Tell us about your childhood and family...

I was born to Mr. Samuel Manohar and Mrs. Dominic Sorna Arokkiyam as the second daughter of the couple, in Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli district. I have a brother named lose lsaac. He is working in Chennai. My father was a member of the C.S.I. congregation. My mother belonged to the Roman Catholic Church. Since childhood my mother took us to the R.C. church and brought us up in that tradition. I would go the church to regularly every week. But I lived without any connection with

Jesus. I was living a worldly life where I did not read the scriptures and did not pray. My childhood was spent watching movies and listening to cinema songs. As my father was saved, he would ask me to read the scriptures and pray. But I never listened to him then.

Well... you told us about your childhood... now tell us about your studies...

I would always be one among the top three in school. I have won prizes in essay writing,



poetry and painting competitions. But I had no peace in my life. It was full of problems and suffering. I used to long for friends and friendship. But there were only disappointments and tears. I have no friends since childhood. No one would ever befriend

me because my qualities do not match theirs.

You were good at your studies and that's wonderful..!! You said you had no friends since childhood... How did you come to know about Jesus?

Since my father was saved and belonged to a CSI church he says that Jesus is the only God and idols should not be worshiped. My father prays every day since I was a child. Ever since I was in 6th grade, a sister who was our neighbor would take me to spiritual meetings and youth meetings. I was very surprised to see them praying there. I started praying and reading the scriptures from 8th standard. But I know nothing about salvation. I lived a worldly life. My

Even though he was a poor shepherd, he was never hesitant to bravely share the words God gave him to the people or to the court. Amos is an example to us that God can use anybody from any position.

that they are more experienced and knowledgeable compared to their husband. It will cause disruption of the state of oneness within the family. Besides, it causes a huge hindrance to obey and to be submissive.

Today's culture and environment, doesn't deem these age limits. People speak of equality, modern thinking, new culture and many such things. But, all these things never work out in reality. 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hearts. Apart from this he is the only Indian player to win the "ICC One Day International Player of the Year award" twice for 2008-2009. He also won Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna, Padma Shri and Padma Vibhushan Awards. Though Dhoni had a dream of becoming the best goalkeeper in the world of football, he yielded him to his coach's advice and allowed him to shape his future. A good potter doesn't throw away the marred clay, instead he takes it in his hand and turns it into a useful vessel. Likewise, the Lord can restore your broken life. When David sinned and marred his life, God didn't leave him to perish. He sent Nathan to David to point out his mistakes. David realized his mistakes and said. "I have sinned against the Lord." (2 Samuel 12:13) Once David repented for his mistake, God rebuilt his marred life. When you stop worrying about your past sinful life, realize your mistakes like David and yield yourself to the Lord to mould and make you, he can rebuild your life!

If yielding oneself to the advice of a man in the world can bring about such a massive elevation, when you yield your life to the counsel of the Lord who created you, he will make you as a useful vessel for everyone. You might have ambitions as big as Dhoni, but struggling to achieve them, or maybe broken and fainthearted. No matter what, surrender your life to him and he will mould and make you. Are you worried thinking, 'Will my fallen life flourish

My dear youths! When you give yourself into the hands of the Lord to be moulded according to his will, not setting a self-aligned goal and running towards it, not worrying about your ruined life, just as a clay yields itself to the potter's hands, He will mould you as a vessel of great use and honor!!

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Things that Please God

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"Teach me to do your will." -(Psalm 143:10).

Many times, we ask unto God all that pleases us. God listens to our prayers, takes heed of our wishes and grants our requests. But David prays a beautiful prayer to God 'Teach me to do your will' which means 'I would love to do what is pleasing to you'. In every instance of David's life, we see that David inquires of the Lord like, 'Can I do this battle?' 'Shall I go to the war?' Can I undertake a particular endeavour?' and acts accordingly by knowing God's will and wish. That's why God acknowledged him as 'a man after my own heart (Acts 13:22).' We too should focus on doing what pleases him. Let us meditate on four things that God expects of us.

HAVING FAITH

"But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him (Hebrews 11:6)." Faith is pleasing to God and it makes Him happy. When we read in Matthew 8 about the Centurion, he came to Jesus and prayed to Him about his servant who was at home suffering terribly due to paralysis. When Jesus said that He would come and heal him, the Centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed". When Jesus heard this, he was marvelled and said to those following him, "Assuredly, I



say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!" Do you have that kind of faith?

