There is no limit to the tribulations, discouragements, pains and many other disturbing situations that he faced while



proclaiming Jesus to the souls in India.

Within the very first year of their arrival to India, his family fell sick one after the other. He buried his son who died of illness with his own hands. This impacted his wife mentally and she also died later. He worked in a dying factory and simultaneously started a printing press to print the Bible. Within a few days his printing press was burnt down in a fire accident and he lost his job too. Yet, he didn't give up and he didn't run back to his native land, rather he continued his evangelistic work for 41 years and he translated Bible in India's major languages like Bengali, Ori-

ya, Marathi, Hindi and Assamese. Apart from that he translated some chapters of the Bible in 29 languages and also in dialect form. He also published a bible dictionary in Bengali. Also, being a social reformer, he strove hard to eliminate many social evil atrocities like 'Sati' a religious practice in which a widow sacrifices herself by sitting atop her deceased husband's funeral pyre. He established the famous university 'The senate of Serampore College.' It is no exaggeration to say that his service to the Tamil language is immeasurable.

Despite many hardships and worries in life, William Carey did not see them as obstacles, but used them as stepping stones, and accomplished the work of evangelism.

But we get tired of silly matters. God wants us to rise from our weariness. If we rise for Him we can create and achieve vastly for Him!

My dear young champs! Think about what you have done for Jesus in your life. Strive to do! Act! God will use you mightily! Run without getting wearied!

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Testimony: Jishya

This is an interview with brother Jenil Matthew who was born into a Christian family, and when growing up, in childhood, had the longing to become a missionary, however, forgotten his commitment in the young age, and was living a life according to the worldly pleasures; meanwhile upon his encounter with Jesus regained the childhood commitment and is now getting trained to become a missionary.

Tell us about your family and childhood?

Our family belongs to CSI background. We live in Seithunganallur, Tuticorin District. I grew up there since childhood. My

father, Fenn Matthew works as a professor in St. Xavier's Polytechnic College in Seithunganallur. My mother, Erline Matthew is a teacher in Rosemary Higher Secondary School. My brother Fenil Isaac Ebenezer is an Export Manager at Horeb Exports Company. I used to watch cartoon a lot in

childhood. So, I used to indulge in leaping, jumping, climbing trees and many such things, as I wanted to become Spiderman and save the world. It was in that situation that my grandfather Mr Fenn Abraham taught me that, Jesus is more of a superhero than Spiderman, and Jesus is the sole super hero who saved you, me and this world. So, I decided to live like Jesus, the super hero whom my grandfather told about. Well... So, being born in a Christian family you have accepted Jesus in your childhood... Tell us about your early Christian life and schooling? I used to fight a lot when studying in primary school. I was never interested in studies. I persistently remained in cartoon and Spiderman. My grandfather used to teach me clearly about

Jesus in childhood. When I introduced myself in the class during my 3rd

grade, I introduced like, "I am Jenil Matthew and I am a missionary."

The reason is, our church reverend on a Sunday told us about the history of the song "I have decided to follow Jesus". The faith of Nokseng Garo, tribe of Meghalaya, Assam stimulated my heart. Then, I

decided in my heart that I would become a missionary like him. I expressed my decision to my grandfather and asked him to teach me that song. He cheered me by telling me about Sadhu Sundar Singh who sang the song "Nokseng's Last Word." I learnt the song with a commitment that whether I live or die, all is for Jesus. Later, my grandfather brought me up by telling stories of Sadhu Sundar Singh. This was my childhood life.



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Great... missionary commitment at an early age... Were you able to pursue this in your young adolescence?

After the death of my grandfather, I started to lose my focus gradually. I developed a deep interest in playing football. I spent most of my time watching soccer players like Lionel Messi, Cristiano Ronaldo, and R. Kaka in the thought

of wanting to play for the Indian team. Furthermore, I fought with my dad to join in Sports Hostel after 10th grade and even was selected for it as well. Besides, I didn't reveal about the weakness that I had in legs before the selection to my father, as he will ask me not to join there. So, I hid the weakness and went for the

selection. I couldn't even play 20 percent. Also, my name was not there in the selection list. So, I developed slight hatred on Jesus. But, I used to say that, Jesus is my everything. Moreover, I joined my I I th and I 2 th grade in Rosemary Matriculation School, Palayamkottai and studied having no interest. Yet, only the questions that I had studied were asked in the

board examination. Jesus gave me good grades and made me to succeed.

