Similarly, God protects us from every danger and snares that come our way. No matter how much evil the enemy sows and plans to destroy our lives, God is a bulwark and a pillar of protection around us. Nothing can touch you beyond His protection.

He is the one who gave His life for you. He will neither leave nor give up on you. When He is the real protector, no danger will approach you!

MY JOURNEY WITH JESUS

This is an interview with a sister who was born in a Christian family, suffered from an illness in her childhood, was healed by God through her mother's prayers, and is now serving the Lord as a teenager.

Tell us about your Family and Childhood?

My name is Anna Rosline. I was born in a Christian family in a village called Karuvantha, near Surandai, in Tenkasi District. I was born as the first child to my parents, Mr. Daniel Deva Pichai and Mrs. Anna Bakiya

Selvi. I have a younger sister and a younger brother. My family does Farming and Animal Husbandry. I used to get sick often, within a few days of my birth. My mother used to say that I was in a state where there were no chances for me to survive. That time, my mother prayed

committing me to God, saying, 'If you give back my daughter alive, she will serve you in her best possible way.' I had fallen sick many times however. Nevertheless, God had protected me miraculously. When I was a little girl, once on a picnic, I lost my way, while I was seeking for my father. A sister brought me back to my parents when

everyone was searching for me. Thus, God protected me many times. I used to go to church regularly in childhood. I never missed attending any sunday classes. I regularly get prizes without fail in every Bible quiz and sunday school classes. However, Sinful desires were still persisting in me.

Okay... your carnal attributes were persisting in you... You said you got prizes in church... If then, when did you get saved? Our church took us all to a youth gathering, when I was 15 years old, studying 10th grade. I received in his presence. Initially, I had been mocked and teased like, "for how many days this prayer is going to last." But the grace of God made me to pray each day.

Well ... You got saved and started praying... Tell us about your schooling?

God had given me good wisdom to study since my childhood. I used to study well. I had a good reputation amongst all my teachers. By the grace of God, I would always put God first during my schooling. However, I had few unspiritual

things in me like watching cinema and getting angry. God gave me the grace to finish my schooling

with good grades.

Superb... You finished your schooling... How was your college life?

I wanted to study Bio-Tech after finishing my schooling. Since I didn't get a chance to pursue it, I applied for engineering in a college in Chennai as per my mother's wish. But God forbade it and made me to study in an engineering college that was near my village. couldn't fathom the plan of God back then. It was my desire to study by staying in a hostel, which is why I had applied for the college in Chennai. I had that longing inside me as I didn't get through. I started backsliding from Jesus during the early days of my college. Even a small failure in studies affected me a lot. I started going into worldly life like everyone else. I who started to distance myself from the Lord, didn't have peace inside me. But, God didn't let me leave just like that. Again the Lord intervened with me through another youth meet. He filled me with the anointing of praise when I was in the

college lab. He keeps talking to me through many things that he loves me. I accepted Jesus as my friend during my college days. I would share everything even my small things with Jesus just as sharing with a friend. In the final year of my college days Jesus and I developed a strong friendship.

Alright... A strong friendship was established between you and Jesus... How was your prayer life?

During the initial days of my salvation, I used to pray for an hour. However, during my college days, my prayer hours were lessened. But, after renewing my relationship with God, I started praying as before. God gave me new praying and waiting experiences. The Lord speaks to me through visions.

Okay... God speaks to you... You finished your education... Did you try for a job?

After completing my college I stayed in Chennai for 2 months and looked for a job. Even though God had granted me good marks and skills, I didn't get any job. One day, I went to a church in Chennai and prayed, 'If I had come to Chennai without Your will, kindly take me back to my

hometown again.' The Lord heard my prayer. That time, my mother called and asked me to come to the town for a small matter. While in the village God gave me a promise. Accordingly, He offered me a job in a Software Company that was near my village. My dream of having a hostel life wasn't fulfilled this time as well.

