, I had a direct encounter with God in which He





said clearly, *“Look at crores of perishing people around you, I am calling you for these people, but instead you are self-centered about you, your career and family.”* Immediately, I wept and dedicated myself to His ministry. Even today, I have a regret in my heart that I was negligent to God’s call for six months and delayed it due to self-centred excuses. Unlike us, Abraham obeyed God immediately. No where in his journey, he had doubts of, *“what people would say, where to go and what to do?”* He just displayed a faithful obedience to God.

We read in the Bible, *“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”* (Acts 1:8) God has not asked all of us to quit jobs, desert our families and then involve in God’s ministry. We are called foremost to be witnesses in the places we are positioned – mainly in our homes and workplaces. How many of us are able to discern the special calling we have? Are we considering that only the full-time pastors, evangelists and missionaries as people who have a calling? Even be a student or a home maker or a business person, we are called to reflect God’s glory in every place we are

positioned. We are mistaken if we think we have to leave our present situation and go somewhere for God’s ministry. God has called you to build up your family- are you committed to that specific calling? If you are shunning away from your family because of the conflicts you have with your in-laws and spouses, it means you are not obedient to God’s calling and you are drifting away from your purpose. Families are meant to have problems and disputes. Amidst that, we should stand firm as witnesses for God which is your calling. Even in the workplace, we are called to work in a special manner, unique from others to reflect God. We are called to be blameless and flawless in our job profiles, leading the examples of Joseph and Daniel. That is the special calling for us! Only then can we be victorious like Abraham.

My dear beloved youth, just because Abraham obeyed God and sincerely committed him to God, no one could defeat him. God stood with him and made the kings of various nations bow before him. Hence, I urge each one of you to commit yourself to God’s calling. Listen to what God is conversing with you. Surrender yourself to His high calling in your education, profession and in every minute detail of your life today. God will make you victorious too! ●

- So, if we face them with fasting and prayer, they will repent.

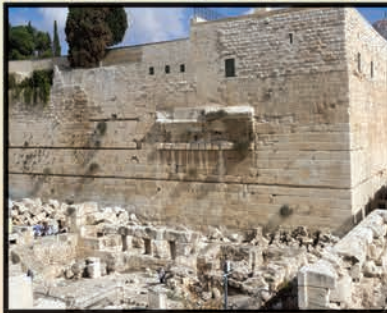

PREPARE FOR JESUS' SECOND COMING

THE REBUILDING OF THE TEMPLE IN JERUSALEM

Jerusalem is called as **“Yerushalayim”** in Hebrew language which means **“Foundation of Peace”**. The total area of this city is 125 sq.km. and more than 8 lakh people live there. It is one of the oldest cities and is considered as the holy city for three categories such as Judaism, Christianity, and Islam.

So far Jerusalem was destroyed twice, besieged 23 times, attacked 52 times, and was captured 44 times by the outsiders. Based on the Lord's promise: **“Now He said to me, ‘It is your son Solomon who shall build My house and My courts...’** (1Chronicle 28:6), the temple was built by Solomon. But this first temple was burnt by the king of Babylon, Nebuchadnezzar in the year 587 B.C. when he came for war against Jerusalem. After 70yrs the temple was rebuilt through people like Ezra and Nehemiah. In the future days the temple was reconstructed by king Herod. The disciples came to show Jesus the structures of this temple. And Jesus said to them, **“Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down.”** (Matthew 24:2). As Jesus said, during 70 A.D., the Romans burnt Jerusalem city and the temple. Because of the fire the golden plates that covered the temple melted and became as blocks stuck in between the stones. To remove this gold, the Roman soldiers separated each stone of the temple, thus fulfilling what Jesus said. According to the Scriptures, the destroyed temple must be reconstructed before the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ. In the year 2018, Mr.Trump who was the President of America earlier,



announced Jerusalem as the capital of Israel. The earlier Prime Minister of Israel, Benjamin Netanyahu announced that the temple of Jerusalem will be rebuilt. An organization named **“Institute Temple Mount”** is ready with a design to reconstruct the temple. **“Know therefore and understand, that from**

the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince, there shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times.” (Daniel 9:25). Because the Anti-Christ will make a contract with Israel and will break it in between. Then he will go and sit in the temple

and will declare himself as God. The countries who support Anti-Christ will make an agreement with Israel and support him. The preparations for this are happening indirectly. The temple of Jerusalem will be rebuilt before the reign of Anti-Christ. The rebuilding of the temple is an important sign before the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ.