Super...You completed schooling... How was your college life?

I took BSc Visual Communication and studied in Madras Christian College. The desire which I had for football began to turn towards photography. My focus had changed to become a Wildlife Photographer. I began to photograph deer, birds that come over there and nature, while I was studying. Since it gave me a kind of happiness, I used to take my DSLR camera each day in the morning and would go inside the college. I used to go crazy behind the photos. But, I used to say that Jesus is everything for

an M C C C S me, despite being forgotten about my heavenly calling. I would go around the town with my friends and be happy. I used to read a chapter from proverbs each day as my parents had suggested. So, Jesus saved me from bad habits like smoking,

doing alcohol and drugs. However, I was ignorant about the truths of the Bible. My life was going like a blind man and a ship that did not know its direction.

Okay...You had come to a point where your missionary vision/focus was lost and it was only photography... Were you able to live holy in the college?

College was happening well until third semester in the second year. Thereafter, two girls from a different department got introduced to me. I liked a girl very much. Whenever I see her, I used to get a feeling of slow motion

and she appears to me like the heroine of Spiderman that I had seen in childhood. I informed my mother about this. My mother said, this is against the Bible, "I will get you married to the girl whom you like in the due time." Still, to get to know more about her, I started talking to a different girl. All my nights were gone with talking in phone and chatting with her. Without my own knowledge, Ih started liking her. I would become worried if I didn't talk to her or message her even for a day. In this situation, my friends were also dating. They had sown a seed in my mind that dating is not a wrong thing. My friends said, if we want we can get married. After knowing all this, one fine night, I sent her a text message saying that I love her. Many days passed by.

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Alright...Love blossomed in college... How was your relationship with God?

My relationship with Jesus was severed and my heart joined with that girl. I didn't say about it to anyone in the family. I stopped reading Bible. It was our habit to walk inside the college campus.

Likewise, one day, when walking, I held her hand like in a movie. After reaching the hostel, I heard a voice in my heart saying, "What you are doing is wrong". However, I didn't take it seriously. To forget this bad thing, I started watching

bad movies. I began doing the

same sin that my friend from seventh grade taught me to do. I fell into the same sin which God gave me deliverance from. I knew that God can give me deliverance. But, I didn't know the truth. Likewise, after doing many such wrong things for the girl, I used to kneel down in the nights and will ask for forgiveness with tears, but there was no freedom from this sinful lifestyle. One day, after reading and meditating the verses from Matthew 7:21-23, I started praying to God that I need deliverance from this sin. Few days later, one night, while reading the Bible, the verses from proverbs 6:27, and proverbs 5:18 started speaking to me. As I read the scriptures I got to know that dating and doing adultery are the same (Matthew 5:28). That's why I couldn't have a relationship with lesus and the scriptures. I remembered a story of Sadhu Sundar Singh that my grandfather told me when I was small. "Once a little child while cleaning its room, after dusting off the spider-web and not killing the spider asked, why my room is still unclean? It had been told her, to kill the spider first, then the room will become clean. Likewise, despise the spider like lusts that you have inside, then your heart shall be clean. Jesus will dwell



in there" (Galatians 5:24, I Timothy 2:22). I surrendered myself completely to Jesus after knowing this truth. I got deliverance according to the verse "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." (John 8:32)

Super...You renewed your relationship with Jesus after backsliding...Were you able to abide in it thereafter?

I apologized to the girl and stopped talking to her after saying, "What I did was wrong. I

must live according to the Bible. Forgive me." The end had come after few arguments. Still, I wasn't able to forget her. I started to inquire about her. That's when, verses from proverbs 3: 5-7 warned me saying not to depend on self but to remain in the Bible. Since I began talking to her again, arguments started to come and I forgot the truth. Bible began to reprimand me saying, "Remember Lot's wife. Do not look back. If you look back, hereafter, it's going to be a pillar of salt." So, thereafter, I didn't look back. According to the verse in Ecclesiastes 12:1, I got close to God. My life got changed that Jesus replaced her and Bible replaced my cellphone.

A relationship was formed between you and Jesus...How did you overcome the old sins?

