HI, JINI. TELL US ABOUT YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY.

Hi, akka. My name is Jini, I was born and brought up in Nagercoil, in the Kanyakumari district. I am the eldest daughter of John Nishan and Selva Amudha. I have a younger sister who is studying in college now. My father is a Christian, while my mother accepted Christ, hailing from a non-believer family. Both of them made sure that I had a Christian upbringing. I prayed promptly and went to church regularly since my childhood. My grandmother stays with us. This is my beautiful family.



YOU HAVE SHARED ABOUT YOUR BEAUTIFUL FAMILY... HOW WAS YOUR SCHOOL AND COLLEGE LIFE?

I used to be a topper at school. I wanted to study well and become an IAS or top-level HR. I was equally interested in dance. In 10th I scored 489/500 and in 12th I got 1061/1100 marks. My parents were very supportive offering the right amount of love and supervision, and this made me achieve in my academics.

SUPER! YOU HAVE STUDIED WELL.... TELL US ABOUT YOUR SALVATION EXPERIENCE...

As I said my mother was from a non-believer family. After my parents' wedding, they used to go to church regularly. When I was in the third standard, my mother suffered a lot because of an evil spirit, but, God gave complete deliverance because of our prayer. Seeing this miracle happen, made me accept Jesus as my saviour and love Him more. From that point, I began telling everyone that Jesus is the only living God. My love for Christ grew each day. But I wasn't anointed then, I just continued praying with great eagerness.

YOU SECURED GOOD MARKS... HOW WAS YOUR COLLEGE LIFE? WERE YOU ABLE TO GROW IN CHRIST?

I completed my school and joined college. My prayer life continued to remain stable for a while even after that. I was regular with my prayers and bible-reading. But very soon I started doing things as I pleased. I felt like an uncharged bird. But my prayer life took a toll and one sin led to another. I gave space for multiple addictions. I started following K-Pop bands like BTS, Monsta X, Blackpink and NCT and consumed their songs day



and night. I also started beginning on Korean series all day. Because of all this, I even skipped my breakfast for 4 years. Once I return back from college, I sit with my phone to watch these videos.

Apart from this, I was addicted to social media like Instagram, Snapchat and WhatsApp. As soon as I unlock my phone, my hands used to go to check Instagram. That was my level of addiction. I started wearing clothes like the ones in K-pop groups and started buying their merchandise. My prayer life took a back seat and I didn't have a personal relationship with God.

HOW DID YOU RENEW YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD BEING ADDICTIVE TO SO MANY SINS UNABLE TO GROW IN YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD?

I was addicted to smartphones from 2016. After finishing UG, I wanted to study further to become an HR. So I applied for a Master's course in Chennai. While I was studying there, the first lockdown was announced and I returned back to my home. When I reached my house, I found that my entire family got addicted to Tamil serials. I didn't have an option to skip that, so I also joined them. During such a phase, we happened to see the Jebikkalam Vaanga program on TV. God spoke to us through the program and asked us to renew our prayer life. So, we obeyed and restarted our family prayer. I also began my daily personal prayer. Gradually God gave me freedom from all sins and addiction. In January 2021 I came to know about the Revival Igniters Camp and participated in that. My life changed completely after that. I confessed all my sins to Jesus and prayed with tears. God gave me freedom from all sins, anointed me and took me into His salvation army.

Earlier I used to be afraid of evil spirits, but now God has transformed me to bind his deeds and ways, through warfare prayer. He has given me the spirit of prayer to stand in the gap for the nation for 2-3 hours daily. My life got transformed completely after attending the camp.

SUPER! YOU RENEWED YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS.. DID YOUR DREAM TO BECOME AN HR COME TRUE?

In the 3-day camp, they asked us to pray for the needs of one another. I was asking my prayer partners to pray for my job. I got an interview call very shortly after the camp and got the job. I only got a humble salary there. While I was working there, I was praying to Jesus for a high pay job and kept trying. Very soon, I got a job in a company beyond my expectations with a good salary.

YOUR DREAM OF BECOMING AN HR WAS FULFILLED... HOW IS YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD NOW?

I am very happy about it. Before I used to be fiddling with my phone all the time, but now there is a huge change in my prayer life. God speaks to me and I speak to Him every day. I hardly realise hours passing by when I am in prayer. Speaking with Him has been a very sweet experience. I am distributing tracts and going on prayer walks now as a part of ministry. I am praying to do more for God. I will be true to the God who redeemed me from my sinful addictions.



