I have completed ITI (Electrical). Currently I'm studying in Harvest Evangelical Training College (HETC). Since my childhood I never obeyed my parents. I was addicted to to many sinful things like TV, cinema and serials. I would fight often with my mother and would rebel so much.

As days passed by, I got the idea to do it the same way the church conducts VBS. There was a desire in my heart to put up notice

posters for VBS like the churches did. But in those days

> we didn't have money to print such posters, so we would write on A4

sheets saying "We conduct VBS in our house" and would stick it on all the walls ourselves. Thus I had an urge to do ministry from childhood.

Great... you got the ministry urge in a very small age... Did you continue doing it?

On the one hand ministry grew up, while worldly love and worldly things started growing on the other. When I was in 8th grade, lesus pointed out a mistake that I did.

Okay... So how did you accept Jesus?

I got saved at the age of 13 when 1 was in 8th grade. But Jesus had chosen me when I was 7 years old, in my 2nd grade. At an age when I didn't even know what VBS was, I would take the kids next door to our



I wanted to change whole heartedly but I couldn't. The reason was the love of worldly friends. There was a time where I could no longer live without my friends. But still I continued doing my Sunday prayer, house prayer and VBS ministry.

But I made no effort to come out of my sin. I who thought, "There's no life without friends", faced many problems because of them. No one in this world could have spent as much money as I spent on friends. If my friends don't talk to me I would cut my hand. I would show hatred to everyone like mom and dad without eating. I was living a life thinking that 'Friends are my world'. I never did anything I liked. I would do anything for my friends. But there was no peace or joy in my heart.

It's really sad to hear ... Well friends didn't make you happy ... Did you go in search of love from friends again?

When I was studying 12th std a teacher was very kind and loving towards me. I too loved her so much. I started hating my family and I used to treat the teacher like my mother. Even that love brought only tears and sorrow. Later in ITI I got a new friend, and I shared all my stories with her. She had been married for six years and was childless. I showed her all my love thinking that she should get my love fully as she had no child. I used to keep crying if she doesn't show up to class one day. I would help her family in everything.

I have prayed a lot for her. In this situation, I joined a company and got a salary of 20,000 rupees after working there for five months. I gave only 4000 rupees to my parents and spent the remaining 16 thousand rupees on my friends. I completely forgot about Jesus and salvation. But I was also ministering out of obligation.

Okay... You lost happiness because of your friends... You forgot Jesus and did ministry out of obligation... What kind of ministry did you do?

Although I was addicted to the love of the world, the Lord remembered me and helped me to evangelize in many places. Through a Christian organisation Jesus graced me to visit and evangelize 14000 children within a year and spread the gospel. Even though I walked away from Jesus, He kept sending me to His ministry. I prayed to God saying, "For 10 months I will fast and pray for my friend by skipping one time meal, give her the blessing





of child", Likewise after 10 months, she told me that she was pregnant. Jesus heard my prayers and gave her a baby girl in 2020 and a baby boy in 2021. A six-year problem was solved.

Unexpectedly, one day my friend threw all the things I had bought her on my face, beat me in front of everyone, humiliated and sent me out of the house, saying a false accusation as I reprimanded her for doing a wrong thing. That's when I started feeling lonely. I was very depressed and sad.

When I was sitting alone dejectedly, Jesus came looking for me and said, "Daughter, the call I have upon you is different; why are you crying?". Not listening to the voice of Jesus I said, "I don't want to do ministry, open doors for me to get a job." Jesus said, "Serve me." However, I urged Him and prayed that I wanted a job, so the Lord gave me a job in a private company. Since I led many people to Christ by telling about Jesus in that place, the management severely reprimanded and warned me that "If you do this again, you will be fired." But Jesus held my head high where I was insulted. God raised me to the extent of placing a banner in the same company with my photo that said 'Best winder and worker'.

Excellent...! He lifted you in your workplace... Are you working in the same company? What are you doing now?

Jesus made me realize that worldly love is vanity, worldly things, work, money and education are all vanity. Now I have left everything behind and am studying at Harvest Evangelical Training College with full commitment for Him.

What would you like to tell to the youngsters?