My dear youngsters, as the scripture reveals the signs of what would happen on earth before the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ, it is being fulfilled very rapidly now around us. On the one side this world is getting ready for the reign of Anti-Christ but the coming of the Lord will be before that. Prepare yourself for the coming of the Lord. “Therefore, you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.” (Matthew 24:44) ●

CHRIST IN ECCLESIASTES

Christ is the only way for man to reach God. Man will find full, satisfied and complete life there. (John 10:10; 7:37,38) The shortcomings that man faces in his life can be fulfilled only through the personal relationship that one has with Christ Jesus.

ADONI-BEZEK

When Joshua enquired the Lord on who should fight against the Canaanites first, the Lord replied that the tribe of Judah shall go up to fight against the Canaanites and that He will deliver that land to them. The men of Judah then invited the Simeonites, their fellow Israelites to join with them to go into their allotted territory to fight against the



Canaanites and then they will move onto the Simeonite territory. So, the Simeonites went with them. When Judah attacked, the Lord gave the Canaanites and Perizzites into their hands, and they struck down ten thousand men at a place called Bezek. After their victory over the Canaanites and Perizzites, the Canaanite king Adoni-Bezek fled to Bezek but they chased him and caught him, cut off his thumbs and big toes. Then Adoni-Bezek said with great anguish, "I had cut off the thumbs and big toes of seventy kings who are now picking up scraps under my table. Now, God has paid me back for what I did to them." They brought him to Jerusalem, and he died there. (Judges 1:1-7)

Dear youth, we understand from the narrative of Adoni-Bezek that our God is a 'God of retribution'. Let us never forget that one day He will give just punishment for all our sins and mistakes.

JACOB

One day when Isaac's eldest son Esau returned home from the wilderness exhausted and hungry, his brother Jacob was cooking a delicious stew. Esau asked Jacob to give him some of the delicious red stew. But Jacob asked him to trade his birth right in exchange for the bread and some lentil stew. Esau agreed and gave Jacob his inheritance just for a cup of stew.

When Isaac was old and his eyes were so weak, he called for Esau and expressed his desire to pronounce his blessings on him as first born. But Rebekah deceptively helped the younger son Jacob to receive his father's blessings instead of Esau. When Esau heard of this, he planned to take revenge on Jacob and kill him. So, Rebekah sent Jacob to her brother Laban. There, he served Laban for 7 years in order to marry his daughter Rachel. But,

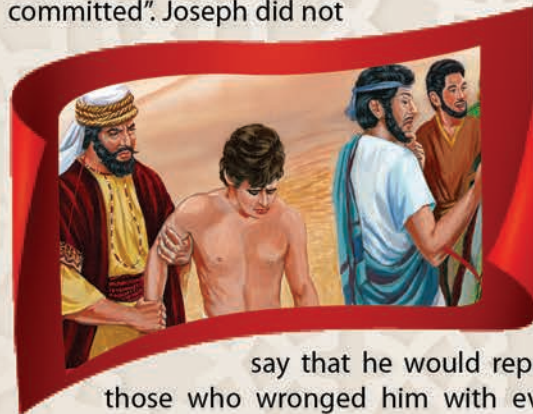


instead of Rachel, Laban gave Leah in marriage to Jacob, thus deceiving him during marriage. Again, he agreed to serve for another 7 years in order to marry Rachel. (Genesis 25-29).

Dear youth, Jacob deceived his own brother twice. But after a few years, he was deceived by Laban. It is very clear from this narrative that we will definitely receive punishment for the sins we commit. Hence, for any reason do not deceive anyone and fearfully walk in God's ways to receive His blessings.

