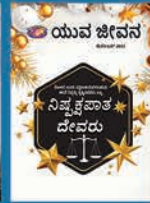
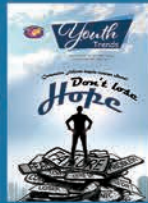

OVERCOME the OBSTACLES



Anyone who is working towards success faces challenges in one way or another. Those who overcome such challenges are champions in life. For every champion, the first challenge is his mind. If the mind is optimistic, he can fearlessly accomplish anything. Rather, if the mind believes "it is too difficult or you can't do it," you cannot achieve anything. So, it is crucial to overcome the negative thoughts to reach your goal in life, as this helps you leap halfway towards your goal.

When progressing towards our goal, it is vital to keep your focus solely on it. Worrying about the challenges will melt down your path towards the goal. For example, if you have completed your school or college education and are trying to get into your higher education or a job but are unable to achieve it, focus your mind on it, and you will surely achieve it. Once, when David



returned from war to Ziklag, the Amalekites looted everything that belonged to David. Rather than being discouraged, David strengthened himself in God, and according to God's word, "he and his 600 men left" (1 Samuel 30:9). When they came near the brook Besor, 200 men stayed behind.

David wasn't discouraged; he continued his journey with 400 men. Later, 200 men left David as they felt too exhausted

to cross the Besor valley. David faced challenges one after the other, but he wasn't discouraged. Instead, he believed in God's word and progressed. Hence, "David recovered everything the Amalekites had taken, including his two wives. Nothing was missing: young or old, boy or girl, plunder or anything else they had taken. David brought everything back." (1 Samuel 30:19). On seeing the barriers in front of him, if David had been discouraged, he could not have won this battle. We can achieve huge victories only when we overcome barriers. We cannot achieve our goals if we get tired of seeing obstacles.

Make progress towards your goal every day. Don't be discouraged by your obstacles. If you want to accomplish your goal, it is

important to work hard, practice, and have some hope. No matter how many obstacles come your way, you can only pursue them if you believe that you can overcome them. No matter how many people rise and try to block you from your pursuit, keep moving forward.

When Nehemiah started building the walls of Jerusalem, he had to face numerous obstacles, stress, struggles, difficulties, insults, and opposition. But he continued to focus on his work. Sanballat and Tobiah sent their workers, asking Nehemiah to stop his work, but Nehemiah didn't give his


ears to them. He sent them back with the message, "I am doing a great work, so that I cannot come down" (Nehemiah 6:3). On the other side, Nehemiah's staffers lost interest in the work and were reluctant to engage in the work of rebuilding the wall, citing petty issues. All these challenges did not startle Nehemiah; instead, he continued to work hard with perseverance and hope towards God. This helped him rebuild the wall of Jerusalem successfully. The people with Nehemiah were weak and whined to his disappointment. But Nehemiah believed in the Lord, who had sent him. He believed in God's word, "The

One who breaks open the way will go up before them" (Micah 2:13) and succeeded in his work.



My dear young people, many

challenges may come your way. But if you put all your heart and mind into your goal, you will certainly achieve it. Obstacles are usual when you are on your way to success. Don't give room for fatigue and worry about it. Instead, strengthen your mind and believe in Jesus, who chose and called you. He will break every obstacle in your life and help you achieve your desired goal ■



The Lord who breaks the Barriers!

“The One who breaks open the way will go up before them; they will break through the gate and go out. Their King will pass through before them, the Lord at their head.” (Micah 2:13)

There are many obstacles and closed doors that a person may come across in one's life. A person may face barriers in his business, in marriage, in jobs, in having children, in job promotions, in studies, in prayer life, or in ministry work. There are many people in today's world facing closed doors. It keeps them unhappy and dejected, as they are unable to move forward in their lives.

Even in your life, you may be facing such obstacles, but the Lord looks at you and says, “My son/daughter, I am the Lord who breaks through all obstacles. Paul wanted to do his ministry work in Thessalonica. He says to

Dearly beloved, can Satan always create a barrier? No, he cannot. He may create an obstacle once, but not always, because the Lord, who breaks open barriers, will create a way for you.

