Bro. Abhishanth

In this edition, let us see the testimony of Bro. Abhishanth, who was caught in the addiction of cinema despite being born into a Sri Lankan Christian family. Though he derailed due to a lack of right fellowship, God met and delivered him and is now using him as a prayer warrior for the revival of Sri Lanka. Here is the interview with him.

Tell us about your family.

I was born, raised, and currently reside with my family in Sri Lanka. My mother teaches in a government school, whereas my father owns a business. My older brother is in his final year of engineering. Recently, my younger brother took his board exams. I'm in my last year of studying software engineering. Being a Christian, my mother often took us to church and prayed for our family's salvation every day. In 2014, my mother's prayers were

heard, and we attained salvation through an uncle. Even after that, we did not have a great prayer life. Our only interaction with God was through family prayer.

You told us about your lovely family. How were you during your teenage years?

I used to watch 4–5 films each day. My friend catches it first and then passes it on to me. I used to stay up watching films till 4 am. Whenever a new film was released, we used to compete to watch it first and discuss the plot with one another after watching it. We

solely discussed films and nothing else.

How did God deliver you from this movie addiction?

Let me tell you... I participated in the World Revival Vision Camp in 2022. Even before going to that camp, I downloaded a list of films that I could watch to pass the time. I told myself, "If there is no prayer in the night, let me start watching films." But God spoke to me through every single word at the camp. I initially thought, "How am I going to survive here when the place is filled with sounds of prayer?" But the words transformed me, and I gave myself up to the Lord and asked him to deliver me from this addiction. Jesus spoke to me during the prayer and delivered me.

I wasn't able to comprehend how God had delivered me from this bondage. When I went to bed that night after the camp, I had no thought of picking up my phone. I had a different phone that I used just for watching films, but I stopped using it after that day and stopped watching films across all media. Soon, I realised that God had touched my heart that day.

Great, the Lord came looking for you and redeemed you... How is your spiritual life now?

Now I spend an hour and a half every day in prayer for my country. I prayed for Sharukshan,



a friend with whom I used to watch films, to be freed from his addiction as well. God graciously heard my prayer and redeemed him too when he attended a meeting in Sri Lanka and prayed.

Now both of us are praying and reading the Bible together. Now all our conversations have drifted towards the gospel and prayer.

Super! God saved your friend Sharukshan too. Shall we talk to him about his transformation? Sharukshan, can you tell us about yourself and the recent changeover?

Greetings, I'm Sharukshan. I live in Mattakalappu, Sri Lanka. My father is an auto driver, and my mother is a homemaker. I have a younger sister. Abhishanth and I have been friends for 18 years. I am a traditional Christian who was baptised at birth. However, I was a namesake Christian who only attended church on occasion.

I also used to watch 4 to 5 films a day. Except for the time I sleep, I spend the rest of the hours watching films. I also share the movie links with everyone and ask them to watch them. Abhishanth used to go to sleep only after watching the films I send him. I wasn't engaged in my academics because I was a film and phone addict, and finally I was unable to continue my education.

Well, after your friend accepted Jesus as his saviour, did you also have the urge to accept Christ as your personal saviour?

Yes, I was able to notice a significant difference in him after he got back from the World Revival Vision Camp. Upon seeing him, a desire arose within me to talk to God as well. I longed for peace and deliverance. During this time, I heard of a fasting prayer in Sri Lanka and attended it with great enthusiasm. I felt the touch of Jesus on the very first day and was filled with the Holy Spirit. I had also downloaded films on my mobile to watch while before going to the three-day-long prayer camp. But I had no intention of watching. I, who doesn't pray even for a minute, am now praying for 1 1/2 hours every morning and night on my knees. Apart from that, we are praying for the nation together as a group.

What message do you have for the young people reading this?

If we live our lives in sin, thinking, "Only in my youth can I enjoy everything, so let me relish it now and seek God when I am old", we will be abandoned by God. Your day of salvation has come; now is the time to turn from your sins and submit to God and He shall embrace you, saying, "Oh, my loving child!" Come to Jesus without any further delay!

