An interview with Sister Sri Lakshmi, who was born into a family that does not know Christ, who was saved by God's love, and who today has given up her dream and her ambition and is working on God's will. Testimony Jishya

Tell us about your childhood - I was born as the second child of Kodanda Raman and Mohanavadivu. I have a brother named Harish. He works as a Designing engineer. through the ninth standard quarterly examination. From that day on, I began to pray and read daily that the Lord would give me wisdom. God helped me to score 500 marks out of 500 and get first place. It was then that I realized what a powerful and

Super, you passed the 10th standard public exam with good marks... Similarly, have you been able to continue to excel in studies?

When I was in class II, I was very weak because of the lack of immunity in my body. I was unable to concentrate properly on my studies due to frequent weaknesses. One day my teacher asked me, "You are so weak, will you be able to write the exam?" Having been without any fear until then, this question brought a great fear in me after hearing

this question. I was very afraid that I would not be able to write the exam. It was then that I came to know that the Achievers meeting was taking place in Coimbatore and attended it. God has not only freed me from all my fears, but He has also completely changed my weakness. After that, God helped me to study well and write the

exam and get 1159/1200 marks and 200/200 marks in Mathematics.

Super... God was with you in your weakness... You also studied higher secondary school... Can you continue to tell me about your college life?

I was praying about which college to study in and what course to study in. It was my wish to study medicine in CMC College, become a doctor and

serve the Lord. That year, a law was enacted that only if the NEET exam was cleared, one could get admission to a medical college. God helped me study well for the NEET exam and write the exam. Since there was a delay in the medical counseling that year, I

applied to study Agriculture on the advice of my parents. I got a seat to study Agri at Thanjavur Government Agricultural College and started studying in that college. But since my medical dream was going on one side, I kept telling everyone that I would definitely become a doctor and get a seat in a medical college. This is how the days went by. One day, while I was praying, God revealed that it was God's will that I should study Agri course. It was very difficult for me to surrender myself to the will of the Lord. Because I don't like Agri, and I don't know what it is. But I realized that it was far more important to agree with the will of the Lord than my will. Knowing that if I did not submit to the will of the Lord, it would grieve the Lord, and eventually, I gave up my medical dream and surrendered to the will of the Lord. It was very difficult at first. Forgetting my plan for myself, I began to pray to Jesus, saying, "Please give me the grace to surrender myself completely to you." The Lord gave me the grace. You might have finished school or college and be waiting for your next step in life, or you might be puzzled if you can reach the goals you always aspired for. Despite her humble background, she was determined to become an athlete from the age of 13 and started working towards it. She didn't let her poverty or family situation hinder her growth. She eventually became the most famous athlete of India because of her strong will and determination. She participated in the inter-state athletic competition and ran in the 100 metre race,



without being intimidated by fellow athletes like Himadas and Dutee Chand, and won it. She also broke (23.26)the 23-year record of PT Usha (23.305) in 200 metres and drew the attention of the entire nation.

She is the best example to show that everything is possible with hardwork and determination.

Even in your life, when you're heading towards a goal, you will face obstacles like Jericho. Don't be disheartened by them. No matter how many obstacles come your way, you can reach your goal only by running forward without getting distracted. To attain success, you need patience and faith, because, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes." (Mark 9:23). Joseph, who had great dreams about his life at the age of 17, faced contrasting situations in his life and his own family opposed him. Nobody understood him. In the early days of my ministry, I went to a village that was located

went to a village that was located near to my neighbouring town Nazareth. The lay preacher of the church there asked me if we can go and pray for a family there who were facing tough times in their life. When we both went there, we saw a mother and her daughter-in-law having a

baby in her lap. Their face was too sad and worried. The sister was too sad. At that time, the Holy Spirit guided me to speak to them.