Similarly, Paul tells the Romans, “Dear brethren, I do not want you to be unaware that I often planned to come to you (but was hindered until now), that I might have some fruit among you also, just as among the other Gentiles (Romans 1:13). Paul wanted to go to Rome to do God's ministry; he strived to go there, but he was unable to do so. But later, God brought Paul to Rome and helped him spread the word of the Lord. It was in Rome that Paul died as a martyr. When

the right time came, God opened the door for Paul and brought him to Rome.

Even today, Satan may bring some obstacles into your life. But without God's permission, he cannot obstruct your progress. Even if Satan schemes and toils to create stumbling blocks, he cannot block your progress completely. He can only create a temporary barrier. But the Lord can break through such barriers and create ways for you.

A certain woman had multiple miscarriages because Satan tried to prevent her from having a child. But the Holy Spirit revealed Satan's plan to the couple. They prayed together, and the evil attack was removed. The Lord destroyed Satan's plan and made them happy by blessing them with a child. Satan cannot always bring obstacles into your life. The Lord will break them open for you. He will break the barriers and shower you with His blessings. In your business, He will open doors; in your job, He will bless you with great prospects; He will break barriers that prevent you from getting married and bless you with a happy married life.

Handle your phones sensibly!

Loving greetings to the Youth Trends readers in the sweet name of Jesus Christ. I believe that you are constantly learning new things through this article on handling a cell phone.

Last month, you learned about cloud storage and Google Notes. Let's continue with that this month and see what more can be done with the help of this cloud storage. Usually, we forget things when we're rushing through a task. We frequently forget certain essential details as a result of excessive work or overstudying. Some of you may study at colleges, or you may be working in IT firms. In such situations, we would type important things related to study or work in Microsoft Word or Excel in the office or college.

In some emergency situations, the information we have stored on one device cannot be accessed on another. For instance, you might not be able to edit any information you save at work or college in a Word document or PowerPoint slide after you go home.

The work left halfway can be resumed only on the next day. Cloud storage offers a solution to



these issues. Google Docs is an alternative to Microsoft Word that we use to store textual material. You may type in letters, study materials, office documents, and so on. The data we provide through this Google Docs application will be cloud-stored along with our email address. No matter where we are, we can access the files we need just by entering our MAIL ID on any device.

Google Sheets and Google Slides are equivalent alternatives for Microsoft Excel and Microsoft Power Point, respectively. This enables us to easily use CLOUD STORAGE for free with GOOGLE APPS. (Note: The Microsoft also has cloud storage, but usage requires a monthly subscription, but Google offers up to 15GB of free storage.) This will remove barriers to work or study and open new opportunities.

Dear young people, you may encounter challenges in your life when attempting to accomplish certain goals. Due to forgetfulness, commitments may not be fulfilled or decisions may not be firmly established. In such

situations, the help of someone other than yourself is definitely needed. Even in our Holy Bible, David says, "Give us help from trouble, for the help of man is useless" (Psalm 108:12). Human help is useless in dire situations. God alone is able to help us. Do you have a question about how the Lord can help us? He will help us through the Holy Spirit. "When He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears, He

will speak, and He will tell you things to come" (John 16:13).

The Holy Spirit will give you the counsel, comfort, and guidance you need at the right times. So learn to rely on the Holy Spirit in all situations to readily receive the blessings of God!

My warmest wishes to the dear young achievers. Every human born on this planet has a unique talent. We should continue to hone that gift every day rather than keeping it hidden from ourselves. We must strive to exhibit our talent in this world. Achievers are those who win struggles. Here, we present to you the life journey of an achiever who battled through life and flew the victory flag.

Erik Weihenmayer was born in New Jersey in 1968 with a rare eye disease called Retinoschisis. Diagnosed when he was 15 months old, the disease turned into glaucoma and left him completely blind at the age of 13. He did not offer to learn Braille, even though he was blind.