Dear youngsters! If God can redeem Abhishanth and Sharukshan from Sri Lanka and turn them into determined prayer warriors, praying for the revival of their nation and world, He can set you free as well from the strongholds and use you mightily in revival! ■



The Fall of Assyrian Kingdom

In this series "Great in Counsel", we have been learning about God's powerful strategies for the Israelites when wars were fought against them. In continuation of that, we shall discover how God sent an Angel and created confusion to help the Israelites defeat the powerful Assyrian kingdom.

Yes, this is an example of how God displays His might against those who insult the living God and mock His people. (2 Kings 18, 19).

- ◀ Are you facing struggles in school or college because of being a witness for Christ?
- ◀ Are you the target of criticism for standing firm for Christ among your relatives who aren't believers yet?
- ◀ Are you ridiculed because of debt, disease, or poverty?

If you are going through such battles, be patient! Because, the God who is fighting for you is Great in Counsel and Almighty. Do not forget that! In this incident, during the time of King Hezekiah, who lived according to God's commandments, the Assyrians came to war against the Jews and criticised them because of their pride in their past victory.

Do you have similar hurtful experiences? Don't worry; the Almighty God is on your side. Do you know what the Jews did in the face of such persecution?

"...But the people held their peace and answered him not a word" (2 Kings 18:36) Yes! Whoever speaks scornfully of you, keep silence, and make no reply, as the Jews did. Only then the battle will belong to the Lord.

Moreover, the Assyrians boasted, "Has any of the gods of the nations saved their land from the hands of the king of Assyria?" Do you know what the Lord gave in return for the Assyrians' pride?

"And it came to pass on a certain night that the angel of the Lord went out and killed in the camp of the Assyrians one hundred and eighty-five thousand; and when people arose early in the morning, there were the corpses—all dead." (2 Kings 19:35)

Yes! God destroyed the entire pride of the Assyrians with just one angel of the Lord. God was especially supportive of His people, the Jews, because of their patient endurance and silence.

"God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble." (1 Peter 5:5) ■

I'll be at school from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. My home is a bit far, so I reach home by 7 p.m., and only then am I able to take care of my mother. I take tuition at home, as the salary given by the school is not enough. Due to the heavy workload at school and home, I couldn't take proper care of students in school. As the students don't have a good impression of me, they have raised complaints about me with the principal. So, the management has asked me to resign. I'm highly depressed because of this. This is the only source of income for my family. How should I handle this?

Dear Brother Shekar, I could understand your hard work as well as your heavy workload. You are overwhelmed by the sadness and pain that you are unable to take care of your mother and are not able to do your teaching work well.

I can understand your agony in this helpless situation where you are oppressed with workloads such as family burden, school in the morning, and tuition in the evening. You are on the verge of losing your job when you were looking for a promotion that would solve your problems.

Shekar, you can surely come out of this oppressive situation! For that, you need to put in some effort and do some exercises. You can certainly get the outstanding teacher and first-class teacher titles in the same school where you couldn't teach properly.

FIRST, YOU SHOULD REALISE THE SUPERIORITY OF YOUR WORK!

- A teacher is not only the one who teaches but also the one who identifies the talents and potential of his students, takes them from the dust, and turns them into gems.
- A teacher's discipline and supervision can make a student a better person.
- A teacher's character and encouragement can turn a student into a scientist or an astronaut.
- A teacher is a great sculptor who designs many such great sculptures.
- A teacher is not only the opener of a student's eyes of knowledge, but a coach who incessantly feeds into those eyes a light and a feeling of running towards the pinnacle of ascension.
- Many teachers today are suffering because they do not understand the need, excellence, power, and strength of such teaching. They torment the students as well.

Efforts to be taken

**You should have a good understanding of your students.
Here are a few strategies to find out their mindset.**

- In a class of 50 students, 20% of students hate studying.
- 20% of students trouble the teachers.
- 10% of students have a cat on the wall mindset.
- 20% of students have an interest in learning.
- 30% of students have the potential to improve with compliments and appreciation.
- 10% of students have huge ambitions to graduate and become adults.

Exercises to do

Once you know the mindset of the students, you should start approaching them accordingly.

- Think about the methods used to pique interest in those 20% who don't want to study.
- What responsibilities can be given to those 10% of students who trouble you?
- Monitoring and being strict with those 10% with a cat on the wall mindset
- How do you motivate those 20% who want to learn?
- How and when to encourage those 30% who need to be encouraged
- How to sharpen and help the learner progress.

