GOAL

Hello Youth! This month, Sis. Ashwini will be sharing with us how God broke, rebuilt, and called her to serve Him. Come, let's listen to her.

Tell us about your early years and family.

I was born in the district of Dharmapuri, Tamil Nadu, into a Christian family and was brought up in Karnataka, where I did my schooling. Mr. Madhu and Mrs. Sumathi are my parents, and my older brother Ashokan is currently employed.

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Fantastic, lovely family! Tell us about your academic background!

Benita

Before the tenth grade, I wasn't very interested in my education. Nor did I have any ambition. My passion for learning truly took off when I was in the eleventh grade, and I began to study with a goal. My goal was to pursue a 6-year PharmD programme.

Well, have you pursued and achieved your dream PharmD course?

Let me tell you.... God called me to do His ministry when I was in the I2th grade. But I refused it. Since my desire was to do a doctorate in PharmD, I had no interest in getting into ministry. Not even my parents were in favour of it. I put a lot of effort into my studies, took the exams, and awaited the results. I was waiting with the expectation that 'I would score well and fulfil my dream.'

Did the result fulfil your expectations? Did you study your desired course?

On the day of my result, about 5 a.m. in the morning, I heard a voice ask three times, "What will you do if you fail this exam?" I was caught up in fear as soon as I heard the voice. However, I didn't pay any th Life | December 202



attention to it. Instead, I prayed and declared the scripture, "The horse is prepared for the day of battle, and the victory comes from the Lord."

I felt pretty convinced that I would get good grades because I had written my exams by putting in a lot of hard work. In the evening, when the results came. I failed in mathematics. That was a disappointment that I couldn't bear. I spent much of my time doing math because problems loved studying mathematics. My parents urged me to try writing it again, but I failed the second time around.

Whoops. What was your mindset when you faced failure?

Having experienced consecutive failures, I concluded that there is no God. I was depressed because, despite my best efforts, I was unable to succeed. My pals began making fun of me, saying things like, "You always claim Jesus will give you whatever you ask for?" Now, where is your Jesus?" The more I heard

it, the more I hated God. I began living my own way after coming to the conclusion that there was no God. I became heavily involved in social media. That took up all of my time. I became quite involved on social media and strayed from God for over eight months.

Alright... When did you get back to God again?

I used to pray at three in the morning. But I stopped praying all these 8 months. Eight months later, one fine morning, when I was idly thumbing through my phone, I heard a voice saying, "Rise up, kneel down, and pray!" Even before I knelt down, I saw the beautiful face of lesus standing before me. He looked at me and asked with great longing, "I endured everything for you; are you rejecting me because of your studies?" I immediately acknowledged my errors and shed tears of commitment upon hearing that. Jesus began to speak with me. "You knew me in your youth. But there are many youth like you who are chained to slavery and sin. Who will tell them the good news?" I completely gave my life to carry out God's ministry as soon as He requested.

What happened in your life after committing yourself to do ministry?

After I dedicated myself to the ministry, the Lord reminded me of the verse, "Who shall



separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 8:35, 38, 39).

I gave myself over right away and prayed, "Lord, even if I fail or die, I will not leave you." I retook the same math exam two months later and again failed. I asked the Lord, "Jesus, why is this failure for me again? Haven't I committed myself completely to you?" The Lord questioned me right away, saying, 'What was your commitment? Didn't you promise that even if you fail or die, you will not leave me? 'I didn't ask the Lord any more questions after that. In the next 3 months, I developed a fatal illness and was on my deathbed. The doctors could not figure out what the disease was. I was under treatment for 6 months.

At last, the doctors told my parents, "Her brain is affected by TB; only one in a million will get this disease, and we cannot save her in this terminal stage," and they gave me 48 hours to live. At that time, while I was in the ICU, my parents prayed and surrendered, 'Lord, take her wherever you want, but just keep her alive'. My parents had previously forbidden me from taking the ministry due to worries about safety. The Lord heard their prayer, healed me perfectly, and gave me a new life. I haven't taken any medication for that illness since then.

Glory be to God! After God granted you a fresh start, what did you do for him?

I prayed... God led me to study at a Bible college. As I was studying there, I was called to do full-time ministry, and now I'm serving the Lord full-time.

What would you like to say to the youth?