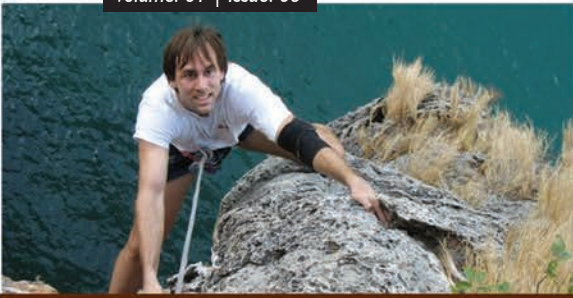
While studying in school, he had a strong interest in wrestling, trained in it, became the best wrestler in high school, and captained his team. In the meantime, he lost his mother and fell into profound depression.

Then, following his father's guidance, he attempted mountain climbing. Using his hands and feet, he identified holes in the mountains. Not only that, he worked as a middle school teacher and wrestling coach at Phoenix Country Day School.

With this, his journey didn't cease. He had to put in a lot of effort to carry on with his mountain-climbing journey. Weihenmayer's first major mountain climb was Denali. In 2004, along with six blind Tibetan youths, he climbed the 21,500-foot north face of Everest.

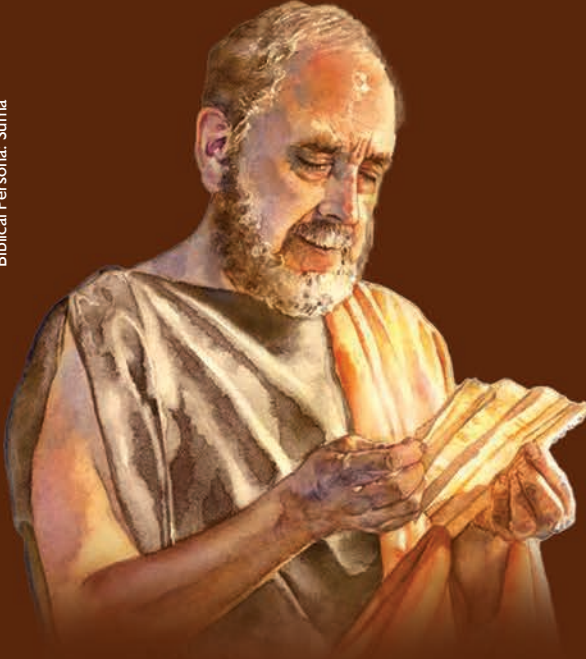
Weihenmayer became the first visually challenged person to reach the summit of Mount Everest on May 25, 2001. He was honored on the cover of Time magazine for this accomplishment.

In September 2002, he became the first blind person to reach the 7 highest peaks on 7 continents. He also made it to Australia's highest peak, the Carstensz Pyramid, in 2008. Eric Weihenmayer is a blind athlete, adventurer, writer, activist, and motivational speaker.

Walking in the truth was Gaius's greatest strength. He never backed down from the actual truth, despite the fact that he witnessed several teachings that day. He was a man who was always willing to provide hospitality. These two are among his exceptional traits that are highly admired. He was well spoken of by everyone. To John, he was like a child.

Despite being a brief book authored by the apostle John, the account of Gaius's life in 3 John is highly beneficial to Christians.

DEPRESSION

We youngsters are living in a quite competitive world. It's true that we deal with a lot of challenges every day. Based on this, we express our emotions in various ways. The following content is for you, especially if you are feeling a lot of unpleasant emotions like tension, rage, hatred, fear, and loneliness.

"I AM IN DEPRESSION" is one of the phrases we hear most frequently in the modern world. Many young people tell me that I'm under a lot of stress. This depressive state is something you can deal with.

Nowadays, children, teenagers, heads of households, people who are single, and even servants of God are affected by this depression.



Causes of depression

- The root cause of depression is "disappointment."
- Some people experience disappointment and get depressed when their expectations are not met within the expected time.
- Some feel disappointed and depressed due to the actions of their loved ones.

Such shattered expectations lead to disappointment. This is the root cause of depression.

People who dealt with depression in the Bible

It's common for a praying Christian to feel depressed at times! However, dealing with it and coming out of it is considered to be the specialty of God's children. The finest example of a person having overcome depression is "Nehemiah."

