“I will trust and not be afraid.” (Isaiah 12:2)

We read about King Jehoshaphat in the 20th chapter of II Chronicles. King Jehoshaphat was a king who feared the Lord and lived a life that was pleasing to the Lord during his reign. Once, three kings rose together and suddenly waged a war against him to defeat and dethrone him. They were a huge army, and Jehoshaphat knew that he could not overthrow such a huge army that was at war with him. His first response to the news was fear. In this situation, he asked, “How can I fight this great multitude that is coming against me? The enemies are drawing near, and there is no other way than to meet them in war. How can I overthrow them?” In such a fearful situation, Jehoshaphat proclaimed a fast throughout his country and asked his countrymen to gather together in Jerusalem.

Immediately, the people assembled in a huge gathering. They all prayed together in one accord. Jehoshaphat sought the Lord in a wonderful prayer, “Lord, we have no power against this great multitude that is coming against us; nor do we know what to do, but our eyes are upon You.” (II Chr 20:12). He cried out, saying, “Our eyes are upon You, Lord; only You can give us victory, not by my might nor by my efforts. I know that all my efforts are in vain, but only You can help me.” This prayer turned the situation upside down, and God gave him a miraculous victory. It was a great victory won by the Lord.

Until Jehoshaphat prayed to the Lord, his fear of his enemies was high. But after he prayed, he marched forward boldly to meet his enemies. He clung to the Lord’s promise, “Do not be afraid nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God’s” (II Chron 20:15). There is no need to fear the huge army that is confronting you. This was the word from the Lord. The Lord removed the fear from his heart.

The examination that you are writing or that you are going to write may be a great battlefield. Just like Jehoshaphat, your heart may be filled with





fear. You may think, “Will I win? How can I score so many marks in this subject? How can I pass this exam? I have been scoring low marks in my exams”. With fear in your heart, you may come to the Lord in prayer. Pour out your heart to the Lord, saying, “I don’t know what to do, Lord; I raise my eyes towards you. Only you can help me in this situation.” The Lord will definitely hear your cry of prayer.

The Lord who helped Jehoshaphat with victory will also help you win. Say out loud, “I will not fear but place my faith in You, Lord.”

You should have an experience of “I will not fear.” But, How to get it? If you look at the situation, your inner fear may increase. But, if you look at the Bible, there are 365 instances where the Lord repeatedly says, “Fear not.” It signifies that every day the Lord strengthens you, saying, “Do not fear my son; do not fear my daughter.” The Lord does not want us to have the spirit of fear. Do you know why? Fear prevents your victory, hinders your studies,

and stops your progress. It is for this reason that the Lord asks us not to fear.

When Jesus was born, the first message delivered by the angels to the world was, ‘Fear not; today, a Saviour is born to you’ (Luke 2:10). Similarly, after the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, the first message that He delivered was ‘Fear not’.

What is the reason behind the fear rising in your heart? Think over it! You had wasted your time and not studied properly; you were lazy; you were surrounded by the wrong group of friends; and you did not spend your time on your studies. These are the reasons behind your fear. Well, how and when will this fear leave you?

When you realise your mistake and say, “Jesus forgive me, I have sinned. I have not performed my duties well. I always sat before the TV, looked at my cell phone, and wasted my time. Lord, forgive me.” If you do so, the Lord will forgive and dispel your fear. Confess your sins and seek forgiveness.

Dear youth! The Lord Jesus has changed your fear of your exam results. Trust in the Lord, and you will surely be successful. Be strengthened and say, “Jesus is with me; I will be successful, I will win, and I will achieve.” Await your exam results with faith, and God will perform miracles! ■

Handle your phones sensibly!



**Greetings,
my dear friends!**

We keep trying different ways to live happily. How many of you know that we are being monitored by someone in this modern world?

Yes! We are being monitored by someone when we talk and walk.

In I Peter 5:8, the Bible warns us, "Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour." Thus, in whatever we do, we should be vigilant and act rationally. In Matthew 10:16, Jesus teaches us, "I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore, be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves."

Mobile users should handle their phones carefully. When we install an app on a mobile device, we get a pop-up notification to allow permission for certain things. In a rush to use the new app, we grant access to everything carelessly without realising its consequences. By agreeing to everything, a few apps get our permission to use our camera and microphone even without our knowledge. Apps like Vault that we download in order to conceal certain data begin to use our camera without our consent. Studies show that even several gaming applications control our cameras like





that. Someone can spy on you through your mobile camera. In addition, they are capable of stealing your personal information. Well, suppose your camera or microphone is being used without your knowledge. This article is going to be of great help to you if you don't know how to find it.