JOSEPH

Hated by his brothers, he was sold into the hands of the Midianites for 20 shekels of silver. An officer from Egypt named Potiphar bought him from the Midianites. He handed over everything he had to Joseph and made him a Judge. Joseph went to jail for something he did not do. As he was faithful in prison, the Lord raised him up again. He appointed Joseph over all the land of Egypt to escape from the famine that was to come. When there was a famine in all the lands, Joseph's brothers bought grain from the hand of Joseph in Egypt. Even though Joseph's brothers did bad things to him, he saw those bad things to be good things in the end. Joseph did not want to harm his brothers even though they had done bad things. Rather, it was Joseph who did them good. But whenever Joseph's brothers saw him, all they could see was the injustice that they had done to him. His brothers looked at Joseph and said, "forgive us for the treachery we had committed". Joseph did not



say that he would repay those who wronged him with evil. Rather he did them good. (Genesis 39-50)

Dear youth, Joseph was hated by his brothers. But the Lord was with Joseph and helped his cause, because he had done good. They received goodness from the hands of the same brother they hated. The Lord will correct evil when you repay evil with goodness!

SHIMEI

King David is chased away by his own son Absalom and goes into hiding. Then Shimei threw stones at King David saying 'get lost, get lost and perish, thou art a bloodthirsty man, and behold thou art caught in thine own iniquity'. David walked away silently. Then said Abishai unto the King, 'why



should this dead dog curse my lord the king? Let me go over, and take off his head'. David then said to Abishai, "My son, my own flesh and blood, is trying to kill me. How much more, then, this Benjamite! Leave him alone; let him curse, for the LORD has told him to. It may be that the LORD will look upon my misery and restore to me his covenant blessing instead of his curse today" (2 Samuel 16:5-12). And it came to pass, when David was returning to the throne, Shimei came out before king David, and cried unto him and asked for forgiveness. (1 Samuel 16:5-19)

Dear youth, Shimei rose up against David, who had committed no crime. But when the time came, he requited the good instead of the affliction. When you also remain calm like David while being despised by others, you will receive goodness.

Thomas designed exclusive hot boxes to keep the pizzas intact. Steadily, the taste and quality of the pizza started attracting people. In the same year, he opened two more pizza shops. The logo of Domino’s Pizza has three dots, indicating the first three shops opened by him. These shops eventually became the identity of the brand. But the success of Thomas didn’t last for long. His first shop caught fire and caused him a huge loss.

Thomas was unhindered by this obstacle. Instead of this one shop, he opened five new ones and his business started picking up. After some time, he started getting feedback that the quality of pizza is declining. This caused a huge decline in

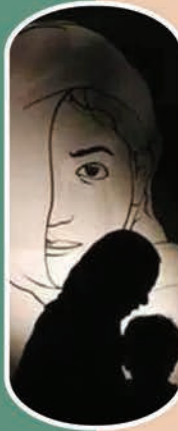

Women, Children – Molestation

- ▶ In 2020 last year, 28,046 rape cases were filed and 28,153 women were affected.
- ▶ The National Crime Record Bureau says that 77 new rape cases are registered every day.
- ▶ Out of this, 25,498 are above 18 years of age and 2,655 are below 18 years.
- ▶ The states with maximum cases registered are Rajasthan with 5,310 cases, Uttar Pradesh with 2,769 cases, Madhya Pradesh with 2,339, Maharashtra with 2061 cases and Assam with 1,657 cases.
- ▶ Apart from rape, 85,392 cases are registered as suppression assault against women.



Prayer points:

1. Let us pray for the protection of women and children,
2. Let us pray for the deliverance of women and children who are affected by rape.
3. Let us pray that the 77 rape cases registered daily be reduced and also for the prevention of violence against women and children.
4. Let us pray that rape be prevented in the country and speedy resolution for the registered rape cases.
5. Let us pray that the Government should take necessary action to prevent repression against women, trafficking and dowry.

Road accidents

- ▶ In India, 1.20 lakh people have died in road accidents last year.
- ▶ Everyday 328 die in road accidents says National Crime Record Bureau.
- ▶ In the last 3 years, 3.92 lakh people have lost their lives in road accidents.
- ▶ Last year, 1.30 lakh cases for over speeding have been registered.
- ▶ Number of cases registered for causing injury due to overspeeding are 85,920 cases in 2020, 1.12 lakh cases in 2019 and 1.08 lakh cases in 2018.



Prayer points:

1. Let us pray that deaths due to road accidents be reduced and accidents be prevented.
2. Let us pray for the prevention of accidents that take place every day.
3. Let us pray for the awareness of driving safely and patiently by following the rules and regulations with proper protection.
4. Let us pray for the speedy recovery of persons currently being treated for severe injury caused by accidents.
5. Let us pray for the Government to take necessary action to repair the roads, create awareness about wearing helmets and following regulations.