Great!... You got a job... Were you able to do the job happily?

It was at the place where I worked that I got my biggest temptation. I feared that it would separate me from God. I lost my prayer life. But, God didn't leave me in any situation. When I tried to resign from the job, He encouraged me to work and said that you should come out of that place as a winner and He gave me strength

to do the work as well. I was protected by the grace of God and His abundant love. I again had the chance to fall back into the same sinful temptation. Nevertheless, God gave me grace to overcome that temptation. I quit my job in October in the last year, as I didn't want a job that separates me from God. After that,

I started a YouTube Channel and started posting christian videos, short stories and Bible verses. People would say that, it was beneficial for them. The YouTube channel was definitely helpful in relieving stress which resulted after the temptation that I faced in the workplace.

Oh no!... You left the job that you desired... So what did you do after that?

During my college days I started a prayer cell in my church and could not continue it for a long time. Later, I participated in a youth meeting that happened during my college days in Surandai. After that, I was invited over phone to attend Synergia that happens every month. I always used to think of going there, but I had obstacles for more than a year in attending it. However, I started attending Synergia when I was in the final year of my college. I began volunteering there. I would sing songs and do other works as well. I started evangelizing for the first time after

attending a youth festival in Nalumavadi. Whenever I get into a bus after work, I would always sit in the place where God stirs me up to instead of sitting with my friends. God always brings the right souls to me. I would tell them about the love of Jesus.

I always have tracts in my bag, and I will give it to the people to whom God prompts. At that time I had many temptations of sin and lost my prayer life. It was at that time, I participated in the Revival Igniters Camp. It was a turning point for me. The word which came through Mohan



Uncle that "God believes you" touched me and I surrendered myself to Jesus. Then I started a prayer cell and prayed together with two sisters who attended the same camp from my village. we as 10-15 members, would gather each week in the evening times to pray for the nation. Later in 2021, through a follow-up meeting that happened in Jebamalai, we started two prayer cells in V.K.Pudur Taluk and began praying. Now, God is providing the grace to conduct three prayer cells.

Okay... You are praying in the prayer cell... How is your relationship with Jesus right now?

In the beginning of 2022, I had a vision in which I was passing through a field where the paddy grains were ripe but unusable. I ignored the vision and the Lord intervened with me through many verses. Since, I didn't obey His word, I began to lose His presence. After that, with much zeal, firstly I started doing Tracts Ministry. I would try going to Village Ministry at least twice every month. When we go and hand out tracts in the village, people share their burdens and that would be very useful for me to pray. Now I can clearly feel the interference of God and His talks with me. When I wait in prayer, He reveals things about the nation in visions and insists me to pray for it. He teaches me many truths while meditating the Bible and when I do something wrong, He rebukes me. He never gives up on me when weaknesses, weariness and struggles occur

in spiritual life. He encourages me with His words and does everything He wants to do through me. Especially, He guides me in gospel and prayer.

Thats Fantastic!... He has made you to overcome temptation... What would you like to say to today's youth?

In many times, God's plans are always better than ours. Even if we couldn't understand it in the beginning, it will be great in the end. I didn't know how I would have been like, if I had got the hostel life that I desired. But the Lord is using me as a useful vessel for many, when His will is fulfilled in my life. I said to the Lord on the day of my salvation, "Even if I leave you, do not leave me", and I surrendered my hands completely to God for His will. If you too surrender yourself with zeal and desire to do something for the Lord, He will surely strengthen you and use you.

Beloved youngsters! Even though Sister Anna Rosline often fell down and rose up, since the Lord was with her, He led her by holding her hands and is using her to minister to many people today. Likewise, when you ask God to hold your hands, He will hold your hands too and will guide you. He will help you as well to overcome temptations and will protect you under His wings!