I said them that there is a big distress in the family that is burdening their hearts and asked them to share with me so that I can pray for them. The sister was crying bending down. The mother began to speak. "Sir! She's is my daughter-in-law. My

son works for meagre wages available. They already have two kids and this is the third one. Because of poverty we are unable to give proper food even for our first two kids. We are running a life with the meagre wages my son brings home. In these difficult times, we are wondering how are we going to raise

a third child? We are discussing that if we can give this child to someone else. "You have a Bible. You believe in Jesus Christ. Then where is your faith?", I asked them. Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. See how the flowers of the field grow. If God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not clothe you. So do not worry about tomorrow. See how Jesus had said such wonderful things and written them for our daily needs. Do you not have faith in Him? Do you

not believe His words? Do you not believe that the Lord who gave this child will give the blessing to clothe the child?", the mother began to weep hearing these.

He is the Lord who fed 30 lakh people and led them in the wilderness for 40 years without any deficits. Did God say that He cannot

feed the third child? Did He say that he would be able to dress up only the first two kids and not the third one? Did He say that He does not have money in heaven to save the third child? What faith do we have on Him? Do you not have a concerned Father who feeds you, dresses you, provide your needs, concerned about you and even knows the number of hairs in your head? Where did your faith go? Will I not give you a job? Will I not help you in business? Will I not provide education to your kids? Will I not feed your children? Will I not meet your needs to do ministry? I can do everything. It's because of your unfaithfulness you did not receive these. The Lord says that you are in doubt, in a state of fear and drowning because you look into the situation without looking for me. Tell to God that you trust Him. His guidance will be entirely different.

When I surrendered to God's ministry in the year 1974, I said to Him that I will come only with the Bi-

ble, I will not ask even a penny from my mother and father or any other people and I will not seek others for my food, dress and my needs. I said to Him that I am His responsibility. God looked at me and said, "Do not worry about tomorrow. I will meet your daily needs, feed you and dress you. You need not seek men for these. I will guide you." I said I believe in You Lord and surrendered to His ministry. My father and mother were wealthy. But when I stepped into ministry I neither received nor asked a penny to my parents. I did not do this ministry trusting men nor their offerings. I came

trusting the word of God who is my Father, my Master and my everything. To this day He has not let me down.

In the last few months we have seen many things about the types of prayer. Accordingly, we trust in the Lord that you all have dedicated yourself to prayer. If you, as a teenager reading this, have not been able to pray for at least an hour in the presence of the Lord and are eager to pray, this section is for you.

How to pray for an hour? Why should we pray? In five minutes I've finished praying for all things. How am I going to pray for an hour? Are you saying like this! We will continue to look at how to try this. Also, we encourage you to start the first hour of the day in the Lord's presence. Early Morning Prayer is the best.

PREPARATION!

Previous day preparation

▶ Preparation is essential for any endeavor. The night before the morning prayer, you need to prepare your mind and body, you need to give your body the rest it needs without wasting time at night. (EARLY TO BED, EARLY TO RISE).

▶ Decide what time to get up early in the morning and pray, "Lord, help me to get up early in the morning in this particular time and pray ..." If possible, set the alarm and go to bed.

Preparations to be made after waking up early in the morning

• Do not kneel on the bed as you wake up. Getting out of bed is the first thing we need to do.

▶ Brush your teeth, wash your face and get ready. Because, never forget that you are not going to meet an ordinary worldly person, but the Almighty God who created the entire universe with His single word.

• Set aside a room or a corner for regular prayer and practice praying in the same place everyday.

• Before you begin to pray in the morning, your scripture should be with you for sure. The reason is that during prayer you not only talk to the Lord, you must give the Lord space to talk to you.

How to pray for one hour?

Divide your one hour prayer time into three parts. First 15 minutes: Praise and give thanks Next 15 minutes: Meditate the scriptures! Next 30 minutes: Pray!

We will see more about this in the next month's issue. So get up early in the morning and try to make the necessary preparations to pray. Have a relationship with the Supreme God who is still alive even today

Stephenson's Perseverence

Our wishes to the young achievers who are working day and night swiftly to achieve their goals. Opportunities can come knocking at your door anytime, anywhere. It may be small or big. Anyone who puts aside the available

opportunities, citing them as too small, and waiting for the bigger opportunity may miss the available opportunity and may not be able to achieve. It does not matter how big the opportunity is, all that matters is our ability to execute it. So take advantage of any opportunity you get, and then you can achieve it. Now, let us see about the fascinating life of an achiever who used the opportunities well in his life and achieved.