The love that we shower upon others in this world is Vanity! One day that love will hurt us. But Jesus is waiting for us to show His love without expecting any returns. Only He can show true, selfless love. Our first priority should always be for Jesus.

First of all, we need to ask and know what His purpose, will and calling for us is. We are the ones always talking to him. Allow Jesus to speak. Know His will. Listen to His voice, to do His will. Only then can we fully receive God's love.

Dear young people! Sister Mary Puspham thought that 'Friends are her life' and even though she gave everything she had to her friends, she could not get the true love. In times of loneliness, the Lord met her directly, expressed His Calvary love and is using her as a witness to many today. Likewise, God can use you as well. That requires you to listen to the voice of the Lord and dedicate yourself to do only His will!■

From India to Indonesia

Warm greetings to the young achievers. Everything that happens in our life teaches us some lessons. The lessons we learn, sculpt and shape us into something beautiful that others look at and wonder about! To make your life more beautiful, here is the life of an achiever!!!

Lakshmi Mittal was born on June 15th, 1950 in an ordinary middle-class family in the state of Rajasthan. During his youth, he lived a very simple life. He was a shy and introverted teenager. Because of this, he was very reluctant to talk with others. He completed his schooling at a Hindi medium school in his childhood. As a result, he could not speak English fluently while studying in college. Inferiority complex prevailed with him because of this. He aspired to study many courses and graduate. But he was able to study only B.Com.

As Lakshmi Mittal's father was a partner in a steel company, considering the business, his family relocated to Calcutta after he finished school. While studying in college, Lakshmi Mittal used to work at his father's steel factory for at least 15 hours a day. He began working hard. In this situation, the Indian Government curbed steel production in India. But this did not stop Lakshmi Mittal. He did not change his business considering the situation. Having pondered about what to do next, he bought a steel manufacturing plant in Indonesia, renovated it and started manufacturing steel. He found great success in this. He made the world look back on steel production. Mittal's business gradually spread to all countries. He provided jobs to over one lakh people in his factories. He was called as "Mittal – the Steel King" because of his persistent efforts and unrelenting self-confidence.

In 2004, 'Mittal Steel' became the world's largest steel producer, producing 42. I million tonnes of steel. The company made over \$22 billion in profits. He also

bought his competitor Arcelor and built it into the world's largest steel company under the name of Arcelor Mittal. It is now the largest steel manufacturing company in the world, producing 70 million tonnes of steel per year. He received various awards such as the Padma Vibhushan Award from the Government of India, European Business Man of the Year - 2004, and Steel Maker of the Year - 1996. He remains one of the richest people in the world. Born in India and currently residing in England, he takes the lead in steel production in various countries.

Young achievers who are reading this! Don't be discouraged. Lakshmi Mittal did not reach this peak easily. Though he was shy and inferior, he set aside all obstacles that hindered his growth, worked hard, overcame them, and attained success. When you see on YouTube, the footage of Gangtang and his wife embracing and crying their son when they saw him after 24 years, the depth of a father's love can be felt. Just as Guo Gangtang wandered in search of his child, Jesus came to this earth as the Son of Man, because man who was created in his image, had sinned and left him. **"The Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost"** (Luke 19:10).



No man desires death so easily, nor dares to face it. As "The wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23), there are innumerable prisoners in this world who live in fear of death anticipating it every day. They must suffer the punishment befitting their sinful act. No one can escape it. A prisoner called Barabbas was awaiting death because of a riot and murder he had committed. Wherever Christians are present we all can witness a cross there. When a church is built, a cross is placed on the rooftop. Many churches have a cross on the altar. Some wear chains with a cross pendant. Thus, we use cross in many ways. There are many types of crosses made of wood, gold and silver.

WHAT DOES THE CROSS REVEAL TO US?

The cross reveals us how terrible sin is. It reveals the power and dreadfulness of sin. So, whenever we look at the cross, we must realize how horrible our sin is. That is why the cross is used as a symbol in churches and homes. Crucifixion was a capital punishment given by the Roman government to those who committed murder and robbery, who

rebelled against the government, and those who committed flagrant crimes.

If the government had decided to crucify a man, they would beat him ruthlessly, strip him of his clothes, and leave him nailed to a cross. Bleeding little by little, he will be tormented, suffer a deadly agony and die hating his life. Crucifixion is such a flagrant death.