WHAT DO YOU WISH TO TELL THE YOUNGSTERS?

Loving anything more than God is sin. Being aware of a sin and still doing it is a bigger sin. If you repent to God with a changed heart, He can forgive all your sins and give you freedom. Give your heart to God today!

I am working in an important department in the operation theatre at a hospital. I know Christ and I serve in a church in the children's ministry. I became friend with a non-believer at my workplace. As days passed by, we started talking casually. Now talks about my marriage is going on at home but my mind is only thinking about him. At first when I informed my parents about him, they opposed but later they said let it be done as per my wish. I told him about Jesus, and he agreed to marry me according to our faith. He began to come to church and now is prepared to be baptized as well. At this point, my colleague asked me a question that disturbed me. Angel, did Jesus agree to your marriage? Did you get to know what is God's will in your marriage? Can you boldly confess that this marriage is from the Lord? I couldn't answer to these questions that my friend had asked me. I am so confused. I should not take a wrong decision. Please help me.

Dear sister Angel, I can understand your anxiety and confusion. I thank God for the good friend that He has given you. Angel, why couldn't you answer to these three questions? You're a prayerful girl and I am sure that you would have prayed. Then why are you confused unnecessarily? Why do you think that you should not take any wrong decision when you have prayed about it? Angel, if you had a good fellowship with God, you would have answered your friend immediately and shut her mouth.

Your friend's first question was, did Jesus agree to this marriage?

Since you are a praying girl, you would have prayed about your marriage as well. What did Jesus say to you? If He had said 'yes', then no problem. Maybe He could have said 'No' or could have



given the signal to 'wait'. But Jesus will never say anything that is contrary to the word of God. When He had said not to be yoked with an unbeliever in His word, then no matter if we cry and pray or make His heart melt by fasting, He will never work against His Word.

Moreover, you are a praying girl, you do ministry and therefore I am sure that you would have prayed for your future husband. You would have prayed for a praying husband, to do ministry along with you, one who would encourage you in doing ministry, as a family you would be a witness and reap souls for God and many such requests. In case you did not have any such expectations or prayer requests then how could you pray and respond to any proposal?

Angel, only if you have any expectations can you analyze the proposal that you receive. If there are no right expectations or if you don't pray right for your future husband, then there are possibilities to say 'yes' to any proposal. Danger of taking a wrong decision is also possible.



Second question, did you get to know what is God's will in your marriage?

You hear many people say that this person was permitted by God in my life, else I would not have met him or would have got the opportunity to share the gospel with him because this is God's will.

Alright, as you said, you have introduced Jesus to him, and it is good. But can you say how is his spiritual growth? He could have known Jesus, he may come to church because of the love he has for you, but does he have the spiritual growth to build a godly family?

In today's world where the husband and wife are praying, they find it very difficult to meet every day's challenges. Are you aware of the spiritual growth of the person whom you love? You can pray as well as you can do children's ministry but what about that person? According to him he is like a child in his spiritual life whereas you are more matured in spiritual life like praying, anointed, doing ministry, and burdened for the souls. If there is so much of spiritual differences, then how can build a Christian family together? Do you think it is God's will to give you a person as a partner who is like a child in spiritual life?



If you still say yes, then you will have to sacrifice many things in your spiritual life. For example, while ploughing in a field they don't tie ox on one side and calf on the other, because it would not be helpful in ploughing. Therefore, you think if this marriage will be God's will or not.

Third question, can you boldly confess that this marriage is from the Lord?

Angel, the person whom you like to marry, at first was a friend. Therefore, he would have helped

you in many ways. In difficult situations, when there was no one to help, either for your family or for you he would have been a support. If not, your friendship would not change as love.



Therefore, meeting him in his life, sharing the gospel with him, would seem to be God's doing. On the other hand, when you were in need, God could have permitted him in your life as a helpful person, based on which you could have shared God's love with him. As we see in the Bible, to help us, God sends angels to serve us. We need to know that they are to help us and not to choose them as partners. God permits many people in our lives for some moments or for some time, to help us or to lift us or to mould us. But we cannot decide that the one who helped is the right partner for life.