During the curfew days I started using mobile phone more and started watching porn videos for nearly 5 to 6 hours a day. That was my hobby. Even now after going to college I can't let it go. I feel guilty after watching it. I am dying inside myself every day. There are no words to express my grief. It seems like someone is saying that I am committing a very big sin. Yes! I know what I am doing is sinful. But I couldn't overcome it. As a result my studies are also affected. I couldn't study my subjects properly either. Is it possible for me to come out of this sin? Will Jesus set me free? - Shankar, Kanyakumari.

Dear brother Shankar, I can feel your inner pain. I can understand that you, who are saved, grieve God by sinning and suffer daily in the guilty conscience that results from it.

Shankar, the moment we want to come out of

a sin, really, God opens the way for it. If you want to come out of your addiction, He will set you free from it and helps you to live with freedom and lead a successful life.

Shankar, many a time we fall into the trap that Satan lays for us, without our knowledge. The Scripture says, **"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy"** (John 10:10). We must be aware of what he steals, kills and destroys in our lives. Only then can we be vigilant.

First thing that he steals from our lives

is our holiness. The strength of young people is their holiness. As Satan steals it, they feel guilty and wearied.

▶ Second, to kill (to kill). He will spoil the beautiful plan that God has for them, divert them from the path of that plan, and begin to lead them straight down the wrong path of destruction.

InGenesis chapter 50, we read about Joseph. When Joseph was 17 years old, he had a dream. He told his father about the dream with great joy. But it drew the wrath of his own brothers, who hated and planned to kill him. However, they sold him as a slave and he was taken to Egypt. Joseph, who came to the land of Egypt as a slave, was falsely accused, thrown into prison, and faced many sufferings. Joseph

was in agony for almost 13 years and his brothers were the reason of all the suffering that he went through in his life. But after all these sufferings, the Lord raised Joseph as the highest official in the land of Egypt. He was made in charge of the country and was elevated to the position next to Pharaoh. At this time, there was a great famine, and Egypt was the only

place where food grains were available. Joseph's brothers came to Egypt to buy food grains. There they found Joseph as the Lord of all Egypt. During this period, Joseph's father was still alive, but sometime later, their father died. After the death of their father, Joseph's brothers were afraid that he would take revenge on them. "Today, he is a man of great authority; what if he plans to pay us back for all the harm we did to him", they said.

But Joseph said to them: "Do not be afraid, for am I in the place of God? But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as it is this

day, to save many people alive. Now therefore, do not be afraid; I will provide for you and your little ones." And he comforted them and spoke kindly to them" (Gen - 50:19-21). God wants us to be like that. You ought to go and speak kindly to those who have harmed you, blamed you excessively, preventing good things from happening in your home, preventing your promotion. Are we able to do that?

But look at Joseph. He spoke kindly to them telling, "What are you afraid of? I am here to take care of your children." He reassured his brothers with compassion. Let us examine ourselves to see if we have that nature in us.

When such great qualities are not within us, there is a lack of peace, quarrels, problems, uneasy situations and enmity in the

house. Sometimes we forget to speak kindly and instead speak angrily. And then we rush to God, pleading forgiveness, saying, "Lord, I should not have spoken in that manner; I should not have behaved in that way, I should speak kindly and compassionately, please give me the grace to do so, please give me that nature." Some people say "Kindly forgive me, kindly help me." We need to be kind to those who say so.

There was a certain family that lived a prosperous life with many possessions and assets. They had a son. In order to grab the vast riches and properties, their relatives killed his parents and took all the assets for themselves. This

child has been orphaned. The same relatives put him in an orphanage. When the boy grew up, he met a man from his village who told him the truth about the murder of his parents by his own relatives to confiscate the wealth. "They are the reason for your life as an orphan", said the man. The boy was enraged. He took up a decision in his life. "I will take revenge on my relatives who stole my property and riches

and killed my parents", he swore with frenzy. When he grew into a young lad, he carried a large knife and was on the lookout for the people who had killed his parents and stolen his assets, so that he may kill them and take revenge.