So why should the God who created the heavens, the earth and us hang on that cross? What crime did He do? What sin did He do? Why did the government punish Him? The Bible clearly says that, He neither sinned nor did any crime. He was not crucified for His sins but for our sins, for our iniquities and for our transgressions.

My dear young people! He gave Himself to hang on the cross for your sin and mine. No crime was found against Him. No one could say He was guilty. But He hanged on the cross

like an accused. Our iniquities and our sins took Jesus to the cross. The cross showed us how dreadful that sin is. It is our sin and crime that led the holy, sinless God to the cross. Whenever we look upon the cross, we can feel how terrible our sin is. The holy God was hung like a robber amidst the robbers. When we ask Him to cleanse us, His blood will cleanse our sins and purify us.

I know a servant of God. He was working doing God's ministry as well. One day while sitting and meditating in the presence of God, he had a vision were Jesus was hanging on the cross with His hands and feet nailed, His head covered with spikes and His face covered in blood. At that moment there came a black figure. That seemed to be a man. But his face was not clear. That figure began to shake the hanging body of Jesus Christ and that pain when he shook could be seen in the face of Jesus.

Then he ran away. Soon he returned back and again shook the body of Christ. This time it was even more painful for Jesus Christ. He did this again for two or three more times. When that missionary witnessed this in his vision, he angrily asked lesus on the cross, "Who is that man who is shaking and tormenting you over and over again?" And the Lord said, "You are that man, do you know that every time you sin again and again, you torment me on the cross like that?" The man broke and cried. When he surrendered himself to God saying he will not sin and torment Him anymore, God gave him a beautiful Tamil song, 'En kaigal paavangal seidhittaal tham kaiyin kaayangal paarkindraare, theeya vazhilyil en kaalgal sendraal tham kaalin kaayangal paarkindraare' (When my hands sin, He sees the wounds of His hands, when my legs go in a wrong path, he looks at the wounds of His legs).

The cross reveals how great is the love of God towards us who created the heaven and earth. In Romans 5:8 it says **"But God** demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Also in I John 4:10 it says, **"In** this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins." If we want to know how great the Lord's love for us is, we must stand before the cross. Only when we stand before Jesus Christ hanging on the cross we can understand the love He has for us.



We can see His love for us on the cross. His love is revealed on the cross. He gave Himself on the cross for us and gave us the assurance of forgiveness. And we are privileged even more that He calls us His sons and daughters. How blessed are we! What can we give in return for this love? He died for our sins and that cross reveals the love HE has for us. Our heavenly Father gave His only begotten Son to die on the cross for us because He loved us. His blood cleanses all our sins.

My dear youth! Are you trapped in a sin? Do you feel guilty and worried because of your sins? The blood of Jesus is there to forgive and cleanse you. Surrender yourself in front of the cross saying, "I will not do this sin again. I will not crucify Jesus again and again on the cross. I will always lead a holy life." Can marching around a super strong double layered wall for 7 days make it fall? Yes, it will! Because our God is the one who can destroy anything that hinders His beloved people.

Dear young people! In this section, we will continue to read the strategies used by the Lord to make the wall of Jericho, which was shut up against the Israelites, fall without a battle or any attacks.

When the Israelites were a few steps ahead to the promised land Canaan, they were blocked by the flooding, Jordan. After they miraculously crossed it, Jericho's barred wall awaited them. If you see a succession of struggles and blocked doors in your life, believe that the Breaker of barriers is passing before you.

The walls of Jericho were built in about 8000 B.C. It is a town in the valley of Jordan. This wall was built to protect the people from floods due to rains. Do you know what was the strategy of God to overcome this wall? It is just to march around the wall!

As the Lord commanded, "Proceed, and march around the city, and let him who is armed advance before the ark of the Lord." Joshua prepared the people of Israelites to march around the walls for 7 consecutive days. The people of Jericho were confused to see the people of Israel marching around the wall without making any attack. As the Lord had said, when they marched around the wall seven times on the seventh day, when the priests blew the trumpets and people shouted with a great shout the wall fell down flat.