Once your mobile phone is hacked, the hacker can turn your camera on or off from anywhere; they can listen to your conversations through the microphone. Clicking pictures or recording videos can also be done. If you think such things are bothering you, you can block them from spying on you. When your camera turns on, you will find a different light illuminating the front or rear cameras. Or you can find it by the activity of the camera. Few applications do not require the use of a camera. So go to settings and turn off the permission given to other apps except essential ones. For Android devices, navigate to SETTINGS · SECURITY AND PRIVACY ·



PERMISSION MANAGER · CAMERA. Here, you can find all the apps that use your camera and can disable them. Moreover, you ought to stop downloading unwanted apps on your mobile device.

Nowadays, you can see a green light in the display on the top right corner when you use the camera or mic on your mobile. This way, you can escape from unwanted problems and know when your camera turns on.

My dear youngsters, you may or may not be monitored by someone through your mobile phone, but the Bible says, "The Lord will keep you from all harm; he will watch over your life" (Psalms 121:7). He will surely protect you from all harm and danger. But we should stay alert to all the mysterious plots of Satan and not fall into his snares. OK guys, I hope you found this article useful. Greetings to all the young champs! We are going to see about "Onesimus" in this month's edition of Gems to be cherished!

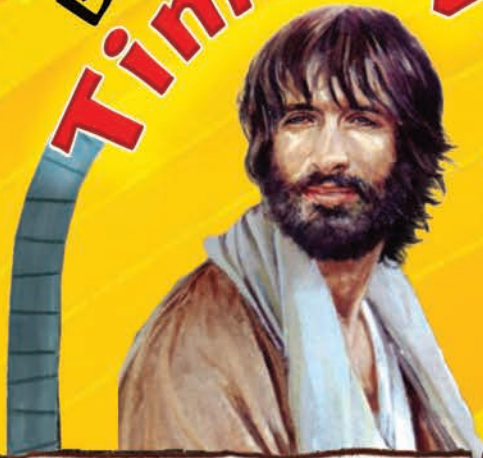
Onesimus was a slave. Onesimus means 'useful'. His life is mentioned in the Colossians 4:9 verse and in Paul's letter to Philemon (1:10). Onesimus was Philemon's slave who lived in Colossae. Philemon received salvation when Paul the apostle preached. Onesimus ran away to Rome from Philemon's household. In the meantime, Paul was house-arrested in Rome. He met Paul accidentally and came to know about the love of Jesus Christ.

Before knowing about the love of Jesus Christ, Onesimus used to be "a useless servant, a slave, an unjust person, and a debtor." But after understanding the love of Jesus Christ, he became a different person who was called "the son of Paul the apostle, useful, and Paul's dearest and most beloved brother." As soon as Paul invited Timothy to minister with him, the young man's heart was filled with enthusiasm to serve the great God who had saved him. The twenty-year-old youth gave his consent without any second thought to leave everything, like his home, country, and parents, to serve the Lord.

Since all the Jews there knew that Timothy's father was a Greek, Paul thought that this might cause a stumbling block to his ministry, so he made Timothy be circumcised (Acts 16:3). Later, Paul and the elders of Lystra consecrated Timothy as a missionary for the ministry of the gospel. Timothy took leave of his household and his congregation and set out with Paul for his field of ministry.

After Timothy joined the Apostle Paul's group, they preached the gospel in Phrygia

and Galatia and came to Troas. Luke, the physician, also joined them here. Wherever they went, the churches were strengthened in the faith and multiplied day by day (Acts 16:5). Timothy's heart swelled with joy when he saw such spiritual changes in the congregations.

My dear youngsters, what would our response be if the Lord called us into ministry? In last month's issue, we discussed 'self-choice' and its consequences through the life story of Lot. This month, let us look at another example, Samson, about his self-choice and its consequences (Judges 13-16).



Samson was one of Israel's judges. His birth was specially foretold by an angel to his parents. He was a Nazarene for the Lord from the day he was born. He was born with God's will to save the Israelites from the Philistines. But Samson, not realising the purpose of his birth and the greatness of it, wanted to take a woman from the Philistines as his wife, whom he was created to destroy. His parents were not interested in him marrying a woman from the uncircumcised troop; they wanted him to marry a woman from their people. But Samson persisted in his choice. He chose to follow his eyes and prioritise his own desires over God's will and his parents' wishes, travelling to the country of the Philistines. This resulted in an array of issues and confusion for him.