The scripture says, "Remember your creator in your youth." As youth, we encounter failures, illnesses, and humiliations as we travel with Jesus as our friend. Ask the Lord for the grace to do it without turning back. The Spirit of God will guide you.

Dear young people! Being called by the Lord to carry out His noble mission, Sister Ashwini, who had been rushing for worldly goals, has committed to run towards the supreme goal He has for her. "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. That is why God will break and build some people before using them. Are you ignoring the call of Jesus today? Are you struggling to do things according to your own will? Repent, listen to the voice of Jesus, and yield yourself to His will!

• Continue studying with faith and prayer in the same Christian hostel where you are staying.


• When fatigue arises, try to find motivation by listening to the inspiring testimonies of people who have conquered similar challenges.

Tejaswin Shankar was born in Delhi. From a young age, he had a great interest in cricket, so he gave it a lot of attention. But Tejaswin's school physical education teacher found that Tejaswin had another talent and advised him to focus more on high jump than cricket, which motivated him to work towards it.

Tejaswin's life was transformed by the inspiration he received from his physical education teacher at school. It strengthened his will to excel in the high-jumping sport. At the age of 14, his father died of blood cancer. He was deeply impacted by his father's loss. While his father was on his deathbed, Tejaswin assured his father that he would become a great athlete. He put a lot of effort into earning what he had promised.

In 2013, Tejaswin won a bronze medal in Delhi's Athletic Championship. His journey towards achievement began when he transformed every moment into a priceless one. In 2015, he won a gold medal in the Common Wealth Youth Games held in Apia. In 2016, he won a silver medal in the South Asian Games conducted in Kawasaki. In the 2018 Commonwealth Games at Gold Coast, he won 6th place and became the talk of the town. He is becoming known as a young achiever these days.

Dear young readers who are reading this! Tejaswin was not an achiever by birth. His ambition and tenacity helped him become a successful high jumper. No one is born as an achiever. However, if you have a strong drive to succeed as you grow older, you will eventually become a person the whole world will turn to. Do not get discouraged after one or two failures. Samson means equal to the sun, firm, or strong. He was among the most well-known characters in the Old Testament. He belonged to the Dan dynasty and was the son of Manoah of Zorah. Samson's birth was miraculously announced to his parents.

(Judges: 13)

◀ He caught 300 foxes, turned them tail to tail, put a torch between each pair of tails, and set fire to the Philistines' standing grain, vineyards, and olive trees.

• He killed 1,000 people with the fresh jaw bone of a donkey.

• He tore a young lion with his bare hands like a lamb.

• Samson is the first man in the Bible to kill a lion.

• He was dedicated to God from birth as a Nazarene.

• His physical strength was beyond measure. He used it for God and for his own glory.

• According to the announcement of the angel who visited his parents before his birth, Samson fulfilled God's purpose.

He delivered Israel from the hand of the Philistines.

• He was the greatest of those who freed the Israelites from the oppression of the Philistines.

 He judged Israel for 20 years during the Philistine era.

• Samson broke God's law and commandment many times.

 He faced many problems because of his relationship with the uncircumcised Philistines.

He used his talents unwisely.

• He entered the vineyard, aware that he had to avoid the grapes.

He went to a harlot and defiled himself.

• Despite being forbidden to go near a dead body, he took honey from the carcass of a lion's body with his hands, ate it, and gave some to his parents.

• Since he loved a foreign woman named Delilah and revealed to her the secret of his strength, his hair was cut off, and his strength left him.

• He forgot the purpose for which he was called and became a lover of pleasure and a transgressor of God's command.

He disregarded his parents' advice.



He (Cornelius) was a devout man and one who feared God with his entire household, who gave alms generously to the people, and prayed to God always (Acts 10:2). Cornelius was a centurion who did not know the true God but understood that there was a God. He knew that he should trust in God and have the fear of God in his life. He feared God and gave alms to the poor and needy. One day, he clearly saw in a vision an angel of God coming to him and saying to him, "Cornelius! Your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before God". When we help others, these actions reach the throne of heaven before God. So we should always make it a point to give alms to the poor and help and provide for those in need.

Why Should We Do Good?

IT IS GOD'S COMMANDMENT

"There will never cease to be poor in the land. Therefore I command you; you shall open your hand to your brother, to the needy and to the poor, in your land" (Deut 15-11). The Lord commands that you should help the poor and open your hands to offer freely to your brethren. Proverbs 17:5 says, "Whoever mocks the poor shows contempt for their Maker; whoever gloats over disaster will not go unpunished." Do not disrespect the poor, because God is merciful and compassionate towards the poor and needy, and He has given it as a commandment.