At that time one day he was told about Jesus. As soon as he gave room for Jesus in his heart, his hardened heart became soft. A great transformation came over him. He accepted Jesus as his Saviour and started to live a new life. A few years later, he met another man who told him about the whereabouts of the people who had killed his parents. He immediately set out to meet them, at least to know the reason why they had killed his parents.

But when he went there, he found them living in poverty, with nothing to eat. When the lad found them in such a worst condition, he did not feel angry that they had killed his parents. Bryant was named an "All-Star" in his second season in 1998 at the age of 19, the youngest in the NBA's history to receive it. Continuing to show his excellent basketball skills, he was named the "Most Valuable Player"(MVP) in 2008. He played for the United States of America in the 2008 and 2012 Olympics and won gold medal in both the events.

In 2013, he suffered a torn Achilles tendon. This resulted in a fractured knee while playing in the 2013-2014 tournament. He was unable to play due to a serious injury while trying to continue playing. He announced his retirement after it became clear that he could no longer play basketball. He won five NBA titles with his talent and hard work over 20 years of his sporting life. He won not only the titles but also the hearts of the fans.

Bryant's great efforts led him to form a charity trust with all the players, to help schools. He organised summer camps every year. Unexpectedly, he lost his life in a helicopter crash on January 26, 2020. The persistence

he had from his childhood made him the basketball player that everyone admires today.

Bryant had a great zeal for basketball since the age of 3. Because of his petite height, he could only watch and admire and could not play. Bryant's two sisters turned him into a standout player in both football and basketball.

As Bryant grew older, his passion and talent for basketball began to increase. He was obsessed with basketball. He not only nurtured the desire, but also began to make efforts and practices for it. His family returned to Pennsylvania in 1991. He joined the basketball team at Laya Merion High School. His hard work led to four years of state championships. He started

playing seriously. Despite high SAT (Scholastic Assessment Test) scores in high school, he decided to skip college and trained hard with his first ambition being to join the NBA. Bryant declared for the 1996 NBA draft and was unanimously selected by the Charlotte Hornets. He was then traded to the Lakers.

Evangelism to the Gentiles by Peter the Revivalist (Acts 10) In the port city of Caesarea, Italy, there lived a centurion named Cornelius,

who was pious, God-fearing with all his household, who gave a lot of charity to the people, and always prayed to God. At the ninth hour of the day, when Cornelius was praying. He saw in a vision that an angel of God coming to him and asking him to send men to the city of Joppa and invite Simon, whose surname is Peter, telling him the exact location and in whose house he was staying and also told that "he would tell you what you should do."

Peter also goes to the upper room of Simon's house to offer his midday prayer, as per the Jewish traditions. While he was

very hungry and wanted to eat, when the food was being prepared, he got enlightened (in a vision) and saw a big cage tied on all four ends descending in front of him and had been left on the ground, and in it were all kinds of four-footed animals of the earth, wild beasts, creeping things, and birds of the air. And a voice came to him telling, *"Rise, Peter; kill and eat."* His mind did not want to eat the creatures shown in the vision even though he was hungry, as he clearly remembered the list of animals mentioned by the Lord in the Old Testament as clean and unclean (Leviticus 11, Deuteronomy 14). He said that "I have never eaten anything that is unclean." By this it's obvious that he did not allow his human emotions or physical

his human emotions or physical weaknesses to violate the Jewish practices and God's commandments.