In this way, when you get to know all the students in your class and teach them the lessons and traits that suit them, it will make a difference among the students. Those who rejected you may want you again.

When you put in some effort and practice like this, you have a chance to become a great teacher. There is a verse in the Bible that says, "Do you see a man who excels in his work? He will stand before kings; He will not stand before unknown men" (Prov. 22:29). If you are diligent and act truthfully (Prov. 22:29) and skillfully, you will not be terminated. On the contrary, you will get promotion after promotion. Try to do smart work instead of hard work. You will succeed, for sure!

And if taking tuition pressurises you, take a few days off and pray for your sick mother and watch over her with love. As you pray for your mother and spend quality time with her, you will see an improvement in her health.

According to the word of God, "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:6, 7), the Lord will strengthen you and make you live in peace. Pray and act!



Be of Good Courage!

During World War II, even in the Nazi extermination camps, people slept peacefully. When asked about the faith that brought them this sleep, their firm belief that “tomorrow will surely be a good day” kept many alive.

There is a Chinese proverb that says, ‘Get up once rather than fall down’. While running towards your dream, some setbacks and failures occur. If you don’t get weary of it, brace your heart and start running towards the goal undeterred, you will surely succeed.

In every street of India, in the corner of every cricketer’s heart, there is the thought and dream of joining the Indian cricket team. Thangarasu Natarajan started his cricket journey with such dreams.

Born in to a poor family in Chinnappampatti, Salem district, whose father was a power loom worker, and mother who runs a roadside food stall, he was determined to run towards his dream. With rigorous training, he made the most of all the opportunities he got and played in the Ranji Trophy for Tamil Nadu, garnering everyone’s attention.

When he was heading towards his goal with huge dreams, his cricket life was put on hold for a year, stating that his bowling style was wrong. But he did not give up and strengthened his mind, engaged in rigorous training and started moving towards his cricket dream again.



He caught everyone's attention in the IPL matches and became the first Indian cricketer to debut in all three internationals in a single tour by being included in the Indian team. After that, despite not getting regular opportunities in the Indian team, he did not get weary or discouraged and created a cricket ground in his own village and is now producing good quality athletes.

When our dreams and plans are not fulfilled, our hearts become weary and weak. We lose our strength and confidence to the point where we can't think about what to do next. Don't lose heart when you are surrounded by various struggles, conflicts, financial problems and future fears. Be strong and believe in Jesus who said, "...in the world you will have tribulation, but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world" (John 16:33). He will make things happen for you.

The team sent by King Cyrus to build the temple in Jerusalem, led by Zerubbabel, traveled about 900 miles and began the construction of the temple in Jerusalem. When the adversaries heard the news that the foundation of the church was being laid and that they were building a temple for the Lord, "the people of the land tried to discourage the people of Judah. They troubled them in building", (Ezra 4:4) and did things to frustrate their purpose.

For almost 16 years, the construction of the temple was ceased. Due to this, many who started the construction work on the temple got weary and gave up. They were stuck, not knowing about the next move, and were waiting thinking that "the time has not come to build the temple of the Lord". Then the Lord, through the prophet Haggai, strengthened Zerubbabel's heart and hands so that he

could not abandon hope and restarted the construction of the temple.

Zerubbabel did not give up despite the oppositions, struggles and intrigues of men that befell in his life. He stayed strong and built the temple according to the Lord's word: "He

will not be afraid of evil tidings; His heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord" (Psalm 112:7).

There is no doubt that the Lord Jesus Christ will definitely do whatever He decides to do with you. When struggles and tribulations come in your life, don't grow weary, be vigilant and courageous. As you move forward with unwavering faith that the Lord is with me, and don't let your heart weaken you will surely succeed.

My dear youth! Don't fear the future with your present. Look unto the words and promises of God who is mighty to change your predicament. "Be strong and do not let your hands be weak, for your work shall be rewarded!" (2 Chron. 15:7), says the Lord.

When negative things took place in Zerubbabel's life, he did not lose hope, but trusted God and turned things around. Don't get discouraged by your circumstances, "Behave courageously" (2 Chron. 19:11) The Lord will be with you and give you victories! ■



Gideon

Read: Judges chapters 6 - 8

After Joshua, God raised up many judges such as Othniel, Ehud, Shamgar, and Deborah. We have seen about 4 judges in the last 4 months. This month let us look at Gideon, the 5th judge.

