

Hello, dear youngies! We are super excited to meet you all again in this new year. In the very first month of this year, we are so glad to present to you the inspiring testimony of the young pastor and worship leader, Bro. Ranjith Jeba. In this interview, Ps. Ranjith himself tells us about his experience of how, being born into a Roman Catholic family, he accepted Jesus when he was 9 because of his desire for music, got anointed at age 10, later received the calling to serve the Lord full time, and now, through beautiful songs, turns a lot of youngsters towards God.

Billy: Hello Anna... How are you doing?

Ranjith Jeba: I'm good by the grace of God.

Billy: I'm very glad to introduce you to our youth Trends subscribers.

Ranjith: Thanks! Likewise, I'm exceedingly glad to share my testimony with you all.

Billy: Okay, Anna... Everyone is eagerly waiting for your interview. Come, let's get started.

Ranjith: Sure, let's go.

Billy: Tell us about your family and childhood.

Ranjith: I was born into a traditional Roman Catholic family in Uthamapalayam in Theni District and was brought up religiously. My father is an electrician. My mother is a homemaker. I have an older sister. I studied at a school in Uthamapalayam until the 8th grade. Later, I studied at a school in Raayappanpatti village from 9th grade to 12th grade. My grandfather, father, and uncle are all zealous

Roman Catholic churchgoers. They harmonium in the church choir. My family was from a traditional Catholic background. My mother is from Kerala. She has been to a spiritual church and has received the salvation experience. There used to be a Sunday school near our house in childhood. We were taken for it and were made to take part in it. I was sent to attend the convention meetings and youth meetings that happened in our town with my father's permission. I began to have a strong interest when I saw the worship that was taking place over there. But my father was very strict, saying that we must only go to the Roman Catholic Church on Sundays.

Billy: Okay... Being born and brought up in a Catholic family, how did you get to know about Jesus?

Ranjith: My aunt used to go to a spiritual church when I was a child. I started to go to that church with my aunt after coming from the Catholic

Church. The pastor in that church would play the guitar and sing songs. I have had a great interest in the guitar since my childhood. I had no big interest in the worship that happened in the Catholic Church. I went there because of my father's compulsion. My mother used to send me to this church along with my aunt without my father's knowledge. There was a massive interest in me for guitar as time flew by. When I saw the musical instruments that were there, I had a desire to play them anyway. But, in those days, I was in a state where there was no way to buy it and learn.

Billy: Okay... You had an interest in music when you began going to that church with your aunt. But have you learned it?

Ranjith: I, my aunt, and my mother used to attend fasting prayers. Because of this, great conflict occurs at our home. I and my sister used to watch the conflict between my parents with much fear. Sometimes, I used to get beaten up by my father. Even though I got beaten up, I would still go to church with my aunt the next week. I would go every week like this because of the interest I had in the guitar. The scriptures that were taught in the Sunday school were carved deeply in my heart. All these were significant reasons for my spiritual life's growth. Becoming a pastor has been my desire since childhood. When someone asks, "What is your ambition after studying?" I would reply, I'm going to become a pastor. I would go to church with many problems and struggles until the 9th grade. My interest in music grew alongside it. My father left me silently on my own when he got to know that I wouldn't come to their

traditions, even after many beatings and scoldings. Later, I started going to church continuously.

Billy: Okay... How did you identify the interest that you had in music?

Ranjith: When I was in 4th grade, the pastor left his guitar once. I kept my hand on it, having a desire to touch it, and there came a beautiful sound from it. My pastor, on seeing this, asked, "Do you like to learn guitar?" With that, he taught me three keys. After that, I myself had drawn a diagram on a sheet of paper, took that to him, and learned guitar from him. I had no means to buy a guitar. A few days later, my pastor gave me his guitar and asked me to play what I knew. God gave me wisdom when I

b e g a n to play. I had a desire to buy a guitar and play it at home. Since I had no means, I would take a piece of cardboard and make it like a guitar, using my sister's rubber band as the string. I used to play it. These were my childhood amusements.