TO ENCOUNTER SUCH EXTRAORDINARY THINGS IN OUR LIFE, WE MUST PAY ATTENTION TO THE BELOW GIVEN DETAILS IN THIS INCIDENT;

• Jericho was shut before the Israelites. No one went in and no one went out." In this situation, Joshua looked unto the Lord. Therefore, we must also be careful to run to the Lord's presence first in any situation.

• When Joshua told the people about God's plan, they did not grumble, did not ask 'How is this possible' and did not delay. They immediately acted as God commanded them. Likewise, in such situations we too must listen and obey to God's word immediately without delay.

• Do you know the secret of the collapse of such a big wall that was the identity, majesty and pride of the city of Jericho? It was Obedience (Joshua 1:1-16). Since Joshua and his people were ready to obey the Lord's word, the Lord broke all the barriers which was against them.

The book of Zephaniah was written during the years 640 – 612 B.C in the Palestine. The prophet Zephaniah is the author of this book (Zephaniah 1:1).

This month in our 'Promises and Conditions' series, we are going to see about the experiences of Joseph, a young man. The God who blessed many of our forefathers through promises, gave Joseph dreams regarding his future. What was that dream? He said, "There we were, binding sheaves in the field. Then behold, my sheaf arose and also stood upright: and indeed your sheaves stood all around and bowed down to my sheaf." (Genesis 37:7) and "Then he dreamed still another dream and told it to his brothers, and said, "Look, I have dreamed another dream. And this time, the sun, the moon and the eleven stars bowed down to me." (Genesis 37:9). The scripture says that because of the second dream, his father rebuked him saying, "Shall your mother and I and your brothers indeed come to bow down to the earth before you?" (Genesis 37:10). These dreams were fulfilled in the land of Egypt where he was taken as a slave. (Genesis 37:36)



Joseph means "Increase" or "Increaser". Joseph grew up with the fear of the Lord and good character from his childhood. God had blessed him with the gift to dream even from his childhood. Since Joseph was born as the 11th child to Israel in his very old age, he was loved more than others. Israel made him beautiful clothes and rejoiced in doing so. He showered all his love on Joseph. Joseph was a pet child to his father Israel.



Joseph's brothers hated him because, amongst all the brothers, their father loved Joseph the most. His brothers hated him all the more for his dreams saying, "Shall you indeed reign over us?" When Joseph came to seek the welfare of his brothers in the wilderness, they saw him from far off and said to each other that the 'dreamer is coming'. Even before he came near, they conspired to kill him and so they threw their father's pet child into a pit. (Genesis 37:5, 8, 18, 24)



They pulled him from the pit and sold him as a slave for 20 pieces of silver to the merchants who were going to Egypt from Gilead. The merchants sold Joseph in Egypt to Potiphar, where he became a servant in his house. May be Joseph would have been worried thinking, "I never dreamed that all this would happen. Is the Lord with me? Is this the way of the Lord?" Days passed by. It was at that moment when he was a trustworthy person to his master, there came another test through his master's wife. When there was an opportunity to sin and to fulfill the youthful lust, Joseph said 'How can I do such a great wickedness and sin against my God." So He left his clothes and ran away. Joseph was falsely accused and imprisoned for a crime that he did not commit.



Joseph's life did not end in prison. There came a day when King Pharaoh had a dream and none of the Egyptian magicians were able to interpret it. Therefore, Joseph was quickly brought to the palace before Pharaoh, the king of Egypt from prison and stood before him. (Genesis 41:14)

Since Pharaoh got the answer to his dreams, he gave Joseph the responsibility to safe guard the people of the nation from the great famine that was coming and also set him over all the land of Egypt.



and put it on Joseph's hand; he had him ride in the second chariot and gave him great authority and raised Joseph as the ruler of the country. The entire nation of Egypt came under his control (Genesis 41:41-44).

Not just that, as Joseph dreamt, the same brothers who hated him and sold him to traders, God made them to fall at Joseph's feet. (Genesis 42:6, 43:26, 28). He also met his father whom he thought that he would never meet and rejoiced (Genesis 46:29)

My dear Son! Daughter! At the age of 17 Joseph was taken as a slave to Egypt, and at the age of 30 he became the governor of Egypt. It did not happen at the blink of an eye or in an easy manner. For almost 13 years he suffered much. Though God led him through a path of shame, reproaches, insults, hunger, starvation, tears, prison, he was faithful and honest before the Lord and before his master, that all could say that 'The Lord was with Joseph.' God gave him a high position that no one can comprehend or can recommend. The reason being His ways are higher than our ways. Hallelujah!