Just as the verse, "by the mouth of two or three witnesses the matter shall be established" (Deuteronomy 19:15), a voice saying, "What God has cleansed you must not call common" is heard three times. As he contemplates the Lord's confirmation of something to him through this vision, three men sent by Cornelius arrive at Peter's door looking for him. The Holy Spirit too instructed him to go with them without doubting anything. When Jesus first sent his twelve apostles to the ministry, he commanded that "Do not go into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter a

city of the Samaritans. But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." But the Holy Spirit is now instructing him to go with the Gentile people. Peter could have thought that doing so would be antithetical to the Jewish upbringing. However, he obeys instantly without arguing. He immediately went downstairs and invited them into the house and hospitably shared the prepared food with them. This probably would have been the first time a Jew had invited a

Gentile into his home. It might have been a bit difficult for Peter, giving him a sense of guilt and anxiety that other Jews might hate him and ostracize him. However, his obedience to the Lord reflects his true discipleship, love, respect and faith in the Lord. The next day, taking with him a few men from the city of Joppa, he travels over a day's journey of about 30 miles to Caesarea and arrives at the house of Cornelius. In general, Roman military leaders



were characterized by valour, irreverence, intelligence, ability to quell rebellions, and fighting for their country until death. But Cornelius was unique in being loving, affectionate, patient, considerate of others, humble, and God-fearing. When Peter enters his house. Cornelius falls at

Peter's feet without considering his authority and status before his kinsmen and friends. Peter neither embracing this act of Cornelius nor equating himself to God, immediately lifts

Cornelius and humbles himself that he is only a man.

This event at the house of Cornelius took place 8 years after the day of Pentecost. The first idea of the Church's first message to the Gentile was that, "God is not partial." Peter bearing witness to the life. death and resurrection

of Jesus spoke about judgment and forgiveness of sins. Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard

patiently safeguarded among them. The congregation glorified God that "God has also granted to the Gentiles repentance to life."

Child trafficking:

In India, nearly 60 thousand children are kidnapped every year. Every eight minutes, a child is kidnapped and 174 children go missing each day. According to the Children Welfare Board, five lakh children go missing each year of which only 50% are rescued back and returned; the life of the remaining 50% is a question mark. Most of the children who are kidnapped are forced into labor, begging and prostitution. According to "The Times of India", in Tamilnadu at least 5 children go missing each day. These children face physical abuses and are affected by STDs like AIDS and face a harsh future of fear, anxiety, stress, shame and blame.

Child Labor:

According to the data from the International Labor Organization, around 153 million children between the ages of 5 and 17 are child laborers. Out of this 73 million people are engaged in hazardous occupations. In the world's poorest countries, one in four children engage in work that harms their health. Almost half (72 million) of child labor is found in Africa. One out of every five children work as a child laborer. Child labor is on the rise in East Asia. The shocking fact is that child labor is found not only in the developing East Asian and African countries but also in well-developed American and European countries. CACL has reported that there are 70 to 80 million child laborers in India alone. Similarly, it has also reported that there is child labor in Bangladesh as well.

Prayer points:

- Let us pray that God himself should rescue the children who have been turned into child laborers.
- Let us pray that this situation of turning children into laborers will change and families will be blessed.
- Let us pray for the rescue of children who are involved in the most dangerous occupations of child labour.
- Let us pray to stop children from being taken as child labour and are sold into anti-social activities such as drugs, trafficking and prostitution.
- Let us pray that the middlemen involved in this will be delivered from this sin and abandon this business.



Child Marriages

The National Family Health Survey (NFHS-5) conducted a survey of around 11,346 families from July 2nd to November 14th, 2019. In this survey, Andhra Pradesh occupies the first position with the highest number of child marriages at 29.3%. Although the number of child marriages in Andhra Pradesh has declined from 33 percent in the previous survey, Andhra Pradesh continues to be at the top compared to other states. Telangana holds the second place with a percentage of 23.5, Karnataka holds the third place with a percentage of 21.3, Tamil Nadu in the fourth place with 12.8% and Kerala in the last place with 6.3%. Apart from this, the study has also found that women between the ages of 15 and 19 are married and have children. Child marriages in India have decreased by 3.3% as per the NHFS (The National Health and Family Survey) survey conducted in 2019-2020 and 2020-2021. Tamil Nadu also reported a decrease of 3.59% and 12.8% child marriages. India tops the list of child marriages in the world.