Introduction

Gideon means 'great destroyer'. He belongs to Ophrah. His father's name was Joash. He was renamed Jerubbaal by his father when he cut down the grove of the Baals. He was very humble during his call. Despite his fear, he obeyed the Lord and destroyed Baal's altar and cut down the grove overnight. By asking for a sign from God, he dedicated himself to save Israel with his own hands.

VIRTUES

- He dealt with the Ephraimites, the troublemakers, with kind language.
- He taught the scorning strangers a lesson with thorns. Despite his victory, he refused to accept the throne.
- Gideon did not turn away even when those who led him drifted from their ways.

INVASION AND CONQUEST

- Gideon and the hundred men who were with him came to the outpost of the camp and blew the trumpets and broke the pitchers that were in their hands. In the same way, others also blew their trumpets, broke the pitchers, and cried loudly.
- And the Lord set every man's sword against his companion throughout the whole camp.
- He defeated a large army with just 300 men carrying torches, pitchers and trumpets without a sword in hand.
- When Gideon, who was a coward due to his fearful nature, obeyed the word of the Lord who spoke to him, God gave him the strength to defeat 1 lakh and 35 thousand people.

WEAKNESSES AND FAILURES

- Without the counsel of God, he turned the plundered objects into an ephod. He paved the way for all of Israel to play the harlot with the ephod which was made of gold.
- This thing became a snare to Gideon and to his house ■



A start with 50 paise!

Loving greetings to the young achievers! Life is loaded with a lot of hurdles. It is impractical to live life without obstacles. Every hurdle that we face in our lives teaches us some lessons that we should learn. Each of those lessons motivates us to achieve. Here is the life of an Achiever who faced a lot of hurdles and achieved through the lessons that she learned.

Patricia Thomas had a happy childhood. At the age of 17, she married a person named Narayan. The marriage, which was sweet in the initial stages, turned sour in a few years. She was deeply distressed to learn that her husband was a drug addict. As a result, she did not have sufficient money to meet the needs of her family, nor did she have the support, education, or skill to do any kind of job.

When she was perplexed as to what to do in such a situation, she began making pickles and jams at home and started selling them. The business grew and flourished. So in 1982, she started selling tea, coffee, fritters, and samosas in a small pushcart in the Marina. On the first day, there weren't enough sales. She got a profit of just 50 paise. Undaunted by this, Patricia continued to work hard.

Through her hard work, the pushcart turned into a canteen in many places. She began to progress gradually. While Patricia's life was going on happily,

unexpectedly, her daughter and husband died in a tragic accident, which shattered her life. After a short period of time, she pulled herself up and moved into the field as before.

Since she lost her daughter in the accident owing to a lack of ambulance assistance, she started an ambulance service in the same area where her daughter met with an accident and died. In memory of her deceased daughter, she started a restaurant named 'Sandeepha Restaurant'. The restaurant provides employment for 200 people. Her business, which started with a profit of just 50 paise, is now earning more than 2 lakhs per day. In 2010, she was awarded the Best Entrepreneur Award by the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI).

Dear young readers! Patricia's life wasn't a bed of roses; it was a bed of thorns. But she fought and turned it into a path to victory. Challenge the struggles in your life with courage and seek victory. Life is to be lived! ■

“Fear not, be glad and rejoice, for the Lord will do great things” (Joel 2:21).



Paul and Silas were in jail, beaten and flogged with their hands and legs tied to a tree, and were unable to move. Yet, even in the middle of the night they prayed and sang praise to God. They did not offer a prayer of tears or a prayer of supplication in prison. They sang praises to God. One can sing with joy only if there is joy in the heart.

When Paul and Silas were imprisoned, they firmly believed that, “Jesus Christ is also





in prison. He is with us". That is why they could sing happily and it was the reason the chains that bound them became loose and they saw miracles. You should also rejoice and be glad in the Lord. The joy and happiness that "Jesus Christ is always with us" must fill your hearts too. And then you too can witness miracles.

DESIRES WILL BE FULFILLED!

"Delight yourself in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart" (Psalm 37:4).

If you want the Lord to grant you the desires of your heart, first of all, practise being delighted in the Lord.