My dear children! Are you sobbing thinking, 'Why these tears in my life? Why such consecutive failures? Why so many difficulties? Why this loneliness? Why this imprisonment? Is God not with me?' Are you feeling as if you were thrown into a terrible pit? Are you suffering for no fault of yours? Are you stumbling on thoughts like - Is God with me? Is this God's way? Do not worry. There is a Redeemer for you, who is compassionate, who brought you up out (Psalm 40:2) and gave you the Spirit of adoption by whom you cry out Abba, Father (Romans 8:15) and to bring you back from captivity (Deuteronomy 30:3). But he didn't want this mistake to stop him from winning, so he ran hard and surprised everyone by taking the top spot. Perhaps If he had thought that, I have run astray; I can't win anymore', he wouldn't have achieved that victory. Caleb

When we read about Felix Kirwa, we can understand that 'if a man guides us, it is more likely to go wrong, and even cause losses'.

But when we rely on Jesus and when He guides us, there won't be any flaws and the run will not be interrupted. The best example for this is the evangelist Philip. What was the reason for his success?

He acted boldly

In the days of Philip's ministry, tribulation and distress were abundant. It was then that Stephen died as a martyr. Obstacles, troubles, persecutions and imprisonments were frequent to prevent the spread of the revival. Even under such circumstances, Philip's run was not hindered (Acts 8:6). He was actively proclaiming the gospel. The reason for that is 'Philip was full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom' (Acts 6:3) says the Bible.

Only when there is a fullness of the Holy Spirit, one will have the courage and faith that is necessary to act boldly for God. There were many reasons and obstacles for Philip not to evangelize. But all those crumbled before the power of the Holy Spirit. There is a famous saying in English that "Fortune favors the brave." It means, "Luck fruitions the one who acts boldly."

In the same way, God wants to use those who act courageously for Him in ministry. As Philip ministered bravely for God, the gifts and powers of the Holy Spirit worked through him. Many people got liberated and were saved through him. Today, God is looking for young people who dare to act courageously for Him. He is ready to fill them with gifts and power and use them. Therefore let us prevail over the oppositions, struggles and problems that prevent us from rising up, through the power of the Holy Spirit and commit ourselves to act intensively in this revival.

He listened precisely to the voice of the Spirit:



Another reason Philip did great things for Jesus was that, he was careful to listen to the voice of the Spirit. The Spirit taught him where to go and what to say. In Acts 8, the Holy Spirit told Philip to go into the wilderness. Then he asked him to join the chariot of the Ethiopian minister who came that way.

A minister of a nation was saved as Philip was heeding and acting upon all the promptings of the Spirit. If Philip had thought that, "There will be no one in the wilderness, and what I shall do where there is no one?" not heeding the voice of the Lord, the minister could not have been saved.

Bible researchers speculate that the gospel preached by the Ethiopian minister may have gone into the land of Ethiopia and within the African continent. Trusting, believing, and acting upon the leading of the Spirit brought blessing not just to a man or to a nation, but to a continent. When we too obey the voice of the Spirit who dwells within us, we can become a blessing not only to a man, but to a nation.

The robber who became worthy of Paradise!

In the Holy Scriptures, there are people known by their deeds, speech or prayer, without being mentioned by name. Notable among the figures is the robber who was crucified with Jesus, who became worthy for paradise. As we celebrate the resurrection of Christ this month, let us imagine a conversation between our reporter and this person, if they had met each other.

Reporter: Hello anna!

Robber: Hello!

Rep: Can you share your experience with Jesus on the cross to our youngsters?

Robber: Dear brother, I am not a prayer or faith warrior, disciple or an apostle. I was a robber who was condemned to death by the Sadducees, Pharisees, and all men, was called an iniquitous man, worthy of the death penalty, and put to death on the cross. Why have you chosen me for the interview?