PRAYING FOR OTHERS

"Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men (1 Timothy 2:1)." Not only that, the scriptures tell us to pray for those in power so that peace, tranquillity and virtue can be found in the country. It is a thing that pleases God. "For kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, (1 Timothy 2: 2, 3)." How many of us are praying for our Chief Minister, Cabinet ministers, Collector, Thasildar, S.P and Judges in judiciary? Most of us are focussed 99% on self-centred prayers for our job, families and grandchildren. Do you pray for your classmates? Do you pray for the salvation of your colleagues? Do you pray for the residents of your neighbourhood and your district? God urges us

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to pray for everyone. Since we, Christians failed to pray, God's plan of salvation for all His people is getting delayed. When every saved Christian prays according to this verse, great revival will come upon our nation. We have failed to do what pleases God. It is because you and I have done something does not please God that we are facing such a big impact today.

GIVING CHEERFULLY

"So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver (2 Corinthians 9:7)." When Jesus went to church, he sat by the temple treasury and watched the people put their offerings. Many rich people threw in large amounts. But a poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a few cents. Calling His disciples to Him, Jesus said, "Assuredly, I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all those who have given to the treasury; When they asked how Lord? He said, for they all put in out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty put in all that she had, her whole livelihood." It's like offering ten rupees while having ten thousand rupees in hand. But this widow just had 2 coins and she put in whatever she had. She put everything away. She made the offering out of love for her Lord, who had kept her alive and protected her till now. She did not give out of obligation, or for fame but out of love. How do we give to God? The Lord sees whether we give out of love for him or out of obligation.God watches our motives behind our giving. God blesses us according to how we give.

DOING GOOD DEEDS

But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. (Hebrews 13:16). Jesus went around doing good. He helped people who were in need. We who follow Christ should also do good and benevolently help others. We read of a man named Cornelius in the



Bible. "A devout man and one who feared God with all his household, who gave alms generously to the people, and prayed to God always (Acts 10:2)." But Cornelius was not yet saved. He only knew that there was a God.

He was making all his household walk with the fear of God, always praying and doing a lot of charity. But one day, his prayers and charity to the poor done from the city of Caesarea reached heaven to the sight of God. God was mindful of him that he should be saved and anointed. Hence, He sent an angel to Cornelius to fulfil the purpose. Cornelius stared at him in fear and asked "What is it, Lord?" The angel answered, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before God (Acts 10:4)." There are 2 things which reach heaven as a memorial offering - Firstly, the prayer that you pray. It should be a prayer that comes from a clean heart. It should be a prayer that we pray according to the verse. Secondly, generous giving. When we extend a hand to help a widow, a poor child, a person who is suffering in the society, it comes as a memorial unto God in heaven.

Dear young people! Like David, we can find success in all our endeavours, when we pray and do things that are pleasing to God according to his will. Since David enquired of the Lord before he ventured into any action, he was called 'a man after God's own heart'. Can God testify about you in the same manner as 'my beloved child who is after my heart?' Try doing what pleases God. God will testify about you!

Let us pray and conquer!

Model prayer: The prayer of the Levites

As we continue to learn the importance of prayer, this month we are going to learn the special prayer that the Levites offered in the book of Nehemiah. If we take the time to meditate on Nehemiah 9:38, there are many wonderful words that can be incorporated in our prayers.

"You alone are the LORD; You have made heaven, The heaven of heavens, with all their host, The earth and everything on it, The seas and all that is in them, And You preserve them all. The host of heaven worships You." (Nehemiah 9:6). All these words of the Levites remind us of who our Lord is.

Also, He is the one who nourishes and sustains us; and when we declare that all things are under the rule of the Almighty humbles us before Him.

But are we, like the leeches asking God to "give...give..." everything that we desire?

When we read the following notes regularly and incorporate them in our personal prayers, our prayer will definitely change.