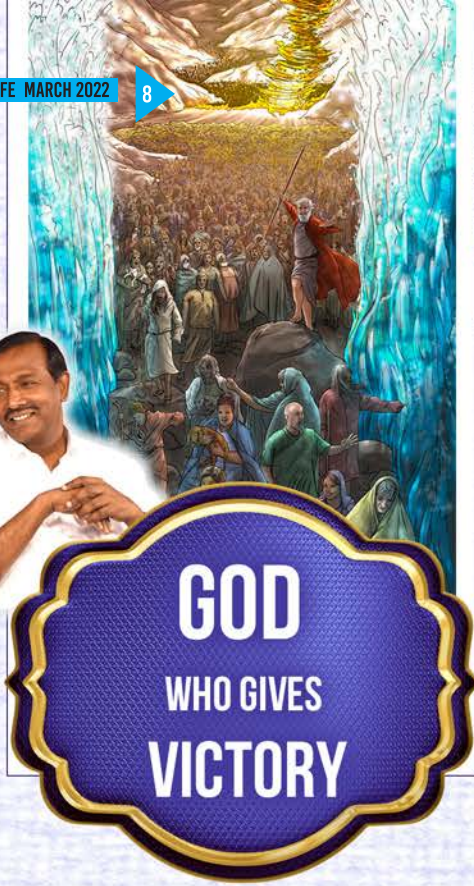
Therefore, if you deeply think about the three questions that your friend asked, you will be able to take a clear decision.

GOD WHO GIVES VICTORY

“Moses answered the people, ***“Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the Lord will bring you today. The Egyptians you see today you will never see again. The Lord will fight for you; you need only be still”*** (Exodus 14:13,14) – Amidst your daily struggles, the promise of the Lord to you is ‘God will fight for you. You need to be just still.’ You will not experience the problems, challenges, fear, anxiety, diseases and struggles you are facing today.

The people of Israel who are chosen by God were held captives in the land of Egypt for 430 years. The people who settled in Egypt during the time of Joseph proliferated and became a massive group. The Hebrews treated them as slaves and extracted very hard work from them. The Israelites cried unto God for deliverance from the hands of these people. God listened to their outbursts and sent Moses to deliver them from the clutches of slavery. Also, God helped them cross the Red Sea by His mighty miracle. When they encamped near the sea, these people were relieved that they were delivered from slavery and finally crossed the dangers. But their relief was a short lived one. They suddenly heard the noises of the chariots and army. When they looked



back, they saw all Pharaoh’s horses and chariots, horsemen and troops-pursuing the Israelites.

He took six hundred of the best chariots, along with all the other chariots of Egypt, with officers over all of them (Exodus 14:7)

The entire people were always afraid of the Egyptian Army. The Israelites who were slaves for 430 years never had any experience of warfare, they were very naïve and did not know to use the sword and fight against enemies. At this juncture, they saw Pharaoh coming with his great Army of chariots and horses.

As Pharaoh approached, the Israelites looked up, and there were the Egyptians, marching after them. They were terrified and cried out to the Lord. (Exodus 14:10)

When this Army of Pharaoh was nearing them, they were first afraid. Even though they were afraid, they did one good thing – ***‘They were terrified and cried out to the Lord’*** (Exodus 14:10). Yes, whenever there are situations of danger, we should cry unto God. He is the only person who can help us and deliver us. He was the one who delivered them from the Egyptian slavery. If we look unto God, he will save us, protect us and give us victory in all our paths. Indeed, He has promised that ‘he will deliver those who call unto him.’



The Israelites also did another evil thing in the sight of the Lord - They said to Moses, "Was it because there were no graves in Egypt that you brought us to the desert to die? What have you done to us by bringing us out of Egypt? Didn't we say to you in Egypt, *'Leave us alone; let us serve the Egyptians? It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the desert!'*" (Exodus 14:11,12).

Grumbling was the sin which instigated God's wrath against the Israelites. God spoke against them in a very angry note and termed them 'Stiff-necked' and 'Grumblers'. Grumbling dishonours and disheartens God. The Israelites grumbled and questioned saying, 'we could have been in Egypt, why did you bring us to this wilderness?'. But amidst these situations, their leader and servant of God, Moses encouraged them in faith saying, 'Do not fear'. The Israelites were living in a very pathetic lifestyle. They were being treated as slaves, beaten for small mistakes and mistreated with heavy job load. Maybe, that's why they are inherently afraid of every situation. Satan's biggest idea is to always place fear in people's hearts and is the main weapon Satan wants to use against God's people. Even if situation seems very threatening and frightening, God reminds us not to fear.

