Though Bro. Joel was born into a Christian family and had a good relationship with God from a young age, as he grew up, the connection with God severed, and he lived a life with no connection to God. Shall we ask and learn from him how God drew him closer to Himself?

Can you tell us about your childhood and family?

I was born in Coimbatore to parents who are prayerful and zealous in their faith. I completed my schooling there, and at present I am doing my 3rd year of B.Sc. My dad is working in the government office, and my mom is working as a teacher. My grandparents, from a very young age, encouraged me to take part in all church-related activities, made me attend Sunday school, and Vacation Bible School, and made me memorise Bible verses. I grew up with the habit of seeking God.

It's good to know that you grew up seeking God from a young age. How was your life when you were a teenager?

I used to go to church and get involved in worldly activities like watching movies until I was in the 8th grade. I was not aware that we should seek God with a whole heart. I used to read the Bible, go to church, and pray every day. On the other hand, I used to watch movies every day without realising that it was a sin. Along with my friends, I began indulging in various sinful worldly activities in the 9th grade.

As the days went by, I had the thought, "Why do I have to go to church?" It's not necessary...!"
My prayer life also began to decline. When I began to spend less time in prayer, my worldly life began to flourish. I began giving first priority to watching movies. I began seeking God less. As the days went by, I began reading one Bible verse

or just glancing at Psalm 23 or Psalm 91 before going to school. I lived a life that had no connection to Jesus. He was just a God from my point of view. I did not invite him into my life.



Your life took a drastic turn. Ok, did you accept Jesus after that? Or did you continue to lead a sinful life?

I continued living a sinful life. In 10th grade, I started indulging in a lot of sinful activities (lust, watching movies, mocking Jesus, roaming around with wicked friends). My aim was to enjoy life. As I began to backslide, I started scoring less in my studies. As I began wasting my time with unwanted friends, I had to face a big blow in 10th grade. I was a bright student, but I could get only 73%.

I did not expect to get such low marks, but by God's grace, I had cleared the exam. I was told that I could not get my desired group for

my further studies. As I entered the 11th grade, I began sinning even more. I could not live without my phone. I began spending a lot of time on social media.

post a lot of things on Facebook, Instagram, Whatsapp, and TikTok. I used to go to church regularly, but I had no relationship with God.

Pathetic.... How did you accept Jesus when you were addicted to

social media? We had lockdown in the year 2020

when I was preparing for my

I I th exam. I used to spend time on my mobile and laptop, as we could not leave our houses. I used to spend the entire night watching things on my mobile. My parents would watch and also ask me to watch the 'Come, Let Us Pray' programme that is being telecasted on Sathyam TV. Without choice, I used to leave my mobile and laptop for charging and watch the programme with them. My parents and grandparents would pray for me with great burden during prayer time. That was when I realised it and started thinking about the condition that I was in. In one "Come, let us pray' programme in April, Mohan Uncle spoke about the importance of prayer. He spoke about 'How should a Christian pray?' The words

touched my heart and made me

think. From that moment on. I had the small urge and desire to pray. "Jesus, help me get up early in the morning. I desire to pray,

but I do not have the habit of getting

up early and praying," was the small prayer that I made before sleeping. Jesus woke me up exactly at five in the morning. I prayed fervently for 25 minutes. I was a person who



wouldn't spend 5 minutes in prayer, but He made me pray for 25 minutes. That was the day I was saved. 2020 was the year when God graciously came in search of me, touched me, saved me, and showered His love on me. When we focus on the victory that lies beyond the struggle, the challenges we face become worthless. Here, we would like to present to you the epic success journey of the brothers who journeyed towards success.



Both the brothers, G.B. Sundarrajan and Soundarrajan, were not well educated. they had only completed their schooling. But they had their lands and started cultivating vegetables on them. But they couldn't see any profit out of it. Since there was no profit, the debts started to pile up. So, they started working for a company. But their ultimate wish was to start a business of their own. So, with a humble investment of 5000 rupees, the brothers started a small poultry farm called 'Suguna Foods' in 1984.