Nehemiah encountered a number of circumstances that would have made him feel depressed when he was building the wall in Jerusalem. Even though he went out of his way to help the Israelites, he encountered a number of disappointments! Even though he had many reasons to be depressed, such as the problems caused by Sanballat and Tobiah and the problems that needed to be solved within the Israelites, he



overcame them and completed the rebuilding of the wall of Jerusalem in 52 days. The key to his wise handling of this depression is, as Nehemiah 8:10 says, "The joy of the Lord is your strength."

YES! THE ONLY CURE FOR DEPRESSION IS "JOY."

When disappointment befalls you, rejoice in the Lord. The things that bring you down will change.

Do you wonder, "How is it possible to be happy when I'm broken and hurt?"

It requires the assistance of the Holy Spirit. However, it is during times of depression that many of us cut off our relationship with God and stop reading the Bible and praying. This is Satan's trick!

At such times, it is up to us to decide and try to overcome depression with the help of the Holy Spirit, or to languish in solitude, worry, and spoil the body by starving.

DEAR YOUNGSTERS, WHAT IS YOUR DECISION?

Your prayers can be heard by your cry! (2 Kings 20:5)

- Be anxious for nothing, but in everything, by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. (Philippians 4:6)

Brave Timothy



Hello friends, I am extremely delighted to meet you again in this series called "Brave Timothy"! I hope you find this series quite beneficial.

So far, we've learned a lot about Timothy's early life, his call to ministry, and the challenges he experienced as a young minister.

Last month, we saw that, when Timothy and his team were evangelising with Paul, the hardships caused by the rebels provided Timothy with the mental power and unshakable faith to overcome challenges.

Paul was eager to know the state of the believers in Thessalonica. For this, he chose not Silas but the very young Timothy.

Paul had such confidence in Timothy

Each of us has individual responsibilities and duties to perform. Are we doing them right, on time, neatly, and properly? Are you perplexed that I am now addressing responsibility? This month, we'll look at Timothy's first responsibility. Come on, let's get into it.

FIRST RESPONSIBILITY ASSIGNED TO TIMOTHY

Paul and others had to leave overnight for the city of Thessalonica because of the riot provoked by the Jews. Besides that, the Jews from the city of Thessalonica also came to Berea and incited a riot. Thus, the Apostle

that he sent him to the rioters. Timothy did not disappoint Paul's trust and performed admirably with the help of the Lord. He went to Thessalonica, where the riots had taken



place, comforted them so that they would not be discouraged by these troubles, and strengthened them in the faith.

This was Timothy's first task. So that no one should be shaken by these troubles, we sent Timothy, our brother and God's worker in the gospel of Christ, our fellow worker, to strengthen you and encourage you in your faith. (1 Thessalonians 3:2).

For a young guy undertaking ministry on his own for the first time, isn't this a huge responsibility?

It must have been beyond his age. There must have been people older than him in the church he visited. Timothy hastened to fulfil the responsibility that was given to him without having any negative thoughts like, "Will they listen to what I say? Or would they be offended because I am young?"

He went to Thessalonica and strengthened the believers in that church. He then returned to Corinth with good news about the church's faith and love. This news greatly encouraged the apostle Paul. In response to this good news, Paul wrote his first letter to the church, from Corinth to Thessalonica.

Paul did not identify only himself as the author of this epistle to the Thessalonians (1 Thessalonians 1:1); he also included the names of Timothy and Silas, highlighting their significance. While residing in Corinth, the Apostle Paul sent his second epistle to the Thessalonians in the names of these three (2 Thessalonians 1:1).

Just imagine a 20-year-old young guy undertaking such a huge responsibility on his own, carrying it out flawlessly and effortlessly with apparent results.

Since Timothy carried out his first task well, he must have been offered more responsibilities. Not only Paul, but the Lord Jesus Christ as well, must have been more confident in him as a result of his success.

In general, responsibilities are given to young people. They are trusted with everything because they are fearless and full of energy, and they approach everything with vigour, dexterity, and thoughtful consideration. Only those who fulfil their duties to a high standard will reap the rewards. Only in such a person do others exude greater confidence. They will achieve better things in life as a result of that confidence. The Bible tells us that the righteous man will receive perfect blessings.