"The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still" (Exodus 14:14).

Even though these people were not skilled to fight, the next generation raised up as warriors. By the time they reached Rephidim, they were very well trained and God through Joshua asked them to send the war men to fight. God sometimes asks us to stay still; sometimes he might ask us to fight. But at this juncture, He asked them to stay still and watch what was happening. God assured them that he will fight for them in this incident. But in another instance, when the Amalekites came to fight, God did not tell them the same way. He did not tell them that you can be still and He will fight for them. Instead, he asked them to gather the people, go for the war and promised them that he will give them victory. We should be ready to get into any of these actions as per God's instructions. Now, they had a major challenge - on one side was the Red Sea, and another side was the Pharaoh's Army. The Israelites were held up in between the wilderness and could not escape easily. In spite of the sea roaring



in front of them and Pharaoh's army rushing at the back, God asked them to stay still. Then the Lord said to Moses, ***"Why are you crying out to me? Tell the Israelites to move on"*** (Exodus 14:15).

"Raise your staff and stretch out your hand over the sea to divide the water so that the Israelites can go through the sea on dry ground". (Exodus 14:16)

God did not instruct Moses ahead about his plan to part the Red Sea. Only at that instant, God asked him to raise his staff so that the sea will divide and allow them to walk through. The waters were divided and the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left for up to 25 to 30 metres height. The pillar of cloud also moved from in front and stood behind them, coming between the armies of Egypt and Israel. This was the special privilege for Israelites because they were the chosen generation. God placed a boundary by means of the pillar of cloud so that the enemies cannot touch or overpower them. God who led them, in the same manner will stand amidst us and Satan too in our daily challenges. He will speak against Satan, 'They are my children, redeemed and blessed generation, I have delivered them out of the Sin of Egypt'. No evil can touch us! Do not be afraid! Who can overpower you? We will be secure as long as we walk in His ways. God will fight for us!

My dear beloved daughter and son, are you afraid of something which is pressing in your mind today? Jesus says, 'I am with you, why do you have to be afraid?' The resurrected Jesus is yours today and forever! When you submit yourself to him in faith, there will be great peace and joy. God will fight for you and give you the victory! ●

Comforter!



In our lifetime, during the days of our youth, we remain the most productive, and are bold enough to achieve our dreams and passions. One's youth days are always filled with great enthusiasm. We will feel soaring high like eagles, and we like doing things swiftly. These things denote the power and capability of a youth. But paradoxically, the things which are being started enthusiastically by the youths don't see the finish line often. The main reason for this is discouragement. The common question which usually arises in a youth's heart is this, "What should I do next?" Seeing the circumstances around, and facing failures, the youths most often get discouraged and give up. If in case, you are also going through a season of discouragement as a result of a failure, disappointment or fear about your future, to strengthen you, God the Father has sent the Comforter. "He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength" (Isaiah 40:29).

WHO IS THIS COMFORTER?

The Holy Spirit is the Comforter who came from God the Father to dwell with us through Jesus Christ. A child may love being with the father, but the child will always look for the mother when he/she has a weakness. The mother's loving warmth and touch will bring comfort to the child. The Lord shows Himself as a mother in many places. David's father Jesse, well-educated his seven sons except David, to make them join Israel's army. But he sent David into the work of a shepherd, which was despised by all. Not only that, but David was also hated by his father and brothers. David was hated by his family to the extent that it was hidden to him about the visit of Prophet Samuel to his house who was famous throughout from Dan to Beersheba. Maybe even David's mother could have left him unattended or David could have thought that this situation would not have come if he had a mother! But the Lord in whom he trusted neither abandoned nor hated him. The Lord would have surely comforted David when he was grazing his sheep in the wilderness on his own. That is why David tells of his experience as, "When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take care of me" (Psalm 27:10). Even you, who are reading this may be hated by your siblings, your own relatives, despised like David, and have no one to comfort or encourage, and your heart may be yearning for words of



comfort for many days. The Lord Jesus Christ now looks at you and says, "As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you..." (Isaiah 66:13).