This wasn't easy, either. So they started thinking about raising chickens on a contract basis. In 1990, Suguna adopted the "Contract Farming Model" which went on to revolutionise the Indian poultry industry. No one was able to understand the idea behind their business and made fun of them. They didn't pay much attention to this. However, they used the jest as motivation and came up with an idea called 'Integrated Chicken Farming'.

Here, they offered all the necessary things to rear chickens, like vaccination, food,

medicines, and equipment, through the 'Suguna group'. This way, 'Suguna Industries' created a benchmark for poultry farming. To everybody's surprise, it earned an income of 7 crores in just a few years.

Looking at this, they decided to expand the brand and start exporting to other countries. Today, more than 8,000 employees are working in four African and Pacific Asian countries. And more than 40,000 farmers attribute their stable livelihoods to Suguna Foods. They also own 80+ hatching centres and 60+ fodder mills, and they research advanced vaccinations and premixes. What started with a 5,000-rupee investment has grown to be an industry that has a turnover of crores.

Dear future achievers reading this! Suguna Foods may appear to have prospered in the short term. However, there had been a lot of struggle every step of the way to establish themselves. Our lives are not going to be challenging throughout, but whenever you face one, be courageous and ready to deal with it. Success is yours!

So is the use of this mobile phone. Though it is useful for us, using it excessively puts us at risk.

When Facebook was launched, many signed up with the intention of making a big circle of friends. Over the course of days, people ended up sharing their personal information with unknown people and were trapped.

Some people these days say they use Facebook to keep up with current events, but they don't realise how much time they really spend on it.

The same thing happens with YouTube as well. A few years ago, many youngsters tried to exhibit their talents and reach great heights through an app called Tik Tok. Sadly, there are more people who are depressed than successful since they didn't receive the number of views and likes they had hoped for. Many young people who used internet gaming

as a kind of leisure have lost a great deal of money in addition to their time.

Okay, do you think using a phone is the reason for all these problems? Not that! Using too much of it is the problem. Since we are so engrossed in it, unaware of the time, we fall into Satan's trap. This feature called Digital Well-Being serves as a great solution for this problem. Through this, you can set a time period for how long the mobile should be used. Likewise, with the SCREEN TIME GOAL, all you have to do is specify how long you want to spend on your phone; if you use it for longer than that, an alert will sound.



for distractions to take over. This kind of distraction can never give you victory. Friendship is a good thing. But that friendship should help you reach your goal; instead, if that becomes a distraction, you should have a second thought about whether to keep the relationship going.



hen Jesus arrived at a town called Jericho, he came across a man named Zacchaeus, the chief tax collector, who lived in considerable wealth but without inner peace or a sense of fulfilment. Upon hearing that Jesus was passing through, Zacchaeus, though physically short, eagerly wanted to catch a glimpse of him amidst the crowds that surrounded Jesus. Due to his height, he couldn't see over the crowd, prompting him to run ahead and climb a sycamore-fig tree to get a better vantage point. Sensing Zacchaeus's anticipation, Jesus looked up and told him, "Come down quickly; I must stay at your house today." Overwhelmed with disbelief, Zacchaeus descended from the tree with great joy and welcomed Jesus into his home.

The residents of that town scorned him, declaring, "He is a man of wrongdoing; he acquires wealth unfairly, accepts bribes, and, as a government official, deceives the public in tax collection. He unlawfully seizes the possessions of others." They hated him because of his sin. He lived without the affection of anyone and was disregarded by all. An inner void persisted, as he lacked the love of others.

At that moment, Jesus encountered him and extended an invitation to visit his house. This gesture resonated with him as if Jesus had conveyed, "Zacchaeus, even if others don't love you, I do; even if no one visits your home, I am coming." A profound comfort filled his injured soul. With immense eagerness and curiosity, he wanted to discover the nature of Jesus. Eventually, he realised that Jesus was incredibly affectionate, leading him to the understanding that Jesus is a loving Lord who cares even for sinners.