13. He has given us the Holy Spirit who rebukes and instructs (Nehemiah 9:20)

14. The One Who Specially Cares (Nehemiah 9:21)

15. He who bestows favour towards us from others (Nehemiah 9:23,24)

16. Even when we fall again and again, He lifts us up. He who has already delivered us many times according to His mercies (Nehemiah 9: 28)

17. He who reproves but remains patient. (Nehemiah 9:30)

18. He pours out His unlimited grace upon us so that we may not perish (Nehemiah 9:31)

19. He is a mighty and awesome God who graciously keeps his covenant with us. Therefore, none of our sorrows are counted as trifles before Him (Nehemiah 9:32)

20. He who never allows our labour to go in vain (Nehemiah 9:37)

There are many such things in this prayer. Today our aim is to incorporate them into our prayers as supplications, praises, humility and thanksgiving.

My dear young people, if you are currently suffering in life perhaps because of the wrong decisions you have made, repent and humble yourselves and come near to Lord Jesus Christ. He does not cast away anyone who comes to Him. God shapes you through your circumstances. Hello friends! My greetings to you all. In this fast-paced world, you might be preparing yourself to be successful or to prove yourself. To encourage you up on your journey to victory, here is a story of an achiever. I hope the life of this achiever will greatly inspire you.

Phil Knight was a track athlete in the United States of America. At the University of Oregon, he came into contact with Coach Bill Bowerman. Bowerman had a fascination to optimize his runners' shoes, constantly tinkering with different models after learning from a local cobbler. Bowerman took one of Phil's shoes and fixed them up with his custom design. Phil very much liked the customized design, and, the shoes worked so well that his teammate Otis Davis took them and ended up winning gold in the 400-meter dash in the 1960 Olympics.

After the University of Oregon, Phil graduated with a Master's degree in Business Administration from Stanford.

During his Master's degree, he wrote a paper theorizing that the production of running shoes should move from its current centre in

Germany to Japan, where labour was cheaper. He even got a chance to put this theory to test with a trip to Japan, shortly after his 1962 graduation. He struck a deal with a group of Japanese businessmen to export the country's popular Tiger shoes to the U.S.

Combining his love for running and his newly acquired business skills, along with his coach Bill Bowerman, Phil launched his shoe company called Blue



Ribbon Sports (BRS) to import highquality and low-cost running shoes from Japan into the American market. The company initially operated as a distributor for appanese shoe maker Onitsuka Tiger (now ASICS). t was а 50-50 business deal between Phil and Bowerman.

They tried to sell their shoes through the existing shoe stores in the US. But no shop came forward to buy their imported shoes. They visited several stores,



but their efforts were only in vain. They spent all their money. Thinking about what to do next, an idea struck their mind and they began to implement it. Phil and his coach loaded all the shoes they had into a car and rushed to the stadiums where sporting events occurred. They put all the sports shoes neatly in the trunk of the car and put them up for sale. This idea was warmly welcomed by





the people and it had a great reception. In 1964, in its first year in business, BRS sold 1,300 pairs of Japanese running shoes grossing \$8,000.

In 1966, BRS opened its first retail store. In 1967, due to rapidly increasing sales, BRS expanded its retail and distribution operations. By 1971, the relationship between BRS



and Japanese shoe maker Onitsuka Tiger was nearing an end. BRS prepared to launch its own line of footwear. They started making their own athletic shoes that were lightweight and in sizes that athletes wanted. Phil Knight chose a shoe factory in Mexico to manufacture his shoes.

The company changed its name from Blue Ribbon Sport (BRS)

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to Nike in 1978. The Nike Company has now grown to become а favourite sports material company. Persistence. hard work. and а relentless mind are all the reasons why Nike has become

such a great company.

Elisha

Before God called Elisha to his mission through Elijah, no one knew much about Elisha. All we know is that he was a farmer. The Lord told Elijah to raise up a prophet in his stead. While Elisha was with his servants plowing with twelve yoke of oxen before him, and he was with the twelfth, Elijah passed by him and cast his mantle upon him. Elisha therefore knew the call he had received and made a feast for the people. Elisha was not an ordinary man, but may have been a very wealthy man who owned many lands. When he received the call to serve God, he did not just go away. He informed his parents, kissed them and bid goodbye, left everything behind and followed the Lord, knowing that God is mighty to lead him. When he stepped into the ministry, he first served Elijah. Elisha learnt to minister from Elijah. Elijah, had Elisha stay with him and was the reason behind molding of Elisha. Elisha who followed Elijah, after him received double fold spiritual gifts and did double fold miracles than Elijah did. Every time as Elijah travelled to different places, he asked Elisha to stay there, but Elisha said he will not leave him and he followed Elijah wherever he went. When they came to Jordan, Elijah asked Elisha "What may I do for you, before I am taken away from you?" Elisha said, "Please let a double portion of your spirit be upon me." Even when Moses returned to the camp, Joshua did not depart from the tabernacle. Joshua was very careful with his responsibilities (Exodus 33:7, 11)