Sometimes, even a mother who has carried the child 10 months in her womb and given birth can forget her child. But the Lord never forgets us. The Lord says, "Can a woman forget her nursing child, and not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, yet I will not forget you." (Isaiah 49:15). There were many disappointment, hatred, sorrows, and insults in the life of Joseph when he was running towards the vision. He was pushed into a situation where even the men who benefited from Joseph could not help him. How could Joseph have overcome all this? You must be thinking, "Wouldn't he be discouraged?" Discouragement would have come. But the Lord, who was with Joseph, comforted him. That is why no matter how many struggles he faced in his life, he was able to achieve the vision beyond all of them.

The disciples who were to carry the Gospel around the world were discouraged after the crucifixion of Jesus. To build up and encourage the discouraged disciples, for 40 days Jesus appeared to them and encouraged them to stay on the path to their vision. "He presented himself alive to them after his suffering by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God" (Acts 1:3).

Eagle

There are eight types of eagles. It has large eyes, sharp pointed and curvy beak, strong clawed legs and long widened wings. The eagle's food habit is different from that of other birds. This month let us discuss about, "The Eagle".


THE NATURE OF THE EAGLE:

It has more strength in its legs than its hand. It has a sharp eyes with lincredible visual acuity.

On seeing its prey, it swoops down very fast and takes it at its feet and eats it. Can identify its prey from a height higher than a plane. Its average speed is 150 km/h. Its flying speed is about 200 km/h from top to bottom to catch its prey.

EAGLE'S GROWING METHOD:

The eagle builds its nest on the rock or peak where it is not easily accessible by anyone. It stacks the hardwood logs on the mounds and fix them with fibers to prevent them from slipping and spreads very soft material like cotton on top and forms like a mattress. Initially the chicks will grow in that luxurious nest. Once it is fully grown, the mother eagle will remove the soft material little by little. Now it puts coarse sticks in the nest for the chicks, to get them acquainted to a harder lifestyle. Now the mother eagle will disperse her nest completely and push the chicks out as the wings have partially developed. When they begin to stumble and fall to the ground, the mother eagle flies down in the last moment, carrying its young chicks on its wings again



and leaves them in her nest. The chicks falling down and the eagle carrying them in its wings happens several times. Eventually its chicks will start flying due to this exercise.

If you want to reach to higher places like the eagle, we need this kind of training, so acknowledge this kind of training in Christ our Father. You too can fly high.

THE ZEAL OF THE EAGLE:

The lifespan of an eagle is 40 years but by its zeal it can live up to 70 years. When it reaches 40 years old, it loses all of its strength by gaining more fat and weight. It makes a decision in that situation of being weak. It decides if it wants to live or die. It goes to the top of a mountain with extreme resolution and remains in a nest there for about 5 months (about 150 days). Then it hits its beak against the rock, again and again to break it. Few days later, the beak will start to grow. It breaks the nail of its feet with its new beak. As new nails grow, it snatches away all the feathers from its wings using the nail. Then it too grows and loses all of its weight. It takes 150 days of rigorous training to be renewed and live 30 more years, younger with new strength.

When the eagle achieves such things with its zeal, how is your zeal as a teenager? In life, we may also come across life or death circumstances. If you, like an eagle in such a situation, wait zealously at the Lord's feet, you can, of course, gain new life and easily succeed in all that comes against you ●

Kalpana Saroj was born in a very poor family in Vidarbha region of Maharashtra. Though her family is big, their income was meagre. Although poverty was on one side, Kalpana was not allowed to play with the kids nearby her house as she was from a very backward community. Even in schools she was not allowed to sit with her classmates. While Kalpana's little heart was struggling with such things, another incident happened in their life that shocked Kalpana. Even before knowing the meaning of marriage and family, she was pushed into child marriage when she was doing her 7th grade. Another dreadful incident fell on Kalpana's head before she could even think that the marriage has taken place. There were 10 people in the house where Kalpana got married. Kalpana was beaten and



kicked for every little mistake she did. Seeing this, Kalpana's father said it's enough for her to live there and brought Kalpana to his house.