In Matthew 15:32, there's an account of an incident where the crowd had been engrossed in listening to Jesus' teachings for three days straight, neglecting their need for food and rest. Then the Lord said to His disciples, "I have compassion for these people; they have already been with me three days and have nothing to eat. I do not want to send them away hungry, or they may collapse on the way. Jesus was

very keen that a miracle should be done for them. Then the Lord blessed five loaves of bread and two fish, multiplied them, provided them with a fulfilling meal, and sent them away with joy.

What prompted Jesus to enact this miracle? His intention was not to showcase and declare, "Witness my power, people." Instead, Jesus performed miracles driven by love and compassion upon recognising the needs of the people. Our God is a benevolent Lord who entered this world in human form solely to manifest that love for us on Earth.

In Matthew 9:10, Jesus was having a meal at Matthew's house when a multitude of tax

collectors and sinners joined him and his disciples. Observing this, the scribes and Pharisees, who believed they were the most devout and closest to God, questioned Jesus' disciples with irritation, asking, "Why does your teacher dine with tax collectors and sinners?"

They accused Jesus of associating with individuals whom society deemed sinners and outcasts. When Jesus heard this, he said, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I desire mercy, not sacrifice. For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners." According to Matthew II:19, the scriptures affirm that Jesus is the companion of sinners. Jesus associated himself with those in society labelled as sinners and those considered of low caste.

Are you familiar with the final miraculous act that Jesus performed? In the Garden of Gethsemane, the religious leaders who were jealous of him came to arrest Jesus in order to crucify him. Simon Peter, one of the disciples of Jesus who had a sword, reacted impulsively as they apprehended Jesus, slicing off the right ear of the high priest's servant in a fit of anger. His ear fell off in pieces and was bleeding. Despite the volatile situation, Jesus reached out and touched the injured man's ear, miraculously restoring it to full health. Jesus demonstrated his divine love by directly

intervening to heal the wounded servant who came to arrest Him.

In Matthew 26:50, Jesus directed his gaze towards Judas, who, despite being with him, had schemed to betray him for monetary gain. Surprisingly, Jesus addressed Judas as 'friend', refraining from viewing him as an enemy. This compassionate act illustrated Jesus' profound love, as he did not regard even the one who planned betrayal as an enemy.

During my school years in Chennai, I used to deride Christians who spoke about Jesus, considering them foolish and promoters of a false deity. I openly mocked Jesus and dismissed those


who tried to share about him by posing numerous questions and ridiculing them. My disdain for Jesus was intense. However, at the age of 14, when I found myself unable to walk, breathe, speak, eat, or even drink water, lying on my deathbed, abandoned by everyone, Jesus, whom I

had despised, sought me out and performed a miraculous healing. Despite my deep-seated hatred, a touch from Jesus, whom I had criticised, transformed my deathbed into a place where I could walk, curing my lameness. My swollen heart returned to normal. The source of my present happiness is attributed to the love of Jesus. Even now, I struggle to comprehend this amazing love of Jesus.

Beloved youth, if there's an extraordinary love in this world, it is the love of Jesus. He is a kind Lord who deeply cares for us and desires to perform miracles in our lives. All you need to do is have faith in Him. He is gentle, compassionate, and truly amazing.

UNEMPLOYMENT

2, 61,847 people lost their jobs globally In 2023. I,000 people were laid off from Paytm last month. Last year, 2,141 people were laid off. A total of 450 people lost their jobs at Dunzo last year alone. Share-Chat has given 600 layoff notices to its employees. These companies have laid off 90,000 people in India in 2 years.

Natural disasters



 - Prolonged loneliness can lead to suicide.









Minutes later, William's squad faced another wave of attacks. William was shot. He thought he was going to die as he felt the pain in his chest. But to his surprise, there was no blood. The Bible in his pocket absorbed the bullet, saving William's life. When he took the Bible, he saw the bullet end on Psalm 91:7, which says, "A thousand shall fall at

your side, ten thousand at your right hand; but it shall not come near you."