Billy: Okay... We can understand your interest in music. How was your relationship with God?

Ranjith: I had been to an all-night prayer with my aunt when I was in the 5th grade. During that time, they called people who wanted to receive anointing to the front. When I went and stood in front, I realised that my language had begun to change. I felt a brightness coming inside me when the pastor laid his hand on my head. I received the anointing.





I have had a severe cold infection since childhood. They used to take me to the hospital every day and night. After receiving the anointing, that sickness got rid of me absolutely. When I went to the Carol Rounds with my pastor, I would carry a guitar that was bigger than me. When we went to the village ministry, I would carry the instruments, like the guitar and speaker box. When I was in 11th grade, God gave me the grace to play the keyboard. I didn't go and learn from anybody. I learned both guitar and keyboard by myself because of my interest. I wanted to do something for Jesus at a young age. Also, because of the interest that I had in music, nothing mattered to me. I got good marks in 12th grade. My music journey was also successfully happening.

Billy: Amazing... Did you study further after 12th grade? Or did you pursue a musical journey?

Ranjith: I had joined BCA at a college in Trichy and did MCA there as well after 12th grade. I studied for 6 years. I got many opportunities to play music in many places when I was studying in Trichy. I utilised all those opportunities while studying. God gave me the grace to sing and play music in many places when I was doing MCA. I had many friends in college who knew music. They taught me many things. I used to sing and worship in any place in those days, wherever I got an opportunity. I didn't think that I could only worship on stage. I very much love to worship the Lord. Even though I had studies on one side, it was only next to the Kingdom of God. I finished my six years of education perfectly, tried for a job, and got a job at a company in Chennai. I worked well there for 5 years for a good salary. God gave me the grace to lead worship in many places on Saturdays and Sundays.

Billy: Alright, how did the calling of ministry come to you when you had a job with a good salary? When did you come to full-time ministry?

Ranjith: My marriage took place on January 22, 2018. My wife's name is Salomi. She is a spiritual Christian. We lived in Chennai after our marriage. I have a daughter. I continued doing my job for 6 months after marriage. God called me to full-time ministry after 6 months. When I told my family about God's calling, they weren't able to accept it because I had been married only for 6 months. Also, since I had so many debts, I prayed to God, saying, "I won't come to ministry, God. Give me a job with a higher salary than this." I began trusting the salary rather than God. I was stubborn about not coming to the





ministry because of my family situation. On one side was my family, and on the other side was God's calling. I began to deviate from God. My mother was a good praying believer, but she refused to send me to full-time ministry because of the struggles in the family. Eventually, I joined another job at a different company. There, I suffered many problems. That's when I surrendered myself to God's will for full-time ministry after praying and resigned my job. Since that year, I've been doing full-time ministry for the Lord. Terrible problems arose in the family. I wasn't able to send money properly home each month, as it was the beginning of ministry.

Billy: Alas..! You came to ministry... Were you able to do the ministry well?

Ranjith: No... Many ministers of God arose against me. My mother, who led me into God, arose against me. Back then as well, I told God and prayed, saying, "God leave me. Many pastors are there. Do things with them. I return to the same job. Give me a job where I can earn a good salary." During that time, God spoke about His heart's agony: "Youngsters in the nation are perishing. The nation is perishing." God comforted me by giving me His words through songs. God gave me many songs. I had written everything. God led me by giving me the song "Nambathakkavar Neer Oruvar Thane" (You alone are trustworthy) when I was weary in ministry. In 2017, God gave me the grace to publish my first C.D., "Nissi." God began to exalt gradually in ministry. Opportunities came from many places. God opened favourable doors for me to worship God and preach God's words, along with the ones whom I had watched from a distance. Now, He is taking me to many nations. Multitudes of problems and afflictions came when I surrendered to the plan of God. Today, God has kept me blessed and cleared all my debts. I couldn't have cleared them and been blessed if I had gone to work, leaving God's calling. All things are possible with our God.

Billy: That's marvelous! What would you like to say to the youngsters?