Sean Stephenson was born on May 5, 1979, in Chicago. He was not born like a normal child. His family did not greet him happily when he was born. Stephenson was born with a disease called Osteogenesis Imperfecta, also known as "Brittle Bone Disease". His bones had no



strength and were very weak. Both of his legs got broke when he was born. The doctors, who examined him, told Stephenson's parents that he would be dead in 48 hours. But luckily Stephenson did not die. Days passed by and he was admitted in

a school near his home. None of his classmates at school were willing to befriend him. When he was in his ninth grade, his legs got stuck between the doors and got injured. Because of this injury, he was not able to go to school for a few days. When Stephenson returned

back to school after recovery, his class teacher asked him to share about his disease and how he recovered from his injury with his fellow classmates. Stephenson gladly accepted the opportunity and was happy to share it with his classmates. He had good clarity in his speech and all the students who listened to his speech enthusiastically applauded him.

> At the age of 17, Stephenson got an opportunity to give a motivational speech on a big stage. Everyone who heard his speech was inspired and gave him a great round of applause. Their

applause encouraged him even more. After this, he started thinking about making, Motivational Speech as his career. He not only began to think, but also to execute it. He started travelling to many

places along with a foundation named "Makea-Wish" and gave many motivational speeches. On the other side, as he grew older, he suffered many fractures in his body. By the time he was 18, he had suffered more than 200 fractures. Because of this situation, he could not even bite and chew even the delicate foods. When travelling in a car, he will always travel in a separate seat allocated for him. Seeing Stephenson's condition, his mother questioned him asking why he is struggling so much by travelling and giving motivational speeches despite his sickness. He replied to his mother that it is an achievement that he has been alive now for 22 years when doctors pronounced that he would not survive 48 hours while he was born and told his mother that he will continue to be an achiever.

In 1998, Stephenson met Tony Robinson, one of the greatest motivational speakers. Robinson encouraged him, saying that his speeches are good, and gave him tips to better understand people's moods and their interests while giving motivational speeches. Thus Stephenson decided to pursue a degree in Political Science to improve himself. While still studying, he got an opportunity to work as an intern for President Bill Clinton. Stephenson wrote a book in 2001 and published it. The name of the book is "How You(th) Can Succeed!" This book got a very good reception among the youths. Wanting to study again, Stephenson graduated as a Therapist from the Bennett University. As he was much interested in learning new things,



he studied Neuro-Linguistic. Stephenson got an opportunity to work as a therapist at the Pacific University, where he studied a course, and began working there with a high salary. He was invited to give

motivational speeches at many schools and colleges. He was paid between 15,000 and 30,000 dollars an hour. His motivational speeches encouraged and inspired many. Stephenson had a dream of starting an orphanage for a long time. Seeing many differently-abled persons without parents to take care, he started an orphanage to give them a better life.

When Stephenson was asked how he became an achiever, here are three things he said

CUTTING OFF THE EAR OF PETER MALCHUS

That Thursday night, Peter, who was sleeping in the garden of Gethsemane, suddenly saw hundreds of soldiers with bonds, torches and weapons, and the servants of the High Priest, Pharisees, falling asleep and catching up with fear, horror, and anxiety. Jesus boldly asks who he is looking for. The answer came from the midst of the great army that said "Jesus of Nazareth". Unable to bear the power of what Jesus said, "I am Jesus", they all lean back and fell to the ground. They were also given an opportunity to know that the person they had come to arrest was not an ordinary person, but a man of great power in words. Even in such a situation, Peter was amazed that Jesus spoke calmly and boldly, without fear or confusion. But knowing the mood of the disciples, Jesus repeats that He is Jesus and asks them to let His disciples go. When a man faces problems and overcomes difficult situations. He would want to save himself from his predicament and not those

close to him. But Jesus, not afraid of death, stands up boldly and tries to send His disciples safely to their homes so that His circumstance does not affect them.