Satan scared me for three months by bringing the sins that I have done in front of my eyes. I continued reading Bible and started praying with the faith that Jesus had forgiven my sins. I got to know few more truths from the Bible after reading Bro. Zac Poonen's book in those days. I got to know that, "When we begin to see the perfect love, the small degree of love will vanish." Satan tried to make me grow weary by showing my old sins. At all those times, when I say, "I am righteous by the blood of Jesus", he will run away from me. When I learned the truth that there is no match for Jesus' love, satan could not separate me from Jesus.

You got to know about hthe truths... And have become a child of God... What are you doing now?

I started doing fulltime ministry after finishing my education. At that time, the Lord reminded me of my childhood decision to become a missionary. Now, I am getting trained in a Missionary Training Centre through Indian Missionary Society. "He who called me is faithful", He has not forgotten the decision that I made in childhood and has brought me for the work of a missionary. "What the Lord wills cannot be hindered" I am receiving my training with perfect joy in the presence of God.

What would you like to say to the youngsters?

First of all, if you acknowledge that what you are doing is sin, 90% of your liberation will be achieved. Abide in the truths of the Bible, without leaning on your own self. Read the scriptures

and pray daily. Prayerfully read a proverb daily and seek Jesus' help to live accordingly. "When you make the Lord your Shepherd, you shall not want." Only, when we become the sheep of the Lord, the Lord can be our Shepherd. Also, only, when we obey the truths of the Bible, we can be the sheep of God. Devote your time in reading the Bible and praying. Run away from the lusts of the world (1 John 2:15-17; 2 Timothy 2:22). Confess and leave all the sins and iniquities that you have committed to Jesus without hiding. His grace will surround you, "If you are in his grace, sin will not overtake you".

Beloved Young People! On seeing the testimony of Bro. Jenil Matthew, we have no doubt that it would suit us. When we confess any kind of sins to Jesus and surrender, He shall forgive all those sins and shall deliver and will transform you to be a minister of God. When you confess all your sins according to the verse, "He who covers his sins will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy", God will forgive your sins and will transform you to a great minister of God! 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Asha! In 1 Corinthians 9:16 Paul says "I am compelled to preach" So sharing the gospel is our duty. Often times, we fail to carry out our duties and we don't obey the Lord's commands either!

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matthew 28:19). This is our Principal command. Romans 10:14 says "How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?" Only through Gospel, people are saved, redeemed from their sins and transformed into children of God! Thomas Alva Edison was not disheartened by the failure of his life. On the contrary, he replied, "I did not fail a thousand times, I went through a thousand steps to find an electric lamp." Our mind, which gets excited when we see success, gets wearied when we fail. Success gives enthusiasm, but failure gives wisdom.

P.V. Sindhu won the gold medal at the 2022 Commonwealth Badminton Championship and won the hearts of all Indians. She started playing badminton since 2009 and the 2016 "Rio

Olympics" was an unforgettable match in her life. She became the first Indian to reach the finals of a badminton event and became the first woman to win a silver medal for India at the Olympics, although she lost to Carolina Marin in the event, a feat which she suffered many defeats. She has won silver and bronze in 7 competitions. She has gone to the brink of competition several times and has seen defeat. On one side, constant failures, on the other side, people who mock saying, "Will you win a Gold Medal? Or not?" Sindhu was tired of seeing all this and instead of being

paralyzed, she encouraged herself and started playing. She realized that failure is not permanent and won gold in the 2018-2019 World Badminton Championship. She put an end to all defeats. Apart from that, she won gold in 2022 Commonwealth Games

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and grabbed everyone's

attention. With this win, Sindhu silenced all her detractors. Don't get discouraged by the failures that come in your life. Whenever failures and disappointments come and make you weary, look to the Lord. Because He is the Lord **"who gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength"** (Isaiah 40:29).

Elijah, who killed 450 prophets of the Baal on Mount Carmel and 400 prophets of the grove of idols who were eating at Jezebel's table, turned the people who had turned back from the Lord, saying, **"The Lord is God, the Lord is God,"** but when he heard the words of

Jezebel, who said that she would kill him with the sword, he ran to the wilderness to save his life. There he lay down under the broom tree and started to mourn. But the LORD did not leave Elijah, who was weary. He sent his angel and strengthened him. With the strength given by God, he began to do his ministry again.