Prayer points:

- Let us pray that child marriage should be completely eradicated from our nation.
- Let us pray for the protection of the children and awareness to be created among parents who are thinking about child marriage.
- Let us pray for the government to make the minors aware of this and give them the power to prevent it.
- Let us pray for the deliverance and comfort of the children who are suffering from mental anguish and distress due to child marriage.
- It is regrettable that India ranks first in child marriage in the world. Let us pray for the transformation of people in India.

Students' Suicide

The number of students who died of suicide has increased by 4.5% in 2021, according to the latest data from the National Crime Records Bureau. In 2021, 1834 students committed suicide in Maharashtra. 1308 students committed suicide in Madhya Pradesh and 1246 students in Tamil Nadu. In 2020, 12,526 students committed suicide, while in 2021 this number has raised to 13,089. Between 2017 and 2019, student's suicide case accounted around 7.40% to 7.60% of the country's total suicide cases. In 2020 it has increased to 8.20% and in 2021 it was decreased to 8%. Out of 10,732 students under the age of 18 who committed suicide, the report says, 864 students have failed in their exams. Since 2017, student's suicide cases have increased by 32.15%. The total number of student suicide cases in 2017 was 9,905.

Prayer points:

- Let us pray that suicidal thoughts among students should be eliminated and suicidal spirits will be curbed.
- Let's pray that the spirits that lead to suicide due to exam failure will be bound and the mindset of students will change.
- Let us pray for God's governance and protection over the students in India.
- Let us pray that awareness centers should be opened in schools for the school going students.
- Let us pray for God's protection so that no student commits suicide anymore.

Dear young people in Christ, it is a great pleasure to meet you again through this Red Alert series. Through this article, we are meditating on the fact that those who were known by God and who were running the race well, because of their small mistake, sin, and disobedience, turned away from God's call and received a deadly punishment. In this

month's alert series, we will be meditating on Balaam, the son of Beor. In Numbers chapter 22-24 we read about Balaam. The Moabite king feared the Israelites, so he called Balaam to curse them. However, Balaam blessed the Israelites three times. But in Numbers 31:8, it is written that the Israelites killed Balaam. Why should the Israelites kill Balaam who had blessed them?

Though Balaam was a prophet whom God had blessed with special gifts, his heart was never pleasing to God. What caused him to fall into this stringent judgment?

LUST FOR MONEY, COVETOUSNESS

Balak, the king of Moab, sent the elders of his country to Balaam with the diviner's fee to curse the Israelites. At first, Balaam enquired about it to God and rejected their request (Numbers 22:13). The Moabite King again sent honourable Princes (Numbers 22:15). When he saw that honourable Princes with great wealth had

come to see him, his heart began to yearn for it. Balaam who did God's will, on seeing the fame and riches drifted from God's will and began praying to God about going with Balak. God was not pleased with this, but as Balaam kept praying, the Lord allowed him to go on one condition. His heart was perverse in the sight of God (Num 22:30).

His heart was set on the rewards that the Moabite King would give rather than doing what God had said. The things that he did against God's will, was the beginning of his downfall. In 2 Peter 2: 15, it is written, "they

have forsaken the right way and gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Beor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness." Even in our lives our purpose should be to please the Lord. Our purpose will not be fulfilled if we set our hearts on money, wealth or fame and the end of it will be destruction.

BALAAM - THE CAUSE OF ISRAEL'S STUMBLING

After Balaam was warned by the Lord's angel he went and met Balak. Although Balak was called to curse the nation of Israel, he blessed them three times as the Lord commanded him. Balak was enraged with this. Balaam gave Balak a false advice to appease Balak's anger and get rewards from him. We read about this in Rev 2: 14, "the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit sexual immorality." In Num 25 :1, we see, the people began to commit harlotry with the women of Moab. The cause of this stumbling was Balaam, who went to speak the word of the Lord, and became the cause of the profanation of the Lord by his desire



for money. Balaam advised the Moabite King that no one can curse Israel, except God if Israel sinned against Him. Therefore, to this day Balaam has been used to symbolise the people who entice others to sin.