Rep: Anna, every man knows only after his death whether he is destined for eternal life or eternal damnation. But even before you die, you got a vow from Jesus that you will be in paradise. Truly you are great!

Robber: Yes. Great was His mercy towards me. Well... Let me share it with you in detail. At first I thought of Jesus as an ordinary man like me. The people who went past our crosses blasphemed Jesus badly. They mocked Him saying, "He saved others; Himself He cannot save." Even we the crooks who were crucified with Him reviled Him.

Rep: Did Jesus react something to it?

Robber: No, He was silent. But His face was full of sorrow.

Rep: ls it?

Robber: The first word Jesus spoke was, Father! Forgive them!' I was touched by these words.

Rep: How?

Robber: Jesus went around doing good to everyone. The Pharisees and Sadducees were jealous and sentenced him to death. The torments that He went through on the cross are indescribable. Every part of His body throbbed with agony. He could not even speak. Even in that situation He didn't talk out of anger or curse anyone. He had no desire for revenge in him. Instead, He forgave every evil thing they did to Him with a heart full of love. Those who hurt him did not apologize. They did not feel that what they have done is wrong. It is impossible for an ordinary man to pray to his Father in such great agony for forgiveness of those wicked, stonehearted people, not wanting them to be punished who have caused him great pain. It was only then that I could realize that Jesus was special and divine.

Rep: What do you think of the ones who crucified you?

Robber: Even though I was rightfully punished for my deeds, I wasn't able to forgive them. I had a lot of anger on them and was cursing them in my heart.

Rep: What happened after that?

Robber: It was only when I compared myself

to Jesus that I got an understanding heart. My soul accepted that He is the son of God. All the words that Jesus had said and the words that I had heard about him came to my mind. I believed that everything Jesus said was true.

Rep: Did the other friend who was crucified with you believe in Jesus?

Robber: No. He desired only temporary blessings of the world. That is, He wanted 'Jesus, the Son of God to prove himself by freeing himself from death on the cross by his divine power and to free us too. But that didn't happen, so he did not believe in Jesus.

Rep: What did you do to get your friend to accept Jesus?

Robber: I advised him to fear God. I rebuked him saying, "And we indeed justly, for we receive

the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong" when he blasphemed Jesus. But he did not take it seriously.

Rep: Mmm... What happened then?

CREATIVE MEASURES TO RESTORE PEACE IN UKRAINE!

QUAD FOREIGN MINISTERS JOINT STATEMENT!

A joint statement by the Foreign Ministers said that they discussed taking constructive steps to bring justice and peace

to Ukraine at the Quad Conference in Delhi. QUAD is a defense cooperation organization of four countries India, USA, Japan and Australia. (Its conference was held in Delhi yesterday.) The G-20 Foreign Ministers' Conference was held in Delhi for the last 2 days. Foreign ministers from 40 countries, including the United States and Australia, participated in this. Following this, the Quad Foreign Ministers Conference was held in Delhi yesterday under the chairmanship of Union External Affairs Minister Jaishankar. Japanese Foreign Minister Yoshimasa Hayashi had come to Delhi to attend.

In a joint statement released by the QUAD foreign ministers after the meeting, the QUAD organization discussed the war in Ukraine and its impact on the people. It was decided that the threat of using nuclear weapons in this war should never be accepted. They discussed the need to take constructive steps to bring justice to Ukraine and return to peace, subject to the rules set by international organizations including the UN. A country's sovereignty, territorial integrity, transparency and peaceful settlement of disputes were emphasized in accordance with international law.

Also, as China's continued aggressive activities are a cause for concern, a detailed analysis of the Indo-Pacific situation has been undertaken. Actions will be taken to support the region by increasing cooperation on health care, climate change, clean energy transition, emerging technologies and infrastructure.

CHINA CONDEMNED THE JOINT STATEMENT!

China's Ministry of Foreign Affairs spokesman Mao Ning met with reporters in Beijing to strongly condemn the joint statement of the Quad foreign ministers, saying, "Each country should take extra steps to contribute to the region's mutual trust, peace and regional stability. "But the Quad organization tries to uphold its uniqueness rather than the stability of the region. QUAD acts as a personal deterrent to China's growth," he condemned.