IT IMPLIES LENDING TO GOD

Whoever is generous to the poor lends to the Lord, and He will repay him for his deed (Prov 19–17). A man can lend to another man. But the Lord has given us an opportunity to lend to the Maker of the heavens and earth. When we lend to the poor, it is similar to lending to God. Many think that offering money and



tithes to the church or various ministries is lending to God. It is not so. When we lend to the poor, help a widow, help a fatherless child, or help those who are suffering, it is similar to lending to God. God will repay whatever you lend to those who are poor.

WHOM SHOULD WE HELP?

Do not withhold good from those who deserve it, when it is in your power to act (Prov 3-27). The Bible does not say, 'give to everyone', but it says, 'give to all those in need'.

One day, a brother without both hands came to me. Anyone seeing him would sympathise with him. But I was unable to express sympathy for him. With tears in his eyes, he told me, "My

daughter is getting married. I am unable to take on any jobs. I have to provide food for who attend the those wedding. But I do not have money". But I was not inspired to help him. The Lord did not give me the desire to help him. So I said, "you will get the money on the day of the wedding; just give me your address and go home."

I gave the money to a brother working in our ministry and asked him to verify the man before giving the money to him. When they went to his village to check on him, the villagers said, "He had married his children many years ago. There is no wedding taking place in his family today". God knew that he was trying to swindle money, and that is why He closed my heart towards the man, and I did not get the urge to help him. Do not help those who try to deceive you, but help those who are truly in need, says the Lord Jesus Christ.

HELP THE FAMILIES OF BELIEVERS

So then, while we have the opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially those of the household of faith (Gal 6:10). Do not discriminate between caste and religion, but help all those who are in need. We should pay says the Bible. When families who have recently accepted Christ as their saviour are in need, we must always help them. If these families need support, help them. If such believers do not have anyone to help and we have the opportunity to help them, we become sinners if we do not help such people.

HELP THOSE WHO SERVE THE LORD

Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches (Galatians 6:6). If you are blessed by the teachings of a Bible teacher, do good to such servants of the Lord. • This attack claimed the lives of... Approximately 7,900 people who were hurt in Gaza during Israel's strike are suffering as a result of inadequate medical care.

• 11 medical personnel were murdered in a strike on Gaza's 34 health centers. 3.38 million people have been evacuated from Gaza. According to the U.N. food organisation, over fifty thousand pregnant women in Gaza do not have access to water.

• Israel's campaign against the terrorists has resulted in the deaths of almost 2500 of them.

Prayer Points!

1. Pray for the safety and peace of Israel and Jerusalem. Pray for the comfort of the family of the deceased and for the quick recovery of the injured.

2. Pray for the refugees in Gaza to have a safe place and good food.

3. Pray that terrorists around the world should repent and accept Jesus Christ.

4. Pray for the people of Israel to accept Jesus as their personal savior.

MURDERS

• According to an American Research Organization, India ranks eighth among countries with a high murder rate.

• India has dropped from second place the previous year. According to the National Crime Record Archive, approximately 82 murders and 11 kidnappings occur in India every day.

• According to the report, the Indian state of Jharkhand has a high murder rate, while Delhi has a high number of kidnapping incidents.

• The main reasons for the murders are antagonism, gain, and conflict.

Prayer Points!

1. Pray for the peace of the country and for murders to be avoided.

2. Approximately 82 people are slain every day. Pray for the abolition of bloodshed in the land.

3. Pray for the Lord to give them a heart to forgive and to live peacefully and happily by forgetting their animosity towards one another.

MANIPUR

• The communal clashes in Manipur between 2 communities has turned into violence. Two women were sexually assaulted and paraded naked.

• Many have taken refuge in the neighboring states as refugees.

• Though the violence has subsided a bit, there was a clash in September in Kanggui region between the people of 2 villages, and 3 people were shot dead.

• The people are living in constant fear due to this prolonged violence.

Prayer Points!

• Pray for the protection of the 50,000 people living in refugee camps after having lost their homes.

• Pray that the violence which is increasing each day in Manipur will come to an end.