In Num 31: 8, we read that the Israelites killed him. His end was tragic. Today, does

our walk, speech, deeds, holiness glorify God before others? Or cause others to stumble? Let us analyse ourselves and act.

Dear young people! Each month we continue to read about the birds mentioned in the Bible. In that order, this month we will be talking about the bird 'Crow'. Let's take a look at some interesting facts about crows and some lessons we can learn from them.

SOME INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT CROWS

- There are about 40 species of crows in the world.
- Tree crows typically live up to 20 years.
- Crows are the most intelligent of birds.
- They have sharp vision and strong wings.
- Crows are omnivorous, eating fruits, seeds, grains, worms, frogs, crabs, fish, rats, and dead animals.
- Crow is a gregarious bird. It has the characteristic of not eating the food it has got by itself, but calls its species and shares it.
- Dead and rotting carcasses are disposed of by crows feeding on them. Thus the environment is protected of pollution.

Crows are mentioned in 11 places in the Bible as 'Ravens'. Raven is the first bird mentioned in the Bible. We read in Genesis 8: 7, when Noah opened the window he had made in the ark *"he sent out a raven, which kept going to and fro until the waters had dried up from the earth."*

Although the raven has many good qualities, in the scriptures the Lord adds the raven to the list of unclean birds (Leviticus 11: 13-15). He commands us not to eat them. Of the birds that Noah left out of the ark, only the dove was put back inside. But we read that the raven kept coming and going until the water dried up. Noah did not take it into the ark. The raven was a carrioneating bird, so it was waiting to eat the dead bodies of the people who were destroyed in the flood. Therefore, Noah did not take the unclean bird into the ark.

When reading I Kings 17:4-6, the prophet Elijah was hungry and the Lord fed him by sending food through a raven. When reading this, the thought arises why the Lord should feed Elijah through an unclean bird. Why should God choose the unclean crow when there are so many beautiful and clean birds? The Lord choosing an unattractive, unclean bird that is considered insignificant in everyone's eyes to feed Elijah, shows His infinite love, which is not partial, which does not ignore anyone and which does not consider a sinner.

Dear young brother, sister! Everything in God's creation has its own use. Nothing and no one should be treated with contempt. God has chosen us who were like crows lying in dirt, mud and trash and has washed us with His Holy blood, sanctified us and has kept us as vessels to do his noble work. Will you think of your Father, Jesus Christ, who has nurtured, protected, clothed and beautified you from the day you were conceived in your mother's womb to this day? "He provides food to the young ravens that cry" (Psalm 147:9). Like a crow, you may be seen today as insignificant and useless in the eyes of many. But the things that he will do with you will be tremendous and unfathomable.

Don't forget that you are special in His creation! He is the Almighty God who is with you. He is sufficient too for you!



"The Prayer of King Solomon"

INDIA'S VOTE AGAINST RUSSIA ON THE ISSUE OF UKRAINE IN THE UN!

New York, October 12: India votes against Russia in resolution condemning the annexation of 4 Ukrainian cities. The war between Ukraine and Russia has been going on for 8 months. Meanwhile, Russia illegally annexed four cities of Ukraine through war, namely Donetsk, Kherson, Luhansk, and Zaporizhzhia. This was strongly condemned by nations across the world. Following this, an immediate resolution was raised against Russia in the UN Security Council. Reacting to this, Russia used its veto power and called off the resolution.

In this case, Albania brought a resolution against Russia in the UN General Assembly which has 193 member states regarding this matter. Russia demanded that the vote on the resolution be held in secret. A referendum was held in the UN General Assembly on this request. In this, India voted against Russia for the first time. 107 countries including India voted in favour of open referendum. 13 countries voted in favour of Russia. 39 countries abstained.