Ranjith: God, who called, is faithful. In the dream that Joseph saw, all the sheaves bowed down, and his sheaf stood upright. If God gives us a vision, He will definitely accomplish it. He will not put us to shame. God is able to lift and exalt anyone. If you are able to learn to lift and glorify God in His presence in any situation, then you need not go seeking exaltations and blessings. God himself will bring everything to us. If you begin to live depending on God, He is faithful to lift you up and exalt you in any situation.

Billy: Amen! Anna, truly, it is astounding when looking at how God led you. Thanks for encouraging our youngsters with your testimony and for making time for us amidst your busy ministry schedule. We pray that the Lord will continue to bless you, your family, and your ministry ■










YOU FROM EVIL

Look at the world today! On one hand, natural hazards such as storms, floods, snow, fire, famine, and rough seas! On the other hand, the effects of strange pathogens and pestilences are troubling people! It is a situation where people's livelihoods are affected. We see that many such situations make people feel afraid and confused.

Perhaps you too are passing through such a situation these days! But the Lord, the God who cares for you, looks at you and says, my son, 'Do not be afraid! Don't worry! He promises you to protect in any situation. Although there are many situations where people do many things against us and cause evil, the Lord promises to protect you today. If he makes a promise, he will fulfil it!

Let us meditate on the ways in which the Lord protects us in our daily lives.

He preserves your soul!

"He (the Lord) will preserve your soul." (Psalm 121:7) This is the first thing that the Lord does for us! It is true that many dangers come into our lives, such as illnesses, losses, famines, and pestilences. But there is a soul within us.



It is the soul communicating with God that creates the peace and comfort He gives us. Only if there is divine peace and happiness in that soul is true blessing. But the wicked devil will taint it and try to separate us from the Lord.

When a man lives in sin, his soul dies! As the word of the Lord says, "The soul who sins shall die" (Ezekiel 18:4), any man who gives place to sin, the soul that is in him shall die. That is, the body remains alive, but as his soul dies because of sin, his relationship with God is severed. That is why people sometimes say, "There is no peace in the mind! There is no harmony! It's scary to live!" they lament. Only when a man's soul is alive, can he be united with the Lord and feel the joy and peace of the forgiveness of sins. But the evil devil will continue to target our souls, bring sin, and fight to separate us from the Lord.

Therefore, it is very important for our souls to be protected.

When I was in my youth, in the days when the Lord began to call and use me for ministry, after I finished preaching in many churches and some gospel meetings, some people would come and appreciate me. But some say, "Brother, the Lord is using you well in your youth! But it is important to endure till the end."

It was an attack by Satan! Back then, I was ignorant of it. It has been a great struggle in my spiritual life! I was so confused that I couldn't even tell anyone about this. At that time, one day, when I was returning home after finishing my ministry in a certain town, an old father put his right hand on my shoulder and said, "The Lord who

protected Joseph that day will protect you who are ministering to him in these young days" and kept going. And that's it! That word gave me faith and courage.

The devil brought a temptation into Joseph's lodgings to drive him into sin. But the Lord protected him. Up until that point, I believed that the Lord was with Joseph since he fled from that sin and kept himself holy. However, after hearing the words of that old father, when I read the Holy Bible, the Lord revealed a truth to me. That is, son, "I was not with Joseph because he ran away from sin; since I was with him he ran away from falling into that

sin. I will protect you as I protected Joseph." He revived me. This year marks 45 years in my ministry! I believe that the Lord, who protected me from all the trials, struggles, and the devil's tricks to make me fall, will

protect me until the end. For the Lord is my soul's protector.

My beloved teenage son and daughter! Your job is to submit yourself to His hand! His job is to protect you!

He will preserve your going out and coming in!

"The Lord shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore" (Psalm 121:8). The Lord promises us, "I will preserve not only your soul, but your going out and coming in." These days, we learn about several risks and mishaps that occur when we travel by trains, bus, van, cars, bike, bicycle, and aeroplane on a daily basis. We therefore require protection while travelling. In the early days of my ministry, one day I was driving from Nalumavadi to Tirunelveli for ministry.