Perhaps you are tired of

listening to the words of men in the place of study or work, or you are broken because of the words of your own family, and the life you hoped for is not happening to you. Look at the face of the Lord, as you are troubled by the failure of something like this in your life. According to the words, **"And they looked**

"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God" (Matthew

5:8). God does not see our face, when we pray. He sees our heart, but men look at the face. Our Lord is the one who examines, what our heart thinks, what kind of ideas come into our heart and how our heart is. Why does God look at the heart? The Bible says "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jeremiah 17:9)" That's why God examines our heart. "Your iniquities have separated you from your God; and your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear" (Isaiah 29: 1, 2). 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the Holy Spirit scans our heart we'll know whether we carry pride, irritation, lust and anger inside us. The Bible says "For it is from within, out of a person's heart, that evil thoughts come—sexual immo-

rality, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. All these evils come from inside and defile a person" (Mark 7:21-23) and these are the sins that hide the face of Jesus.

> How to find them out? We need to surrender ourselves in the presence of God and allow the Holy Spirit to examine us. He will ask you to confess the sins that the Spirit shows you. During the early days

of my ministry, One day I was fasting and praying as usual for the sermon. An hour or two passed, but I could not feel the presence of God. I could not even feel that the Lord was near me. How can the Lord speak to me without feeling His presence? How can I hear His voice? There was a big dilemma in me. I started to praise, sing and pray but still I could not find any change. Realizing that something has gone wrong, I asked God,

"Why do you refuse to talk to me, Lord? Why can't I feel your presence? How can I preach without you speaking? Please speak to me Lord". After two hours the Lord began to speak. The Lord said though you are saved, anointed, speak tongues, sing and praise, you still have a bitterness deep inside your heart. He told me that I have a grudge

over a person who spoke wrong about me in the church. I never fought with that person nor argued. But whenever I see him, I always had that bitterness over him that he is the one who spoke wrong about me. God scanned my heart and showed me this. When God pointed out

this in me, I realized it from the bottom of my heart and confessed to the Lord. God asked me to go and reconcile with that person. It was a difficult task to do. But since I wanted God to speak to me, I went to that person's house and knocked at the door. When he opened the door, he angrily asked me, "Why have you come?" I said, "Forgive me!" We never fought and never argued with each other. But deep inside our hearts we both know that there is a division within. I apologized to him saying that "I have a grudge against you, forgive me." He held my hands and started crying. The Lord again built a good fellowship between us.

When I returned home and knelt down to pray, the Lord came down and spoke to me saying, "Since you obeyed me, I will come and stand amidst the people in the meeting today" and revealed the miracles that will take place. The Lord performed great miracles just as He had said. The Lord speaks when there is holiness that the Lord expects. Commit yourself to holiness so that it is not destroyed in your work place, home and in streets. Blessed are the ones pure in heart. When we read Acts 2: 46, 47, it is written that the ancient church believers were glad and pure in their

hearts. They do not speak about others. They do not have jealousy. They do not know to talk ill about another person. They were pure in their hearts. That's why God was with them and used them mightily for the revival.

God wants us to be like children. Though kids fight for a moment, the next moment they stand together holding hands with each other. Children are pure. We need such kind of heart in us. When we meditate the word of God, we will know the amount of sins we have in us. We will know how pure we should be. Pray and ask God for such a pure heart.

Colby Stevenson was born on October 3, 1997, in the United States. When he was a child, Colby's parents took him to watch a skiing competition. Colby was very happy and excited to watch it.

To encourage his excitement, his parents enrolled him in a skiing school. As days passed, Stevenson learned to ski well. He became an expert in skiing when he was young at the age of 10. He met experienced skiers and learned many techniques from them. He participated and won in various district level skiing competitions. Stevenson's coach said that this was not enough and encouraged him to participate in national level competitions as well. Apart from that, he boosted Stevenson's confidence that he should participate in the Olympics and win a medal. From that day onwards, Stevenson began training hard to compete in the Olympics.