• Pray for the two communities to live in harmony with each other and for peace to prevail.

• Pray for the protection of women and pregnant women. Sexual assault against women must come to an end.

• Pray that our government to take the needed steps to bring normalcy to the state.

PORN WEBSITES

• According to news reports, a large number of children in India start watching pornographic films at an early age.

• Children under the age of 13 are especially prone to this practise, and the number of people seeing pornographic websites is rising every day.

• A study has revealed that dopamine levels increase in people addicted to watching porn, and they experience volume loss in their brains.

• Watching porn videos also leads to stress and various mental disorders.

• An excessive amount of time spent watching pornographic videos can ruin friendships with people of the other gender and problems arise with getting physical contact.

• In the present-day people of all categories, including youngsters, children, men, women, married, unmarried, saved, unsaved, preachers, believers, people in power, etc., are trapped in this sin.

The end of King David

Dear youngsters! Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ! This month, let us conclude this series by reflecting on how the end of King David was. 2 Samuel 5:10 and 1 Chronicles 11:9 mention that David became more and more powerful because the Lord Almighty was with him. In another translation, it says that he prospered and grew.

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POTENTIAL

Looking deeper into the truths from these verses in 2 Samuel 5:10 and 1 Chronicles 11:9, we see the secret or reason as to how the shepherd boy David, who was taking care of the sheep in the wilderness, became king over all of Israel and then continued to flourish because the Lord God Almighty was with him. David became more and more prosperous and powerful because the Lord God Almighty, who created heaven and earth, was with him.

He thus sings in Psalm 16:8, "I have set the Lord always before me; because He is at my right hand, I shall not be moved." David had the experience of having the Lord before him and with him. Not only during times of war, not only when facing bears and lions, not only when his son Absalom or his adversaries were pursuing him... David always had the Lord before him. King David did not seek the Lord only when there was a need. He had the experience of always seeking the Lord.

Having the Lord before him, he vanquished all his adversaries and triumphed in all of his conflicts with the Canaanites, Hittites, Syrians, Philistines, and Moabites since the day he started his first war with the giant Goliath.

BLESSINGS

David's father, Jesse, was a farmer and sheep breeder in the little town of Bethlehem. David, who was grazing the few sheep they had as possessions in the wilderness, was blessed by the Lord Almighty. As per God's plan, the prophet Samuel anointed David as King of Israel. After he defeated Goliath, he received favour in the eyes of King Saul, and he was brought to Saul's palace. He received the responsibility of fighting the battles. David played the harp for Saul to relieve him from the evil spirit that troubled him. He became the son-in-law of Saul. He was anointed and crowned as the king of Judah. At the age of 37, he succeeded King Saul as the head of all of Israel.

The Lord blessed David and his household. Even when there was constant fighting and famine, the Lord was with King David and protected and blessed the nation of Israel. He was spared from his foes by the Lord. David wanted to build a temple for the Lord, so he gathered gold, silver, bronze, iron, trees, stones, and everything else needed and stocked them up. For David, the Lord built a magnificent home and a palace. It was called the city of David. 

In this series of 'The Track, we have been learning about marathon runners, their hard work, perseverance, and achievements, and we have meditated on those in the Bible who worked for God with zeal. In continuation of this series, God wants to talk to you about how to run for God in the upcoming revival.

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Yuki Kawauchi is Japanese, and he works as a manager at a school in Japan. At the same time, he participates in marathons. He participated in a marathon, which took place in Boston. On the day of the race, there was heavy rain with winds, and the temperature was also freezing. Also, elite marathon runners from Ethiopia and Kenya were preparing hard for the marathon. So, Kawauchi had less possibility of winning. But Kawauchi won the Boston Marathon by overcoming extreme weather conditions and other strong participants. Generally, runners run slowly to win a marathon. But Kawauchi ran fast from the beginning of the race. There was about 300 metres between him and the ones who followed in that marathon. The commentator who criticised and laughed at Yugi initially celebrated him after seeing his pace and run. Yuki Kawauchi did not feel down after seeing the unfortunate circumstances or strong players. Instead, he concentrated only on his goal and achieved it.

Reading about Yuki reminds me of Elisha in the Bible, who was running behind Elijah, craving the anointing, and receiving a double portion of it later. Let's see the challenges Elisha had to overcome to receive such an anointing.