> Peter was moved by Jesus' divine nature, His love for His disciples, and His earnest efforts to protect them in that context. Desperate to save Jesus from getting arrested, He cuts off the right ear of Malchus, the High Priest's servant. Fishermen usually have the habit of cutting

the pectoral fins of the fish that looks like a ear, and in the same habit, Peter cuts off the ear of Malchus. Anger, courage, and love for Jesus in front of Peter caused him to do so. Peter did not seek to kill the servant, even though he was afraid and nervous in his heart and had a sword in his hand. He tries to prevent the process of arrest with restraint, yet he obeys Jesus' command and puts the sword in the sheath. A disciple betrays Jesus with a kiss. I don't know where the other disciples went. The fact that Peter alone stood alone and cut off Malchus' ear among all the warriors for Jesus, along with Jesus, shows that Peter was special.

PETERS BETRAYAL OF JESUS

This event is written in the four Gospels of the New Testament as an important event (Matthew 26:58, 69-74; Mark 14:54,66-72; Luke 22:54-62; John 18:15-18, 24-27). Peter

could not bear to see Jesus being arrested and taken away. All the other disciples fled from Jesus (Matthew 26:56). His mind was wondering what would happen to Jesus, so he followed Jesus in the distance, sitting with his servants in the palace courtyard of Caiaphas the High Priest, cooling down. And one of the maidservants of the High Priest said, "You also was with Jesus the Nazarite." Immediately Peter denies for the first time before all men, saying, I do not know, I do

not know what you say. Immediately the cock crows. But out of fear and confusion in Peter's mind, Peter did not notice it. He comes back to the door and sits down. Another servant; When he says that he was with Jesus of Nazareth, he denies the man a second time and swears that he does not know him. And when the people who stood nearby said, "Surely you art one of them, and you are a Galilean, and your speech is like it," he began to curse, and swear, saying, I know not the man which you talk about, and denied it the third time. The cock crowed a second time, and it is only now that Peter remembers the word that Jesus said. And the LORD turned and looked at Peter. Peter could not bear the sight. He becomes a heartbroken. He goes out in search of a place to cry alone, and he feels sorry for his actions. He immediately reconciles.

Perhaps if they had run away like the other disciples and were hiding somewhere, such a trial would not have come. But the mouth, which said that he would not deny even if he had to die with you, had forgotten Jesus three times. But unlike Judas, he did not seek death out of a guilty conscience. He asks Jesus for forgiveness, revives his relationship with Him again, and returns to normalcy, not allowing

him to take on a guilty conscience.

Until then, neither the other disciples nor Peter had the experience of being born again by the Holy Spirit. They did not receive the Holy Spirit until they were blew upon them after Christ's resurrection (John 20:22) and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit." Jesus says "That when

the Holy Spirit comes to you, you will be witnesses to me in Judea, Samaria, and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8), in the same house Annas and Caiaphas where Peter denied Jesus, in front of them, Peter boldly thunders by the power of the Holy Spirit: 'Jesus christ, who was crucified by you' (Acts 4:6,10). Therefore, rather than saying that Peter's repudiation was an act of iniquity, it can be said that his weakness is the cause ■

Nice to meet you again with the Red Alert series. In recent days, a lot of news, sermons, and songs released are mostly focused on blessings. In today's segment, we will reflect on God's chosen people, whose minor mistakes and distractions from God's plan by disobeying led to terrible fates, and we will learn from them as warning messages to correct ourselves. Last time, we meditated on Absalom who was ambitious to meet the throne. This time, we are going to learn from the life of King Saul who was anointed as the first King of Israel.

When God chose Saul, he chose someone humble, God-fearing, and even prophesied. According to the Bible, despite being a nice person, God rejected him and regretted making him King. Let us find out why Saul's promising start ended appallingly?