When everything was going smooth in Stevenson's life, he faced a sudden unbearable situation. He took part in a skiing competition and won the title of 'Skier of the Week'. Stevenson was ecstatic, saying "This was my best ski ever." His fellow skier John Michael Fabrizi had broken his leg at the same event, and so Stevenson offered to drive him back home after the competition. Fabrizi was in the back seat. The fatigue of the game and the long journey had left Stevenson so tired that he began to feel drowsy, finding it hard to drive. So he thought of resting for a while and then continue the travel. But before he could stop, he lost control and the car started accelerating. Before he could realize what was happening, the car rolled several times off the road and fell into a ditch. The roof of the car was completely destroyed. As a result, Stevenson suffered serious injuries and was bleeding from

his head. He had more than 30 fractures in his skull. His friend Fabrizi was unharmed, and he immediately called the hospital



and informed what had happened. Stevenson was rushed to the hospital in a critical condition.

Although treatment started at the hospital, there was continuous blood loss from his head. The doctors consulted and attempted to artificially induce coma. A natural coma can be treated and reversed over time. But artificially induced coma can result in lifelong loss of vision. Despite these dire circumstances, doctors tried to save Stevenson's life, and continued the treatment. When he woke up three days later, the first thing he asked the doctor

was, "Can I ski again?" The doctor said, "While you were admitted to the hospital, many said that survival is difficult. But with our diligent treatment, you were able to recover from coma, woke up and sur-

vived." He encouraged Colby to keep running with confidence. Although he tried hard, Stevenson could barely move his legs. It was only after three months that he slowly started moving his legs.

After six long months, he was able to stand upright finally. Then he started walking slowly. After that he started running. He started running fast. It was only after a year that he began to undergo rigorous training. Snow skiing is no ordinary event. Pits must be traversed. While climbing and descending the mountains, even the slightest slip of the foot can lead to severe injuries. But none of this could stop Stevenson. After rigorous trainings, he participated in the national level competition and won. Despite winning at the national level, since Stevenson's goal was to win gold at the Olympics, he practiced more intensively. The 2022 Beijing Olympics began. Stevenson was selected to represent the United



States in freestyle skiing. Shortly after the start of the first round, Stevenson began to stumble. Having endured so many problems and struggles, thinking that it was only shot, and he has to endure everything for just this one day, he pulled all his energy together and started skiing faster and reached his goal. It was only after reaching the goal that Stevenson came to life. Though he finished the race, the firstround stumble cost him losing the gold and

> gaining a silver medal. It was a little hard to accept but winning the silver medal in the Olympics from once being on the brink of death was definitely a great achievement.

Colby mentioned that, 'a few days ago, people said', "It's a big deal that you survived". Then when I started to get up and walk, they said, "It's really a wonder that you got up and walked". When I started training, they said that "it's a big thing to practice, that's enough, don't do any more persistent training." In every phase of my life people kept on saying "It's enough, enough." But I got out of bed, walked, ran, and today I stand before you as an achiever. If I can achieve it, so can you: nothing is impossible if you try.

Dear young champs reading this, Stevenson's perseverance and selfconfidence kept him going even when those around him told him that he couldn't do anything. It made him reach unfathomable heights. You too can achieve anything, if you have the same confidence and tenacity within you **Try it!! Finish it!!**





Every month in this Red Alert series, we are meditating about God's chosen people who moved away from God's call and plan because of their mistakes or sins. All these are a sound of God's warning to us who are living in the end times. As we read this article, God expects us to recognize those areas in our lives where we need to set right and work towards it. This month in Red Alert, let us meditate about a couple who saw and experienced the revival poured out in Jerusalem on the day of the Pentecost and yet committed a sin that led to God's anger. They are Ananias and Sapphira. Let us see what they did to the extent that God's anger came upon them.

SELFISHNESS!

Everyday thousands of people were saved and added to the church right from the day of Pentecost. The Bible says in Acts 4:32, "now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common." It is also mentioned that many sold their possessions and lands. Ananias and Sapphira lived amongst such people who were selfless and did not keep anything for themselves. Though Ananias and Sapphira lived in such a time, their hearts were not like other believers. Their hearts were filled with Satan (Acts 5:3). They also sold their land on their part, but they did not give the entire cost rather they kept a part of it for themselves. The reason behind it was selfishness and that led to the beginning of their destruction. No matter how long we pray for revival, fast, or take part in revival meetings, if we do not die to the self in us and if we serve the Lord

for the sake of name and fame then God cannot use us for revival.

Youngsters! Is there selfishness in us as we are

chosen for this end time revival? Let us analyze ourselves and surrender to God for our self to become ashes.