His 'riddle game' led to 30 murders perversely. Frustration, anger, revenge, etc., took away his peace. He couldn't marry the woman he

liked. As his love life was a failure, he sought love from another wrong woman called Delilah. Because of her, he was easily betrayed, got caught in the hands of his enemies, and lost his eyes. Just think! Would the Philistines have given him anesthesia before gouging out his eyes to make him feel painless? The Philistines were his enemies; they have suffered many destructions because of Samson. They would have ruthlessly gouged his eyes out in such rage, tormenting him to the core!

As the Bible says, "The eyes that mocks a father, that scorns an aged mother, will be pecked out by the ravens of the valley, will be eaten by the vultures." (Proverbs 30:17) The eyes that he gave importance to were cruelly gouged out and would have fed to a bird or an animal because of his self-choice that he made against God's will and for despising the counsel of his parents. How pathetic!

Samson then repented, pleaded with God with a broken heart, and regained his lost strength. With all his might, he shook the pillars of the building where the Philistines had gathered, destroyed a huge number of them, and died with

them as well by falling into the ruins of the building. The dead that he killed at his death were more than he had killed in his life.

Note well! The purpose for which Samson was created was fulfilled by God here. Even his name was later included in the list of faith warriors because of his repentance (Hebrew 11). But Samson found neither a wife nor any good thing. His 'Progeny' was not blessed either. Perhaps if Samson feared God, obeyed his parents and found a life partner among God's people, he might have had thirty or sixty little Samsons, as judges and the Israelites would have lived so bravely and comfortably in the midst of their enemies because of these tiny mighty men.

CONSEQUENCES OF SAMSON'S SELF-CHOICE

- The one who should have been happy with the wife of his youth encountered an untimely death at a young age!
- A mighty warrior was made to grind in the prison.
- The one who terrified the beholders by killing thousands of people with a donkey's jawbone turned out to be a blind clown, to amuse the enemies.
- He set his fiancé and her father on fire.
- 30 murders and the torture of 300 foxes by setting their tails on fire.
- Destruction of the fields of the Philistines.

Look! How many instances of conflict and disaster...

My beloved, is self-choice needed? Think about it!

Ticket to HELL!

Part - 3

Hello friends! The weapon that Satan uses to take people to hell is sin. One such tool that Satan employs is sexual sin, which we studied in detail last month. We learned, “What are sexual sins? How much have these sexual sins increased in society? What are the reasons for the increase in these sins? What is its origin? What are the effects on our body, mind, family, and society because of our involvement in sexual sins? And, How to overcome this sin? Let’s look at covetousness this month as another tool the devil employs.

Covetousness

Covetousness is a sin. You may think, “Oops! Is covetousness a sin? So far, I wasn’t aware that it was a sin!” Some may ask, “How does having a desire for materialistic things become a sin?” Of course, covetousness or greed is a sin. The Bible is always our source of reference! We ought to see what the Bible says.

In Isaiah 57:17, it is mentioned as “for the iniquity of his covetousness.” To want things out of greed is considered iniquity. It is a sin. Some look at some materialistic things and want to buy them somehow. They would say that they could not live without it. It implies that they have become slaves to it. Anything that makes you a slave is a sin.

Some desire mobile phones. Without it, they would neither eat nor sleep nor do any work. Some desire gadgets. Whether they use them or not, they will buy and hoard

them. Some desire bikes, cars, jewels, clothes, etc. The list goes on.

Colossians 3:5 says, “Covetousness is idolatry.” You are engaging in idolatry if you are craving materialistic items. An idol is something that prevents you from perceiving God. If covetousness blinds you from seeing God or separates you from God, it is an idol, and it is a sin.

Matthew 7:22–23 says, “Covetousness comes from within and defiles a man.” Today, certain government officials, those in authority, take bribes even to sign a document. Some judges take bribes and flip justice. The reason for all this is that they



have greed in their hearts. In the Bible, we see that the children of the prophet Samuel turned to greed and began accepting bribes to pervert the course of justice. When greed enters a man, it makes him take bribes, get involved in corruption, and violate justice.

Proverbs 15:27 says, “He who is greedy for gain troubles his own house.” The same verse in the GNB translation says, “If you try to make a profit dishonestly, you will get your family into trouble.”

Furthermore, Romans 1:29–32 says, “Covetous people are deserving of death.” Greed pulls us towards death. Before God destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah, in order to save Lot and his family, He sent angels to take them by hand, leave them out of those cities, and tell them not to look back. But the heart of Lot’s wife was not with the Lord. Her heart was on the wealth—goats,



cows, donkeys, etc., that she left behind. So she looked back, turned into a pillar of salt, and died before her time.