A Journey With Pa ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CHURCH AND THE FIRST SERMON OF PETER!

The word 'Pentecost' means 'the fiftieth day'. It is the second major festival celebrated annually by the Jews. It is a festival of harvest, where people offer the first fruits of their land

to God (Leviticus 23:15,16). After the resurrection of Jesus, this day marked the first baptism involving the Holy Spirit. Like the first fruits of the land, for the Church, Pentecost marks the beginning of the harvest of souls to God in the world.

Where did the church originate? Which day? Who is the head of the church? The answer to all these questions can be found in the first chapter of Acts. The first

church was started in the upper room of Jerusalem, on the first Pentecostal day, with Christ as its head and leader. The statement that Jesus told about Peter, "On this rock, I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it (Matthew 16:18)" was fulfilled that day. The number of people gathered in the first church was 120 and the first preacher was Peter, the main pillar of the early church. Peter's preaching was surprising to the people who had only seen Jesus preach

until then. Peter, who denied Jesus as he was afraid of the servant girl, who could only cut the ear of Malchus with a sword when Jesus was captured by the evil men, who was illiterate and unwitty, on the day of Pentecost, when they worshiped the Lord, after being filled with the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:4) boldly preaches in front of the people, the authorities, and the elders of Israel;

In his first sermon, he preached about repentance, baptism and leaving the wayward generation. Many accepted his message at that time. **"They were steadfast in the doctrine, fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers of the apostles.** (Acts 2:36-47)" Peter, who had received the keys of heaven from Jesus, added 3000 people to the church that day, including the ones who had crucified Jesus on the cross. Another day, 5000 people believed in Jesus because of his sermon (Acts 4:1-4) If the repentance of one sinner can cause so much joy in heaven, can words describe the joy of heaven caused by Peter when 3000 and 5000 people repent? The entire heaven would have rejoiced and celebrated Peter as the hero of the day.

PETER AND ANANIAS - SAPPHIRA (Acts 5:1-11)

The early believers comprised of both economically weak and strong people. Many children of God willingly brought their wealth to the feet of the apostle. Annania and Sapphira were the couple who were eager to use such a well-intentioned plan for their fame. They were caught lying in the presence of God and were immediately suffered punishment.



Obedience to husband is necessary, but when a woman supports him to do things that are against God, it will never end well. Sapphira's life is an example for this. While God praised the widow who gave all of her two coins as an offering, instantly reveals his judgment by a lie of the couple who sold their hereditary land and came to pay a large amount of it as offering. The root cause of Anania-Sapphira's sin was the lust for money and fame. How did Peter know the thoughts of others' heart? Both Anania and Sapphira considered Peter as an ordinary man looking at his face. Since Peter was gifted with the spirit of revelation by the Holy Spirit who was within him, discerned the thoughts of other men's hearts. God's judgment was immediately fulfilled because Peter boldly condemned their sins with the gifts of the Spirit he had. "Great fear came upon all the church and upon all who heard these things (Acts 5:11)"

PETER AND SIMON THE SORCERER (Acts 8:5-25)

The sermon of Philip made many Samaritans accept Jesus. When Peter and John heard of the Samaritans' repentance, they came to Samaria to pray for them and lay their hands on them to receive the Holy Spirit. Many were filled with the Holy Spirit because of this. Though a sorcerer named Simon believed in Jesus and was baptized, he did not seek to receive the Spirit, but desired to buy God's gift and become a wholesale merchant. As a result



of that he was cursed. Though the youths and elders of Samaria believed that Simon is the biggest form of God's power, in Peter's view he was poisoned by bitterness and was bound by iniquity. Once Peter told everything about Simon, the sorcerer got afraid, humbled himself and asked Peter to pray for him. Since the power of the Holy Spirit revealed the hidden secrets to Peter, here a sorcerer repents with fear.