As a daughter or son, a student, an employee, a member of the church, and a citizen of the country, we also have a lot of duties. Do we execute them correctly? Do we try to accomplish them? Or do we shirk them? Let's think about it. As we pray to the Lord for blessings and spiritual advancements, we often neglect to assess how well we are carrying out our given responsibilities. Our shortcomings in carrying out our duties could at times be the cause of our failures. If so, let's evaluate ourselves and, with God's help, make the necessary corrections. Victory is sure!

Ticket to HELL!

Part - 5

Hello friends, Satan uses sin as a trap to lead us to hell. One such trap was lying, which we discussed in brief last month. We got to know the answers to many questions, like, What is a lie? What does the Bible say about it? Who are liars? From whom does the sin of lying come from? And what are the consequences of lying? This month we are going to discuss another Satan's trap, which is 'drunkenness'.

DRUNKENNESS

Drinking alcohol and being intoxicated by it is called drunkenness. In short, we define drunkenness as an alcohol addiction. This sin has spread widely these days. From children to adults, everyone, regardless of age, gets drunk. There was a time when only men drank. But throughout time, women also started drinking, saying that we are not inferior to men and that we have all rights like them. These days, people sit and drink as a family.



We could see school and college students posting drinking videos on social media in their uniforms. In those days, mostly illiterate people only drank. However, educated individuals are drinking more these days. On those days, people drank occasionally. Nowadays, people drink on all occasions, like a New Year party, a birthday party, a marriage

function, when they get a job or promotion, when a baby is born, etc. Few men and women go to alcoholic centres like nightclubs, pubs, clubs, and bars to get themselves drunk. Some drink as a hobby, some for pride, and some to forget their problems. Few young people use heroin, cocaine, cannabis, and other illegal substances to get intoxicated. Many people like this in our society get drunk and intoxicated. These people are referred to as drunkards in the Bible.

Do you know why this sin of "drunkenness" has increased now so much like never before? Because this is the end time. When the disciples asked Jesus what would be the sign of the end of the world and the coming of Jesus, this was one of the many signs that Jesus said. "Be careful, or your hearts will be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and the anxieties of life, and that day will close on you suddenly like a trap" (Luke 21:34).



What are the effects of drunkenness?

Alcohol enslaves the heart (Hosea 4:11).

Alcohol leads to transgression (Habakkuk 2:5).

Not only that, but alcohol makes us stagger and lose our way (Isaiah 28:7).

Drunkards do not know what they are doing.

Some people get drunk, fight, beat their wives and children, lie half-naked on the road, misbehave with women, and sometimes even don't hesitate to commit murder.

The Bible says that drunkards will become poor. (Proverbs 23:21, 21:17) They spend all the money they earn on alcohol, sell their property, borrow money, and eventually accumulate debt. Proverbs 23:29–35 teaches us about the adverse effects of alcohol addiction. In the Bible, when Noah was drunk, he wasn't even aware when his clothes were off (Genesis 9:21). Drunkenness makes us stumble (Job 12:25). Many people fall sick and die because of this sin. So many women are widows, and children are fatherless.



This sin of drunkenness brings curses into our lives (Isaiah 5:11). This sin not only has an impact while living in this world but also leads our soul to hell after death.

Drunkards will not inherit the kingdom of God (Galatians 5:21; 1 Corinthians 6:10).

WHAT GUIDANCE DOES THE BIBLE PROVIDE US IN THIS REGARD?

Those who are addicted to alcohol are like those who stroll in the dark. They may stumble and face many mishaps. Therefore, the scriptures say, “Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness” (Romans 13:13). In Ephesians 5:18–19, the Bible says, “Do not be drunk with wine, which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns.”

Young brothers and sisters reading this: sin has power. Sin destroys peace, brings sickness, and enslaves you (John 8:34). It is the devil who works behind every sin.