Proverbs 1:19 says, “Having greed for gain takes away the life of its owners.” That is why Luke 12:15 says, “Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of the things

he possesses.” Gehazi became a leper because of his greed, and he brought the curse upon his generation as well (2 Kings 5:27). Ananias and Sapphira lied to the Holy Spirit and died because of their greed (Acts 5:5, 10).

However, if we detest covetousness, our days can be prolonged, says the Bible (Proverbs 28:16). The sin of covetousness doesn’t affect us only in this world. In the afterlife, it will take our souls to hell and hinders the privilege of going to heaven. The Bible says that covetous people shall not inherit the kingdom of God (1 Corinthians 6:10; Ephesians 5:5). Our enemy, Satan, operates gravely and cunningly to take us to hell. King David said a

beautiful prayer in Psalm 119:36: “incline my heart to Your testimonies and not to covetousness.”

Would you also join with me in prayer?

Lord Jesus, thank you for teaching me about covetousness today. Cleanse my mind with your holy blood, forgive my sin of covetousness, and grant me self-control. Help me not to give room for greed and end up in hell. Guide me to live a holy life. Let me incline my heart to Your testimonies and not to covetousness. Amen!

Okay, friends, we shall meet again next month with another sin that leads to hell.



Humiliation turned into Adornment!

Greetings pals! This is the testimony of Sis. Joysha, who was born into a Christian family, began preaching the gospel at a young age, thereby winning a lot of souls. She studied well and is a lawyer today, while at the same time continuing to serve the Lord. Come, let us hear her testify about the ways the Lord has led her down.

CHILDHOOD AND FAMILY

I was born and raised in a very spiritual Christian family in a village called Viravanallur in Tirunelveli district. My mother is a teacher and also does village ministry. Since 2020, my father, who worked abroad, has been residing with us. I have a brother and a sister. As my mother is ministering, I too attend every prayer she goes to. God filled me with His Holy Spirit when I was 8 years old. When I was in fifth grade, my teacher rebuked me for sharing the gospel with my fellow students. I was even slapped for proclaiming Jesus to my friend. But after a few years, I came to know that her whole family got saved, and I praised the Lord!

Again When I prayed about choosing the right course for college, God guided me to choose B.A. History. He helped me excel in it and made me get the 4th rank in the university. INDIA AIMING TO ACHIEVE ONE-THIRD OF THE GLOBAL MILK PRODUCTION BY 2030



NDDDB aims to increase India's share in global milk production to one-third by 2030. Focus on breeding, nutrition, animal health, and animal productivity. The Government of India and NDDDB are working together. NDDDB forms a joint venture in Assam working on increasing the procurement and capacity of WAMUL using renewable and solar energy sources. Emphasis on holistic development.

The National Dairy Development Board (NDDDB) is working to increase productivity so that India can account for one-third of the global milk production by 2030, its chairman, Meenesh Shah, said. He said breeding, nutrition, and the health of animals are the main focus areas for achieving the target.

"Currently, India accounts for 24 percent, or one-fourth, of total world milk production. This contributes to 4–5 percent of our GDP. Our plan is to increase the share globally to 30 percent, or one-third, of world milk production by 2030," he said.

Increasing the productivity of animals is crucial to achieving it, Shah said, pointing out that though India is the largest producer of milk, animal productivity is less than in developed countries.

"The Government of India and NDDDB are working together on their mission to increase productivity. Breeding, nutrition, and the health of animals are the crucial areas in this regard," he added.

"Our milk production has been growing at 6 percent per annum for the last five-six years, while the global growth rate is 2 percent. We have to maintain it," Shah said.

PRODUCTION OF WHEAT TO HIT ALL-TIME HIGH



In the crop year 2021–22 (July–June), wheat production stood at 107.74 million tonnes. During 2023–24, the production of Rapeseed and Mustard is pegged at 12.69 million tonnes.

The production of wheat is estimated to reach an all-time high of 112.01 million tonnes during the crop year 2023–24, shows data released by the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare on Thursday.

The Second Advance Estimates of Major Agricultural Crops (Kharif & Rabi Season) for the year 2023–24 shows that wheat output during the rabi 2023–24 is estimated to reach an all-time high of 112.01 million, which is 1.32 percent higher than the 110.55 million metric tonnes figure recorded in 2022–23.