In line with that today let us talk of our national bird, the "Peacock". Our national bird has a charming look with beautiful colors in its feathers. Peafowls belong to the bird family "Phasianidae". They live

in humid regions of tropical countries.

The bird 'peacock' is mentioned only in a few places in our Holy Bible. Let us continue to read some information about this bird.

• The male peafowls, called as Peacocks have beautiful long-tail. This is called as 'tail or train'. They also have a crest on their head.

▶ Peacocks are beautiful, glossy and bluish green in color. The peacock's train consists of highly elongated upper tail coverts. These feathers are marked with eyespots.

• The female peafowls, called Peahens do not have tail or train.

• A peacock spreads out its train and dances to attract a peahen.

During the rainy seasons, the peacocks in the forests of India spread their feathers and dance gracefully. This is a sight to behold. Moreover, these peacocks are considered as a symbol of luxury.

Where can we read about peacock in the Bible?

✓ It is a historical fact that, King Solomon, in order to add beauty to his palace; imported peacocks from the Indian subcontinent.

✓ Peacocks have a long term reputation. It is said that Indian kings offered peacocks as a gift to King Solomon. It denotes that in ancient times peacocks were valued as equal to gold.

Here are a few facts we need to learn for our lives from peacock:

Outward Appearance: Peacock is a beautiful bird to look at. But its voice is not sweet either. Therefore, it is not enough that people look good but the thoughts of their hearts and every word that comes out of the mouth should be sweet.

Braggadocio: Peacocks are considered to be metaphors for bragging. Among the Indian birds, peacock is said to be the most arrogant bird and has a luxurious appearance. This bird reminds us of the people who are egotistical.

Pride and arrogance are condemned in many places in our Bible. And we are warned that "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." (James 4:6).

5.83 CRORE PEOPLE HAVE FILED INCOME TAX RETURNS! 72,000 PEOPLE REGISTERED ON THE LAST DAY!

According to the official statement released, about 5.83 crore people had filed their Income Tax Returns before the deadline.

The time frame for the filing of ITR for the financial year 2021 – 2022, started in April. Every individual earning more than Rs. 2.5 lakh per annum has to file for the income tax returns. In this case, the deadline for filing income tax returns for the financial year 2021-22 ended the day before yesterday.

While speaking about the people who had missed the deadline the Income Tax Officers said that, the people with the total income that is less than Rs. 5 Lakh must pay a fine of Rs. 1,000/- . The people earning above would have to a pay a fine of Rs. 5,000/-. The ITR can be filed till 31st of December. If a person delays in filing from January to March, Rs. 10,000 must be paid as fine.

A total of about 5.83 crore people had filed their Income Tax Returns. During the last financial year, the government had extended the due date for filing the returns till the 31st of December. In the given time 5.89 crore people had filed their income returns. On the last day about 72 lakh people had filed their ITR. – **Dinakaran, 02 August, 2022.**

2ND HIGHEST GST REVENUE IN 5 YEARS! GST COLLECTIONS IN JULY AT RS 1.49 LAKH CRORE! 28% HIGHER THAN THE LAST YEAR!

Approximately 1.49 lakh crore was collected as GST in the month of July. This is 28% higher than the previous year. It is said to be the second highest revenue collected in 5 years.

he Goods and Services Tax (GST) was implemented across the country on July 2017. GST collections are increasing every month after the relaxation of corona restrictions.

In this state, the Union Finance Ministry has issued an official statement that Rs. 1.49 lakh crore revenue had been collected in July.

The gross revenue stands at Rs. 1,48,995 crore, of which CGST is Rs. 25,751 crore, SGST is Rs. 32,807 crore, IGST is Rs. 79,518 crore.

When compared to July of last year, it is said that the collected amount has increased by 28%. Moreover, in the 5 years of the inception of the GST, this is said to be second highest amount collected. In April 2022, GST collections had hit an all-time high of Rs 1.68 lakh crore. As for Tamil Nadu the GST amount collected for July is Rs. 8,449 Crore. - Dhinakaran, 02 August, 2022.