The Bible tells about a certain woman named Hannah who prayed weeping with anguish for a child. Eli who was in the church blessed Hannah saying, "Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition which you have asked of Him.". and Trivandrum)





From Mount Sinai, the Israelites travelled through the wilderness of Paran to a place called Kadesh. God told Moses, 'Choose one from each tribe and send 12 of them to spy out the land of Canaan. I will give that land to the Israelites.' Moses chose 12 people and sent them, including Joshua and Caleb, to spy on and know about the city and the people living in that land, whether they were strong or weak, few or many. After 40 days, the spies returned and reported to Moses. 10 of them gave a hopeless report that, although it was a good land, the people there were strong like giants, there were great walls around the cities, the inhabitants of Canaan are enormous, resembling giants, and we felt ourselves like grasshoppers in front of them. The Israelites were terrified upon hearing this, and decided to select a leader and return to Egypt, as they did not want to lose their lives in the land of Canaan. However, Joshua and Caleb had faith in the Lord, and they gave a positive report about it saying "Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it." But the people did not listen to them. They decided to stone and kill Joshua and Caleb. The people who did not obey the Lord and grumbled were not able to enter the Promised Land, as God's anger was upon them. (To read: Numbers 13, 14 chapters)

Dear youths! As the 10 spies were not courageous and did not trust the Lord, they could not inherit the Promised Land. Are you also fainthearted, like these 10 spies? You will gain courage when you put your faith in the Lord!!

Barak

Deborah the prophetess, told Barak that the Lord had told him to gather 10,000 men and go to the river Kishon to fight there against Jabin's army, and that the Lord would deliver Sisera, the commander of Jabin's army, into Barak's hands. When Barak heard this, he was afraid to go alone and said to her, "If you will go with me, then I will go; but if you will not go with me, I will not go!". She then assured him that she would accompany him; nevertheless, she said that there will be no glory for him in the journey he is taking, for the Lord will sell Sisera into the hand of a woman.

Barak and his 10,000 men descended from the mountain to battle Sisera's great army. The Lord routed Sisera and all his chariots and army by the sword, and Sisera got down from his chariot and fled on foot. Barak and his men pursued the chariots and defeated Sisera's army; not a man was left. But Sisera was killed by a woman called Jael. (To Read: Judges 4)

Dear youths! God did not deliver Sisera into Barak's hands, as he disobeyed God's word by putting his faith in Deborah rather than trusting the Lord who had promised him ■



A MAN AFTER GOD'S OWN HEART!

DAVID'S HORN OF OIL ANOINTING!

My dear youth! Greetings to you in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Last month we meditated on the early life of King David. Continuing this month, let's meditate on the anointing that God gave to David.

The Hebrew word Mashach means 'oiling' or 'to anoint'. The purpose of God sending Samuel the prophet to Bethlehem was to anoint David as king. But David, who was tending sheep in the wilderness, was neither informed nor invited to such a sacrifice. We saw that, David, the last child, was neglected by his parents and siblings to that extent.

The sacrifice was prepared in the temple of Bethlehem. But before the feast, Samuel the prophet called David's father Jesse and said "Send your children in order." Jesse lined up his 7 good-looking sons and sent them in order, starting with his eldest son Eliab and ending with Ozem. Samuel was deceived by their appearances. But the Lord said, "I do not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart. I refused these seven." Samuel was so confused as if that were a test for him.

Then he looked at Jesse and asked, 'Are these all the sons you have?' Then the father remembered David, the last son, who was tending the sheep, forgotten, neglected and lightly esteemed by them. He said, "There remains yet the youngest, and there he is, keeping the sheep." Even then, he didn't feel like saying, 'I will send someone and call him.' On the contrary, he introduced David to Samuel disparagingly, saying "He is a shepherd, he is not fit for this anointing and feasting."

When I was a small boy, there were six children in a family that lived near our house. Looking at the 3rd son, one of their relatives would often say, 'You are good at cooking, so you are fit only to cook'. In time, instead of sending him to school, he was kept at home as a cook.

Even in your home, do your parents disregard and hurt you in front of relatives, saying, "He is neither fit nor worthy of all this, he is an inept, a burden to the house and the earth"? Don't worry! David is no exception to all of these.



But Samuel the prophet looked at Jesse and said sternly: "Send someone and bring him. For we will not sit down to eat till he comes here." Then, having no choice but to send a man into the wilderness, David, the hero of the ceremony, was brought in.