TO PLEASE MEN, HE UPSET GOD

In 1 Samuel 13, while Saul had ruled for two years, the Philistines assembled to fight against Israel (1 Samuel 13:5). They were huge in numbers. Saul was waiting for Samuel to pray and offer the burnt offering to God to lead the war. But, Samuel did not show up at the set time of seven days, on the other side some men from Saul's side began to scatter. In this obscure situation, Saul took the wrong decision. On seeing the men scatter, he decided to offer the burnt offering himself which a priest must only offer.

God may have put Saul into this obscure situation to test whether he relies on Him. But instead of counting on God and believing Him, he did what seemed the good relying on his wisdom and strength but was immor-

> al in the eyes of God. And so, God's wrath was over him and his generations, that they cannot endure the kingdom again.

Israel is the Lord's country. There is a difference between how

other kings rule their countries and how the King of Israel rules Israel. The King of Israel must believe in the Lord, trust only Him and obey His words. Only then he can lead the country in Lord's way otherwise the country will fall apart from Lord. Only when we rely on, believe in, trust, and obey the Lord in our God-given work, family, ministry, and studies we will be able to carry out God's





plan. We will fail and be disappointed if we rely solely on our strengths.

G.S.T COUNCIL'S RECOMMENDATION CANNOT CONTROL STATE GOVERNMENT: SUPREME COURT!

New Delhi: G.S.T council's recommendation cannot control state government. Central and State government has equal rights in taxation says the court. Goods and Service Tax (G.S.T) is considered to be an effective change in taxation for a long term. It lays some indirect tax; it is effective from 1st July 2017. It aims to become a standard goods and service tax. Its ultimate goal is to simplify the services and goods taxation for the businesses. It provides more chances to reduce the taxation. There are four types of GST, Central Goods and Service Tax (CGST), State Goods and Service Tax (SGST), Integrated Goods and Service Tax(IGST), Union Territory Goods and Service Tax-(UTGST).

A committee of 33members has been formed under the supervision of central finance minister, Nirmala Sitharaman to form GST rules. The duty of the GST council is to determine the basic percentage, to suggest the maximum tax exemption in goods and services and much more. From the day of introduction, they have been conducting meeting in Delhi and other states. Finance ministers of all the states will participate in it. Many important decisions are passed in this meeting and the state governments are forced to follow it.

In this situation, a private organisation in Gujarat, filed a case in High Court. It states 'G.S.T council forces the state government to follow its decision. It is unacceptable'. The High Court that investigated the case ordered the state government to follow the GST council's decision and cancelled the integrated tax on the ocean freight.

Against this order, they further appealed to the Supreme court. Last week this case was postponed without mentioning the date. In this situation, panel led by Justice Chandrachud gave their judgement stating GST council's recommendation cannot control central and the state government. GST council's recommendation is only up to a trustable mark. Moreover India is a country that functions on the basis of cooperative federalism.

Judgement was written stating 'Indian constituency law gives and empowers the central government with cooperative federalism only to avoid confusion. We must understand democracy and federalism are dependant on each other. Moreover, both the parliament and the state legislatures have equal rights in passing laws on GST. So, the GST council's recommendation should not be forced on the state governments' – Dinakaran 19th May 2022.

Central government plans to rise GST on online games and horse race betting from 18% to 28%!!

Delhi: Central government's ministry has recommended to rise the GST of online games, casino, horse race betting from 18% to 28%. GST council's meeting is expected to be held in the upcoming days; recommendations related to this can be filed says the sources. There is 18% GST for entertainment games such as horse race, casino, online cricket, poker and rummy now. The central government has decided to increase the GST of online games. It has formed a panel of 8 members led by Meghalaya's Chief Minister, Conrad Sangma. The panel set for online games, horse race and casino discussed in Delhi on increasing the GST for online games. Based on their recommendation the central government has decided to increase the GST for online games from 18% to 28%. The corrected procedure and the final report regarding this will be submitted to finance minister, Nirmala Sitharaman. It is expected that there will be a reduce in the number of online gamers after increasing its GST.