Kalpana was there in her dad's house. Then she started applying for jobs as she decided not to be a burden to anyone. Since her age and her educational qualification were too low, she was not offered any job. 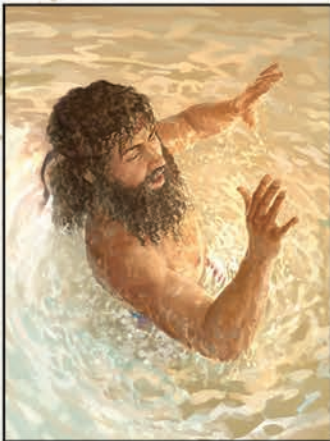
LITTLE GIRL ON THE MISSION TO SAVE SOULS

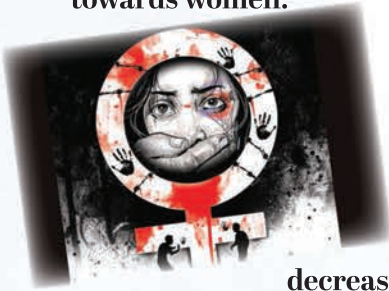

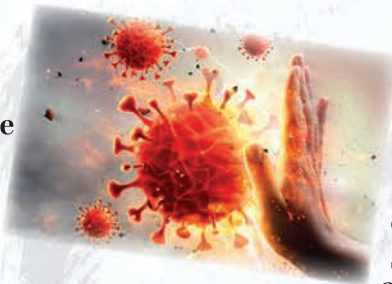

A JOURNEY WITH PETER...

Are you ready to travel with Peter? Then, come on! Hop on soon! The ship is going with the disciples to Capernaum which is on the other side of the shore. (Matthew 14: 22,23, Mark 6:47 - 51, John 6: 16 - 21). Just think how would it be if you really got an opportunity to travel with Jesus and His disciples in the boat. With that thought, can we continue our journey with Peter now?

THE BELIEF AND DISBELIEF

According to Roman understandings, it is 3 hours that make what is referred to as "Jaamam" in Tamil.

That particular time was 3am to 6am in morning. The waves were all high by the shores of the Sea of Galilee. With the harsh winds, the sea kept wavering hard, and the journey in the sea became hard. The disciples who were in the boat which was struggling in the middle of the sea panicked even more. With the fear of death and questions like "Would we survive? Or would we not?" they look out and see Jesus calmly

walking over the sea. When we expect them to give up their stress and relax now that they have seen Jesus, the disciples who got the authority to cast away evil spirits (Matthew 10:1), didn't think through that it was Jesus but instead they hastily panic thinking that it was an evil spirit.

Jesus understood their heart feelings and asked them not to fear and also to be bold. From then we don't know where Peter got his bravery from, he asks Jesus to command him to come walking over water if it is Him. The tension he had all the while vanished all of a sudden, and he became cool, and now he wants to do something that defies gravity and something that is not possible to be done by a human. As a true disciple of Jesus, and with a curiosity in heart, he wants to walk on water like Jesus. None of the other disciples had the desire to walk on water. The desire of Peter, the way he asks for permission, and his faith in Jesus differentiate him from others and show



him special. One of the characters that we should notice about Peter is that he changes his mind immediately like a child. The one who stepped out of the boat with bravery and started walking on the water looking at Jesus was shaken up with disbelief

when he felt the harsh wind and the high tides that were out of the ordinary. He starts to feel surprised and also doubts if he was walking on water, and that made him drown.

However, with faith that Jesus will not give up on him, he calls on Jesus to save him. Because of his doubt, Jesus calls him a poor believer. However, Jesus' loving hands held him, and after they got on the boat, the wind goes down. This incident tells us how Peter's faith wavers just like the tides of the sea.

PETER'S REPORT ABOUT JESUS

Jesus looked at His disciples, about how people are identifying Him to be. (Matthew 16:13 - 23, Mark 8:27 - 29, Luke 9: 18 - 20). Even though as a response there were a lot of answers like, John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah and several other prophets, Peter responds saying that He was the son of the living God. The Hebrew name for the Greek word Christ, is Messiah. The Jews were waiting expecting that the Messiah would come and save them from the Romans' rule. Since Jesus didn't come from the royal lineage or with a good troop, they did not accept Him as Christ. So, they had told that whoever calls Jesus as the Christ will have to leave from their religion. (John 9:22) But, Peter was the first person to call Jesus as the Christ in front of everyone boldly, and this delighted the heart of Jesus. While this is not expressed in flesh and blood,



but the Heavenly Father chose to express this to Peter among all the other disciples, Jesus said that he was blessed. Also, Jesus only told Peter that "He will build His church on that stone", which is God's plan about

Jesus. Also, for Peter to work on this plan, He gives him the special doors of Heaven which is a special blessing.