The Lord said to Samuel, **"Arise, anoint him; for this is the one."** Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed David in the midst of his brothers who despised him according to the Lord's word, **"I have found My servant David; With My holy oil I have anointed him,"** (Psalm 89:20). That is why David glorified the Lord by singing, "You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil" Hallelujah! While David was anointed with oil, the Spirit of the Lord came upon him (Sam. 16:13).

David, who was introduced to the prophet Samuel by his family as a sheep herder, after receiving this anointing, was introduced to King Saul as "skillful in playing, a mighty man of valor, a man of war, prudent in speech, and a handsome person; and the Lord is with him" (1 Sam. 16:18). David who was tending the flock was brought to King Saul's palace. When David took his harp and played it, the

distressing spirit that was upon Saul departed from him (1 Sam. 16:23).

After receiving this anointing, David who was just 20-years old defeated the 10-foot-tall giant Goliath, who was the greatest threat for the Israelites, with a simple slingshot and brought a great victory to the Israelites. After all, he was made king of Israel at the age of 30. It was because of the anointing and the Spirit of the Lord that rested in him. David sings his experience as "The stone which the builders rejected has become the



chief cornerstone. This was the Lord's doing" (Psalms 118:22, 23)

Dear youngsters! Are you rejected by this world and your kith and kin?

Consecrate yourself today to receive this anointing. The Spirit of the Lord is ready to dwell in you and guide you. When this anointing oil of the Spirit is poured upon you, sin shall not have dominion over you because the Holy Spirit who convicts you of sin and of righteousness is with you. No sin approaches you. When the Spirit of truth comes into you, you will feel him guiding you into all truth.

This anointing of the spirit teaches you concerning all things and brings everything to your remembrance. You shall receive power when this Holy Spirit comes upon you. Infirmities disappear. This fullness of the Spirit will make you a witness to the world. No man can stand against you. You will receive blessings like never before in your life. Commit yourself to receiving this helper called the Holy Spirit today.



There are many in the Holy Bible whose names are not mentioned, but they were known by their actions, character, husband's name, place of birth, the place they were brought up, or the place they governed. Thus, we have seen an imaginary collection of conversations with many people over the past months. Even in this article, let's get to know about a person who was known by his title as 'The Centurion' who served as the commander of a century (hundred men) in the ancient Roman army.

Though there are mentions of many Centurions in the Bible, here we will be seeing an imaginary conversation with the Centurion mentioned in Matthew 8:5-13 and Luke 7:1-10.

Reporter: Greetings, my Lord!

The Centurion: Greetings!

Reporter: Please share a few words about yourself so our youth can get to know you better.

The Centurion: I served as an officer who commanded a hundred army men, a fulfiller of law and order and a responsible officer of the Roman government. I lived in Capernaum, the port city of Rome. Many people like Romans, Greeks and Jews lived here. I loved the Jewish people, built a synagogue for them, and lived among my people with name and fame.



Letesenbet Gidey

So far, we have studied many older and more experienced athletes and their achievements. However, this time, we are going to take a look at a 23-year-old Ethiopian athlete named Letesenbet Gidey. She has broken the world records for both the 5,000 and 10,000 metres in women's track. After her success, Gidey's only desire was to excel in the half marathon (20 km). She trained really hard, and in the month of October 2021, in Valencia, Spain, she completed the half marathon in just 62 minutes, setting a new world record (the previous record was 63 minutes). Gidey is now leading the list of female long-distance runners. Many sports enthusiasts are hopeful that Gidey, at only 23 years of age, will continue to break records.

Reading about Letesenbet Gidey reminds us of David, who was introduced as a young man in the Scriptures. After being taunted by Goliath for 40 days, the Israelite army turned its back to retreat (including King Saul), but amidst them rose up a young David, who opposed Goliath with courage. "As the Philistine moved closer to attack him, David ran quickly towards the



battle line to meet him.” (1 Samuel 17:48). When everyone else was ready to pull back, why did David alone run towards the Palestinian?

DAVID'S PERSPECTIVE

Though David was a young man who hadn't set foot on a battle field before, he wasn't afraid to fight Goliath. The reason is the manner in which David perceived Goliath. The Israelite army saw him as a giant, whereas David saw Goliath as the beast he had killed earlier.