Murder-Abduction cases

► In India in 2020, around 80 people are murdered every day. In just one year, murder charges have been made against 29,193 people.

► 3,779 murder cases in Uttar Pradesh, 3,150 cases in Bihar, 2,163 cases in Maharashtra, 2,101 cases in Madhya Pradesh, 1,948 cases in West Bengal and 472 cases in Delhi have been registered.

► The percentage of murdered victims age-wise is about 38.5% in 30-45 years of age, 35.9% in 18-30 years of age, 16.4% in 45-60 years of age and 4% are above 60 years of age.

► Last year in 2020; 84,805 abduction cases have been registered. In 2019, 1,05,036 cases were registered.



Prayer points:

1. Let us pray for the prevention of murder in India.
2. Let us pray for the evil spirit that provokes murder to be bound and that it does not result in death.
3. Let us pray for the binding of the evil spirit that provokes a youngster to murder and tries to destroy their future.

Online Fraud

► Fraudulent groups from northern states extort money from youngsters saying attractive things like how they can earn money from home, online.

► These northern state groups target mainly on the youth from the states of Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Karnataka.

► In the last 2 years, the number of victims deceived by this group keeps increasing day by day.



Prayer points

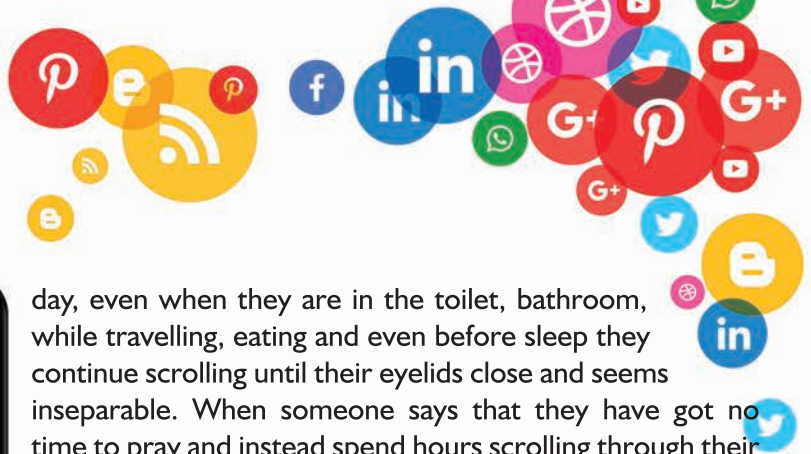
1. Let us pray that the Tamil Nadu government create sufficient jobs so that the youth can work in their own state.

For the sake of your social media friends, don't lose your loving family, who wait expectedly for your love and affection. It causes disputes between husband and wife and destroys the peace in the family. The children seek the love of their parents and stray away

if they don't get it. Like these, many things can be illustrated. Perhaps, few things mentioned above could have happened in your life too.

What does the Word of God say?

"...if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey..."

(Romans 6:16). In our case, we are not obeying, rather we are overcome by the social media and are slaves to it. Test yourselves by asking this question: when you get a free hour, will

Adoni-Bezok

Adoni-Bezok was the king of Canon, before Israelites conquered it. After the death of Joshua, Israelites inquired the Lord as to who shall go first and fight against the Canaanites. The Lord said, "The tribes of Judah shall go". As told, they went and the Lord gave the Canaanites and the Perizzites into their hands. The tribes of Judah along with the tribes of Simeon pursued Adoni-Bezok and cut his thumbs and his big toes. The Lord led the Israelites against Adoni-Bezok and repaid him for his action. This has been narrated in the book of Judges 1:1-7 in the Holy Bible.

At the time when Adoni-Bezok was being defeated by his opponents, he would have heard two inner voices as below:



Voice 1: What is my flair? What is my strength? I have subdued 70 kings by now.

Voice 2: Did the Lord assist me? Definitely it is a wonder that I conquered all these kings.



Voice 1: What punishment shall be given to all these kings? Shall they be killed?

Voice 2: Or shall I forgive them? Because I have heard "Whatever we sow, we shall reap"



Voice 1: To forgive? Not possible! Will punish them for sure.

Voice 2: What if I imprison them for life?