The scriptures he hated protected him like a shield. He got another chance to live again that day, accepted Jesus as his saviour, lived until he was 83 years old, and led many people to the Lord through his testimony. William's testimony also rings true for today's generation.

In Scripture, we see how God shielded David in 2 Samuel 22:1-4. The God who protected David, the God who protected William Devers, will surely protect you under His wings. God himself will be a shield and protect you from all the fiery darts the adversary Satan flings at you. India records 9.3 lakh cancer deaths, 12 lakh cases, the second-highest in Asia!



According to a new Lancet study, India became the second-highest contributor to the cancer burden in Asia in 2019.

India recorded approximately 12 lakh new cancer cases and 9.3 lakh deaths in 2019, making the country the second-highest contributor to the cancer burden in Asia that year, according to a new Lancet study.

Published in The Lancet Regional Health Southeast Asia journal, the study, conducted by an international team of researchers, including experts from the National Institute of Technology

Kurukshetra and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Jodhpur, and Bathinda, compared cancer data across 49 Asian countries from 1990 to 2019.

The study highlights that, alongside China and Japan, India played a significant role in the growing cases of cancer threats in Asia, where a staggering 94 lakh new cases and 56 lakh deaths were reported in 2019. China contributed the most, with 48 lakh new cases and 27 lakh deaths, while Japan reported about 9 lakh new cases and 4.4 lakh deaths.

Among the key findings, tracheal, bronchus, and lung (TBL) cancer emerged as the predominant cancer in Asia, causing an estimated 13 lakh cases and 12 lakh deaths.

Cervical cancer ranked highly among women, highlighting the importance of the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine in preventing this type of cancer.

The study also identified smoking, alcohol consumption, and ambient particulate matter pollution as dominant risk factors for cancer across Asia.

"The rising cancer burden due to increasing ambient air pollution is concerning in Asia," they wrote, especially in countries with high levels of ambient particulate matter, such as India, Nepal, Qatar, Bangladesh, and Pakistan.

The study also found the prevalence of smokeless tobacco (SMT) such as khaini, gutka, betel quid, and paan masala in South Asian countries like India, contributing significantly to oral cancers.

India alone accounted for 32.9% of global deaths and 28.1% of new cases of lip and oral cavity cancer in 2019.

The study found the need for addressing the factors contributing to the rise in cancer cases, including industrial growth, urbanisation, migration, and increased motor vehicle usage as well.

We don't find many references to Epaphroditus in the Bible. Only 6 verses in the book of Philippians, chapters 2:25–30 written by Apostle Paul in the New Testament make reference to him.

He was named Epaphroditus after the Greek goddess. Bible scholars believe that Epaphroditus, being a gentile, must have known Jesus Christ through the Apostle Paul's preaching.

The book of Philippians was written while Paul was imprisoned in Rome. After travelling 800 miles, Epaphroditus brought Paul the offering that the Philippians had given to make up for Paul's deficiency. Paul wrote in Philippians 2:26, 27 & 30 that "having travelled many miles without proper sleep and proper food, he became very sick in the body, almost to death."

Paul testifies about Epaphroditus, stating, "He is not just your representative but my brother, fellow worker, fellow soldier, and the one who ministered to my need." Even though his work was small, Epaphroditus was faithful to it. He endured through everything for the cause of Christ, despite the fact he was on the verge of death, and he carried out his appointed mission flawlessly.

The good deeds that you do for others may go unnoticed by others. But do it faithfully to Christ, like Epaphroditus. He was a disciple who brought honour to his mentor. The Bible makes no mention of his preaching anywhere. He might not have been well-known to many people that day. But today, the Lord has made his true love and ministry available for many to talk about.

My dear young readers, the Bible has very few verses mentioning Epaphroditus. But he was beloved by God and his master as a faithful servant. In the same way, God desires us to be as obedient as Epaphroditus, regardless of the size of the job ■