HYPOCRISY!

Believers sold their lands and possessions, and all the proceeds were laid at the apostles' feet.

Many would have appreciated those who saw what the believers did. Not only that, may be that entire city would have spoken about them. Having

watched all these, may be Ananias also wanted people to talk about him and appreciate him. So, he sold his land and gave only half of the proceeds. But he showed off as if he brought all his proceedings. The intention behind him bringing the offering was purely for people to see and praise him but never for the Lord. This is hypocrisy.

When Jesus rebuked the Sadducees and the Pharisees, He used the word hypocrites. God hates the sin of hypocrisy. Having sin and evil within and showing off as a good person outwardly is hypocrisy. Because of Ananias hypocrisy, God's anger came against him.

Youngsters! How is your heart? If you have sin within and show off as a holy person on the

outside then it means you are deceiving yourself,

not others. Therefore, let us make use of this

opportunity to repent.

Ananias brought the proceeds of selling his land and gave it to Peter. He showed as if he was giving sacrificially before others. But the Holy Spirit revealed the hypocrisy of Ananias because Ananias did not lie to man but to God (Acts 5:4). Our

> God searches our hearts, and nothing is hidden from Him. Because he lied against the Holy Spirit, he fell and died there. Following which, his wife Sapphira also came

looking for him, lied against the Holy Spirit and received the same punishment. Though Ananias and Sapphira saw and experienced the revival they couldn't stand firm till the end.

Dear youngsters! When we superficially read the story of Ananias and Sapphira, we may wonder why such a severe punishment for a lie. As you read this article, think about it in terms of scriptures, whether the things you do are pleasing to God or not? God will make us aware of the self, pride, hypocrisy, and other sins within us that hinder the revival and will help us to get rid of them.

Jairus

Jairus, a ruler of the synagogue, fell down at Jesus' feet and requested him to come to his house. He pleaded, "My daughter is suffering on her death bed. If you put your hands on her, she will survive." When Jesus was on his way to his house, a woman who had been having an issue of bleeding for twelve years and had spent all her living upon physicians, none of whom could heal her, came behind him and touched the border of his garment with the faith that if she touched even the hem of his garment, she would be healed. Jesus Christ and healed her and immediately her bleeding stopped. Jesus asked, "Who touched me?" The disciples said, "Master, the people are crowding and pressing against you. Birds in the Bible

This month we will be looking at the bird "Owl". Some interesting facts about owls...

• Owl is a nocturnal bird. It sleeps during the day and is active at night.

- These are birds that kill and prey on other species.
- These are birds ranging from five inches to two feet in length.

• Its wings are very soft. So, it doesn't cause any kind of sound while flying.

- Unlike other bird species, its face is flat and round.
- Its sharp curved beaks are surrounded by feathers with a short curved stiff quill.
- Its round face has round big eyes. It has two ears like horns.
- Once the owl lays its first egg, incubation begins.

The hoots of the owl are varied. Its sound is so loud and low pitched that it can be heard far away. An owl uses its voice to identify its species and to communicate its location.

Owl in the Bible

In the Bible the owl is mentioned as one of the unclean birds (Lev 11:13-19, Deut 14:16). Usually owls live among ruins, in ramshackle buildings, in graveyards, and in tree trunks (Psalm 102:6). Like this, we can find references of owls in some other places of the Bible too.

When troubles and sorrows which refer to owls surround us, the faith that the Lord is our refuge is enough to keep us moving forward. Owl is a stronger bird than a crow. But owls cannot see during the day. So an owl can easily be defeated by a crow during the day. The crow will take advantage of the owl's moment of weakness and defeats it very easily. If a crow tries to attack an owl at night, failure prevails. Similarly, we must turn our enemy satan's weakness into our strength. Peter and Tabitha (Acts9:36-42)

In the city of Joppa there was a disciple named Tabitha, which is translated as Dorcas. She was full of goodness and charitable deeds. Scripture does not mention that she preached to anyone. But she followed the teachings of Jesus and reflected Him throughout her life. When she fell

ill and died, her benefactors could not bear her loss. None of the other disciples gathered there and tried to perform a miracle in the name of lesus. So, their minds sought the help of Peter. Since Joppa is near Lydda (ten miles apart according to schol-

ars) they sent two men to Peter to call him who was there to come to them without delay. Peter realised the gravity of the situation and readily went along with them. The widows surrounding Peter showed him the robes and garments made by Tabitha, with an expectation that, "Won't he do something? Just like Jesus asked everyone to stay outside while resurrecting Jarius' daughter (Mark 5:40), Peter asked the people there to leave the place. Then he humthe widows who were waiting outside, and presented her alive to meet their expectations. This news spread across the city of Joppa and everyone believed in Christ.