Voice 1: They might come to take revenge on me along with my other opponents, if they escape from the prison.

Voice 2: I should give a well-thought punishment that people shall speak about my wisdom and skill for posterity.



Voice 1: What if we make them disabled. Even if they get released, they cannot do anything bad to me.

Voice 2: He who is crippled by a man must also be crippled, the law says. What if I lose and the same punishment could have given to me.



Voice 1: Nothing should happen and nothing will happen. Thumbs and big toes of my opponents must be cut so that they don't run fast or shoot arrows. They cannot live as soldiers or war heroes. Even if they get released or escape, there shall be no trouble.

This is how; Adoni-Bezek's inner voice would have spoken to him.

By listening to his bad conscience, he cut the thumbs and the big toes of the kings who were captured as prisoners. They used to pick the scraps under his table to eat.

When king Adoni-Bezek was captured by the tribes of Judah and Simeon, his thumbs and big toes were cut off. ***"As I have done, so God repaid me" he said.*** (Judges 1:7)

Beloved son and daughter, there is a name for our God **"The Lord of Vengeance"**. ***"For according to the work of a man he will repay him and according to his ways he will make it befall him"*** (Job 34:11) said Job.

"I the Lord search the heart and test the mind, to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his deeds". (Jeremiah 17:10) says so, let your actions and thoughts be good to others. Be cautious to act wisely and to do good to your enemies also. Because the Lord himself has taken the responsibility of taking vengeance.

IGNITERS CAMP 2021



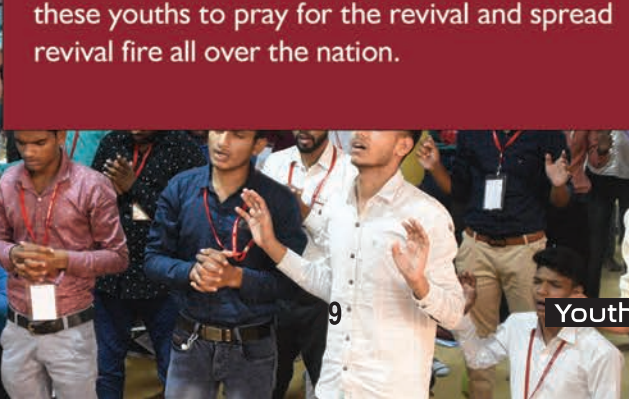

THE NEET EXAM THAT WAS CONDUCTED THIS YEAR, CAN'T BE BANNED!

THE PETITION IN THE SUPREME COURT HAS BEEN REJECTED!

FINE OF RS 5 LAKHS FOR THE ADVOCATE

The petition to ban the NEET exams that was conducted this year owing to the fact that many states had received the question papers a day earlier, has been rejected by the supreme court. Adding to that the court has also ordered a fine of Rs 5 lakhs to the advocate who represented the case.

NEET, which is the entrance exam for Under Graduate studies in medicine, was conducted on the 12th of last month. More than 6 lakhs students attempted the exam. Advocate Mamta Sharma had filed a public interest litigation last week. In her litigation she had mentioned the following 'The NEET exam that was conducted this year on the 12th of September has to be cancelled owing to the fact that there were multiple fraudulent activities that had taken place such as impersonation and release of question papers a day prior to the exam in certain states'.

Subsequently the case was investigated by Judge Nageshwara Rao in a session. At that time the advocate representing the petitioner announced 'The exam that has been conducted amidst many discrepancies must be banned'. But the judge panel which rejected the petition asked the following questions 'Millions

of students have written this exam all over the country. Wouldn't it affect their future if we ban the exam? Moreover, why didn't you inform those who approached you that such petitions would be closed with a penalty. Didn't you know that? Also, hasn't it been clearly stated in the judgement given by the supreme court previously?' A fine of Rs 5 lakh was levied upon the advocate who took up the case. It was also ordered that the advocate has to pay the fine by herself and not ask for money from the people who approached her.

NEW SYLLABUS CAN'T BE ALTERED!

The union government has filed an affidavit regarding the syllabus followed for the admission exam conducted for super speciality medicine. It read, 'Under no circumstances will the new syllabus for Super specialty medicine be withdrawn. In order to help the students to prepare for the new syllabus, the exam which was supposed to be held on November has been postponed to 10th and 11th of Jan, 2022.'