As the driver drove the car, I sat bent over in the back seat, reading the letters and prayer requests that people had sent me to pray, and I kept praying. As I was bending over for too long, my back started to hurt. When I raised my head a little, the car that was supposed to be on the left side of the

road was going on the right side out of control. A bus was speeding in the opposite direction. I was startled to notice the driver sleeping right away! How would it have been? Think about that. In the blink of an eye, I woke him up. The driver immediately

woke up and swerved the car to the left. Look; in an instant, we were protected. Otherwise, my run would have been over that day.

My dear children, the men we trust to lead us safely may sleep. But the Holy Bible says, "The one who guards Israel (God's children) neither sleeps nor slumbers" (Psalm 121:4). It is the Lord who protects our going out and coming in.

"The Lord shall preserve you from all evil" (Psalm 121:4).





Pray that God will protect our country from any kind of destruction in this New Year.


Yearly Report 2023

AIR POLLUTION CAUSES OVER 2 MILLION DEATHS ANNUALLY IN INDIA: BMJ STUDY



The research found that air pollution from using fossil fuels in industry, power generation, and transportation accounts for 5.1 million extra deaths a year worldwide. This equates to 61% of a total estimated 8.3 million deaths worldwide due to ambient (outdoor) air pollution from all sources in 2019, which could potentially be avoided by replacing fossil fuels with clean, renewable energy, the researchers said. These new estimates of fossil fuel-related deaths are larger than most previously reported values suggesting that phasing out fossil fuels might have a greater impact on attributable mortality than previously thought, they said. The team, including researchers from Max Planck Institute for Chemistry, Germany, used a new model to estimate all cause and cause-specific deaths due to fossil fuel-related air pollution and to assess potential health benefits from policies that replace fossil fuels with clean, renewable energy sources. They assessed excess deaths - the number of deaths above that expected during a given time period - using data from the Global Burden of Disease 2019 study, NASA satellite-based fine particulate matter and population data, and atmospheric chemistry, aerosol, and relative modelling for 2019, in four scenarios.

OVERWEIGHT AND OBESITY AMONG CHILDREN, TEENAGERS AND YOUNG ADULTS! DOCTORS ALERT!

Chennai, 14th November 2023: In commemoration of World Diabetes Day 2023 on November 14th, M.V. Diabetes and Prof. M Viswanathan Diabetes Research Centre today hosted a grand "Health Conclave: For a Healthy Mind and Body" event aimed at fostering awareness about general well-being and the prevention of diabetes and its associated complications among the public. As part of the event, the renowned institutions proudly introduce "Chennai Slim & Fit 2.0." This initiative aligns with their ongoing commitment to primary diabetes prevention, particularly focusing on combating the escalating obesity epidemic among children and adolescents in Chennai.

Dr. Vijay Viswanathan, Head & Chief Diabetologist at M.V. Diabetes said in his speech, "People should lead an active life when they are still young. At least 45 minutes of exercise, such as swimming, jogging or walking is important. Practicing yoga and meditation can greatly reduce stress, which has emerged as a significant risk factor. It is better that the at-risk population can get used to diabetic food, which is less in carbohydrates and fat. With a balanced diet, regular exercise, lab investigations once in three months, and consultations from a qualified doctor, diabetes can be managed at any stage. Intermittent fasting is a good option to consider in a predominantly carbohydrate-consuming population of India. The obese and the pre-diabetics are particularly the most beneficiary group. Those on insulin should discuss with their physicians before resorting to intermittent fasting".

In light of the escalating burden of overweight and obesity among not only children but also teenagers and young adults in the post-COVID era, characterized by increased screen time and altered routines, M.V. Diabetes and Prof. M Viswanathan Diabetes Research Centre have tailored their focus. Building on their past success, the institutions are gearing up to target teenagers and young adults to instill and promote healthy habits for a wholesome life.