Even though Peter was illiterate, he preached without any microphone and added 3000, 5000 souls to the church. Now, by Peter's miraculous gift of healing, men and women from town to town without any advertisement became believers and were added to the Lord in great

> numbers. They trusted his healing powers so much that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches. that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them. Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to

Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed. (Acts 5:14-16) and none of them left disappointed. Peter made the verse, "He who believes in me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do," (John 14:12) a reality. The entire lerusalem and nearby towns were blessed because of one man of God.

Accident

Road accidents

Most road accidents have taken place from 2017 to 2020. 17,926 people have died in 2017. 18,394 in 2018. 18,129 in 2019 and 14,527 in 2020 due to road accidents. Within these four years from 2017 to the last 4 years. The National Crime Records Bureau has published the statistics of traffic accidents like road, rail and railway crossing in the 2020, the number of accidents has increased from 12 percent to 83 percent. It is noteworthy that accidents and fatalities have increased in year 2021 across the country. Last year there were 4.03 lakh road accidents and 1,55,622 people had died and 3,71,844 people have been injured.

Crime against women

In Delhi, around 1,100 women were raped and another 2704 women were kidnapped in the past 6 months. Due to this, women's safety is still a question mark in the national capital. The number of cases related to sexual harassment keeps on increasing in Delhi every day. In the current year till July 15, 1,100 women have been raped. In 2021, the number of cases registered for violence against women was 1,244. This year it raised up to 1,480 within July. 2197 women were kidnapped this year. 2704 women were subjected to domestic violence69 women have been victimized due to dowry abuse. Crimes against women in the capital as a whole have increased by 17%, according to statistics.

Addiction to drugs and alcohol creates a situation where their lives end at a young age.

LET US PRAY AND CONQUER!

Many have a question like, "Should a prayer contain very difficult words and deep biblical wisdom and not be simple?" Surely, prayers are simple. The prayer that we are going to look at is a simple prayer that Hezekiah offered.

When we speak of Ezekiel's prayer, the first thing that comes to our mind is the prayer that he did, to extend his lifetime by 15 years. But he was not the one, who prayed only for himself. He remained a prayerful person throughout his life. Let's meditate on his prayer.

A prayer to God for his people

When some of the people disobeyed God's words, Hezekiah advised them to turn to God and prayed for them. **"May the good LORD provide atonement for everyone"** (II Chronicles 30; 19) was the prayer of Hezekiah. The Lord listened to his interceding prayer and favoured the people.

A prayer in times of trouble

Rabshakeh, a commander sent by Sennacherib, the King of Assyria, came against Judah and began to act obnoxiously and to speak mockingly of Hezekiah. He challenged, "I will give you two thousand horses; if you can earn two thousand men to ride on them, stand against the king of Assyria." This made King Hezekiah very upset. Later, when Rabshakeh started to abuse even more, King Hezekiah went to the Lord's presence and poured his heart out. It is mentioned as "crying out". It is a cry for help trusting God in the midst of fear. Let us also trust in the Lord in the day of fear. A prayer of faith is, saying "The Lord is on my side; I will not fear; what can man do unto me?" In our prayers too, it is necessary to remember that "The Lord is a strong fortress in the day of trouble; He is the one who saves me and delivers me."

A prayer for his healing

It was a prayer made on his deathbed (2 Kings 20; Isaiah 38; 2 Chronicles 32). He appealed in tears to God that he walked before him in truth and with a perfect heart. The Lord answered his prayer with a sign and extended his lifetime by 15 years. This was a simple

'remember me' prayer. It had tears and a simple request, 'heal me'. It didn't have many words. But the Lord knows the heart. He was aware of the untold words of Hezekiah and answered his plea.

Dear youths, King Hezekiah made such simple and humble prayers. We can also pray such simple prayers like him and receive deliverance. ■