I. THE PRICE ELISHA PAID

Elisha was introduced to Elijah in 1 Kings 19:19–21 and received the call to serve the Lord as a prophet. In that period, King Ahab and Jezebel were looking out to kill Elijah. At that time, Elijah commanded Elisha to follow him, leaving his family behind. While reading the scripture, it looked like Elisha could be from an elite family. He quit such a lavish lifestyle to obey the divine vision to accomplish a risky prophetic mission, and he followed Elijah. He was ready to give up his possessions and family to follow God.



2. HE ASKED FOR A REMARKABLE THING

In the period of Elijah, there were many prophets. But Elisha asked Elijah for a double portion of the anointing. None of the other prophets wished for such a thing. To receive something from God, we must thirst and yearn for it. Elisha thirsted and yearned for the anointing that was in Elijah. He was ready to do anything for it. And so, in 2 Kings Chapter 2, Elisha inherited the double portion of the Spirit. Hence, he did commendable God's work with great miracles and signs.

Dear youth! This is the end time, and the signs for Jesus's second coming are happening. Even after seeing these things and searching for small happiness in worldly things, we would not be prepared for that day. Make the best use of the time, because the days are evil. Rise and shine! God is ready to handle you.

Is this the time to take money or to accept clothes—or olive groves and vineyards, or flocks and herds, or male and female slaves? (2Kings 5:26) ■





The four lepers who announced the gospel!

It was at that time that the Syrian King Ben-Hadad had surrounded Samaria with his forces. And as a result of that, there was a severe famine in Samaria. People were suffering from severe hunger and starvation. The situation was so bad that mothers in the region began cooking and eating their children for survival. During such a time, four unnamed lepers, mentioned in the Bible, were near the outer gates of the city. Because of their daring act, the entire Samaria was delivered from hunger, and it has been mentioned in 2 Kings 7th Chapter. What if they met our reporter and had a chat with them? Let us take a look at the imaginary conversation.

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Reporter: Hello, dear brothers!

LEPERS: Hi!

Leper 1: We belong to Samaria, in the nation of Israel. We suffered a lot due to our leprosy, and as a result, we were unable to coexist in the city with our people. Instead, we were residing outside the city limits.

Leper 2: We were considered to be impure. The people were afraid that we would end up spreading the disease to our family and children if we lived among them. So they left us at a point where we were away from the people of the city.

Leper 3: Our friends and family usually leave the food they bring us far away. We gather the

food from the location after they depart.

Leper 4: Be it marriage or festivals, we were not allowed to participate in any of them. We weren't useful to society or family. In fact, we weren't even useful to ourselves.

Reporter: How did you manage during the famine?

Leper 2: Oh! The famine was dreadful. Usually, people finish their meals and bring us a share. But when they themselves had nothing to eat, we had to starve. A section of people who managed to get the food also made sure that they ate it in hiding.

Leper 1: Even the proud and rich ones lost everything. They cooked up their own kids

and didn't have the heart to share the excess food with their needy brother or wife.

Reporter: During this tough situation that includes physical exhaustion, depression, and starvation, how did you tactfully make the right decision to venture into the Syrian army camp?

Leper 1: We were wondering where to go in search of food. Since there was no food in the town, there was no use going there. If we had chosen to stay in our place, we would have



Reporter: What happened in the Syrian camp?

Leper 4: Since God exposed Syrian warriors to the sounds of horses, chariots, and the noises of a mighty army, they spoke among themselves, "The kings of the Hittites and the kings of the Egyptians, come upon us!" and fled from their tents the same evening, leaving their horses, donkeys, and all other belongings.

India is at the forefront of income inequality! UN reports!



The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) released the Asia-Pacific Human Development Report 2024 yesterday. While the report pointed to long-term progress, it also noted persistent rich-poor disparities. As far as India is concerned, between 2000 and 2022, per capita income increased from ₹ 36,244 to ₹1, 95,898. Also, between 2015-16 and 2019-21, the share of people living in poverty, based on those earning ₹177 per day as per the International Poverty Index, fell from 25 percent to 15 percent. Yet poverty continues to be concentrated in the states, home to 45 percent of the country's population. The report points out that 62 percent of the poor live there. Mainly since 2000, the rich-poor disparity has risen sharply across the world. In particular, in South Asian countries, including India, the richest 10 percent receive more than 50 percent of the country's total income, according to the report.