Peter uses this and starts preaching Jesus to the Jews who killed Jesus. In His one-day sermon, a lot of people (3000, 5000) accepted Jesus

and got baptized. (Acts 2:14 - 41,

4:4). He also preached to the Romans at the house of Cornelius, and they were baptized. (Acts 10). Also, with a lot of miracles and signs, he made a lot of Christians believe in Jesus. If one sinner is reconciled, there is great happiness in Heaven, so, when Peter led three thousand and five thousand of people through salvation, there must have been a great celebration in Heaven and Jesus' name would have been glorified greatly.

PETER BEING SCOLDED

All the disciples understood who Jesus was and therefore, Jesus expresses the whole plan that God has for Him which includes the pain, the crucifixion and the resurrection on the third day to all His disciples. Peter who received the revelation of the Father was praised to be blessed a while back, and was considered superior over other disciples. But he expresses his own opinion instead of God's will. Since he changed his thoughts immediately, Jesus scolded him saying that he is not thinking according to God, but according to humans ●

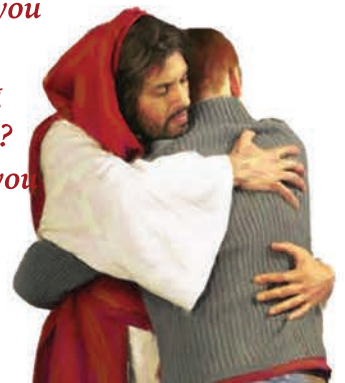


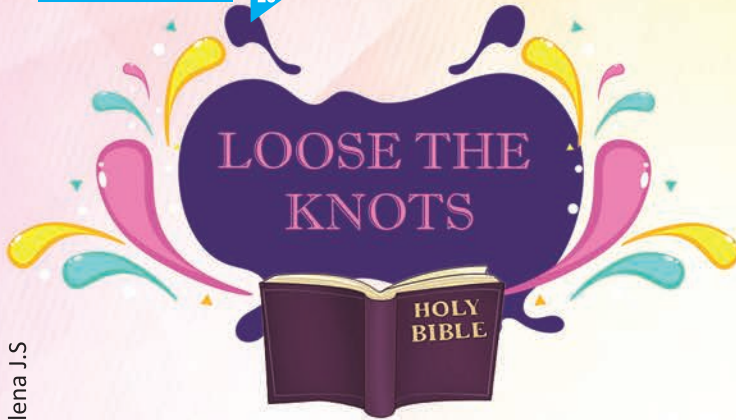
of the world. You will get a better job than this. Try not to give up and move on" said my mom. I felt comforted.

BAN ON PLASTIC MATERIAL FROM JULY 1: UNION GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

The Government has banned plastic products from July 1. It has been warned that stern action will be taken if this is violated.

Plastic products are extremely harmful to promote climate change. In this regard, “The Union Ministry of Environment and Climate Change”, said in a statement issued yesterday that the production, import, storage, distribution, sale and use of single-use plastic products identified by the Union Government in August 2021, will be banned from July 1. For example, the ban includes plastic ear buds, plastic flags, ice cream cups, straws, spoons, magazines, cigarette butts and plastic and PVC banners below 100 microns.

The order will come into effect from July 1. These items must be cleared out by June 30 from merchant shops, petty shops, shopping malls and movie theatres. If these are found to be stockpiled or distributed, the relevant places will be sealed and appropriate penalty will be imposed.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF NEW NUMBER ‘1930’ FOR PUBLIC COMPLAINTS REGARDING CYBER CRIMES

A new number ‘1930’ has been announced on by the Cyber Crime Police to report cyber-crimes.

Cyber-crimes are on the rise in Tamil Nadu. The Tamil Nadu Police is making a number of drastic changes as by the orders of Chief Minister, M K Stalin to control it. District wise cyber police stations have been started throughout Tamil Nadu. Through this, immediate action is being taken against bank frauds and cyber-crimes in Tamil Nadu.

On that regard, the cyber-crime police have changed to the new number of 1930 instead of the already existing 24-hour emergency number ‘155260’. When any bank fraudulence is reported to this new number, the cyber-crime police will immediately contact the bank concerned and action will be taken to prevent fraudulent persons from withdrawing money by blocking the fraudulent bank account immediately. Thus, this emergency number will serve useful to protect the public money from fraudulent persons.