The Israelites became weary, seeing the challenges and circumstances. But David, in the midst of everything, saw only the Lord. That is why he declared, “I come against you in the name of the Lord of hosts, whom you defied” (1 Sam 17:45). The reason we are not progressing in our spiritual life or ministry is because our eyes are set on the things of the past, the world, and circumstances. When we turn our eyes towards God and everything that is pleasing to Him, the speed of our spiritual race intensifies and will end in victory. “I lift up my eyes to the hills; where does my help come from?” (Psalm 121:1)

DAVID'S FAITH IN GOD

In 1 Samuel 17:48, we read that David did not confront just Goliath but ran towards the entire Philistine army. Just imagine a young lad with no experience in battle going up against an entire nation's army singlehandedly; he must have had

unfathomable faith in his God. How did he acquire such faith? The answer was the fellowship he had with the Lord and his prayers. When we put our faith and trust in the Lord, we can overcome every challenge in our lives that rises like Goliath. “Because of you, I can run through an army; because of my God, I can leap over walls” (Psalm 18:29).

DAVID'S ZEAL FOR GOD

Another reason for David's victory over Goliath was his zeal for God. Goliath did not rebuke just the Israelites but also their God. David could not tolerate this. ‘How can an uncircumcised Philistine rebuke my God?’ David thought, and hence he fought against Goliath. Even today, the devil has bound our nation's people as slaves to sin and curse, which we witness through the news. But do we pray with zeal? Or act upon it? Think about it! When we praise God with zeal and take one step, the Lord will take multiple steps for us. “I pursued my enemies and overtook them; I did not turn back till they were destroyed” (Psalms 18:37)

Dear young brothers and sisters! The great revival of the world, which the heavens eagerly await, is coming soon. To be instrumental in the revival, we need to set our eyes upon the Lord, confirm our faith, and arise for God; only then can we do great things for our God and procure more souls for his kingdom ■

13.13 lakh girls, women went missing between 2019 and 2021: Govt data

More than 13.13 lakh girls and women went missing in the country in the three years between 2019 and 2021, with Madhya Pradesh accounting for the highest at nearly two lakhs, closely followed by West Bengal. According to the Union Home Ministry data, tabled in Parliament last week, 10,61,648 women above 18 years and 2,51,430 girls below that age went missing between 2019 and 2021 across the country. The data was compiled by the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB).

In Madhya Pradesh, 1,60,180 women and 38,234 girls went missing between 2019 and 2021, according to the data provided to Parliament. A total of 1,56,905 women and 36,606 girls went missing from West Bengal in the same period. In Maharashtra, 1,78,400 women and 13,033 girls went missing in the said period. In Odisha, 70,222 women and 16,649 girls went missing in the three years while 49,116 women and 10,817 girls went missing from Chhattisgarh in the said period.

Among the Union Territories, Delhi recorded the highest number of missing girls and women.

In the national capital, 61,054 women and 22,919 girls went missing between 2019 and 2021 while in Jammu and Kashmir, 8,617 women and 1,148 girls went missing in the said period.

The government also informed Parliament that it has taken a number of initiatives for the safety of women across the country, which include the enactment of The Criminal Law (Amendment), Act, 2013, for effective deterrence against sexual offences.

Govt ratifies 8.15% interest rate on Employees Provident Fund for 2022-23



The Employees Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) on Monday announced an interest rate of 8.15% for Employees' Provident Fund (EPF) accounts for the financial year 2022-23. The announcement was made in a circular issued by the EPFO on July 24, 2023. The circular stated that the interest rate was approved by the Central Government under para 60(1) of the Employees' Provident Fund Scheme, 1952.

Retirement fund body EPFO on March 28, 2023, had marginally raised the interest rate on EPF deposits to 8.15% for 2022-23 for its over six crore subscribers. As per an official order issued on Monday, the EPFO has asked the field offices for crediting the interest at 8.15% on EPF for 2022-23 into the accounts of members. The order came after the finance ministry's concurrence to the EPF rate of interest approved by EPFO trustees earlier in March this year.

In March 2022, the EPFO had reduced the interest rate on EPF deposits for 2021-22 to a four-decade low of 8.10% from 8.5 per cent in 2020-21. This was the lowest since 1977-78, when the EPF interest rate stood at 8%.