Are you worried that ‘I started drinking for fun and gradually became addicted to it?’ There are a few others who know that it is a sin but cannot let it go. Worry not! Jesus Christ not only forgives our sins, but he also delivers us from them. That is why He shed His blood, bore your sin on Him, and defeated Satan on the cross. According to the words ‘If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed’, when you commit yourself today and cry out to Him, ‘Jesus, forgive my sin and set me free from it,’ no matter how many years you have been enslaved to this sin, one touch of Jesus Christ will set you free.

Dear young people, the devil is conspiring to get us to hell by making us commit the sin of “drunkenness.” Thus, avoid the terrible consequences of this sin by being vigilant and sober.

“The days of our lives are seventy years; and if by reason of strength they are eighty years,” says the Bible. (Psalms 90:10)

If you divide this into years before and after marriage, the time people have before marriage is comparatively less. For example, if a man gets married at 25 and lives till 75, it means that he lived twice the amount of time in marriage than being single. So God wants everyone's marriage to be filled with joy, happiness, and peace. To make this happen, every youngster out there must cooperate with God. SIN

For example, a youngster might have picked up the habit of smoking from his friends. When he realises his sin while getting ready for marriage, all he has to do is confess his sins to God, regardless of their intensity, and repent. Will not the God who forgave the ones who crucified him even before they repented forgive you? Pray earnestly, seeking His divine presence and peace; no one can stop the blessing you are about to receive.

PARENTS

Sometimes the parents who haven't been redeemed by Christ might stand in the way of you getting a life partner who has entered salvation. Cast your burden on Christ in this situation, too. He alone can open the sealed doors. Once, a girl born to a non-believer industrialist got redeemed in college through her friends. She was free to worship Jesus until she was in the hostel. But when she returned home, a great shock awaited her. Her father told her that he had promised to marry her to the son of another non-believer industrialist. She was unable to bear it. She was terrified, thinking about how she couldn't survive without praising God, praying to him, or reading his words. Since the Bible has mentioned eight times (Exodus 20:12; Deutro 5:16; Matt 15:4; Luke 18:20; Heb 6:3) that one should honour their parents, she was unwilling to



rebel against their decision. She also didn't share her burden with anyone. Whenever she was alone, she fasted and prayed with a burden. She would stay awake for many nights and continue praying. Eventually, her heart was filled with a divine peace that the world couldn't give.

God gave her the verse, "All things work together for good to those who love God," and strengthened her. After this, she didn't cry or resist that marriage. And the marriage happened to everyone's joy. When she confessed that she loves Christ to her newly-

married husband, he also shared that he is a secret Christian and had been praying sincerely for a Christ-loving bride. Both of them were filled with joy beyond words. This beloved daughter has proved that prayer can make unimaginable things happen, hasn't she?

Hello, I'm Urvashi. I live in Delhi. Unlike most children, I had a miserable childhood. I am motherless. I have two brothers, one older and the other younger. My father is an alcoholic. He doesn't like it when I laugh, talk happily, and play with other children. However, when I was in my first year of college, I got to know Jesus and accepted Him as my personal savior. That day, struggles started in my life. My father wanted to end my life because I accepted Jesus.



Every day, he used to buy liquor, drink, and even get my brother drunk. Both would get completely drunk and beat me very badly. They beat ruthlessly. Every day, I go to college with bruises on my face and arms. Everybody would laugh at me. Days turned into months like this. I was beaten and tormented every day, undergoing physical and mental agony.



However, none of this affected my love for Jesus. My father used a new technique to kick me out once he realised I was leading a Christian life without leaving the house. One day my father and brother drank and thrashed me so badly, and then they called the people of the neighbourhood and

GST revenues hit record Rs 2.10 lakh crore in April on strong eco momentum, efficient tax collections!



The Gross Goods and Services Tax (GST) collections hit a record high in April 2024 at Rs 2.10 lakh crore. This represents a significant 12.4 per cent year-on-year growth, driven by a strong increase in domestic transactions (up 13.4 per cent) and imports (up 8.3 per cent)," the ministry said.

The GST revenue, which is basically taxes on goods sold and services rendered, was more than Rs 1.78 lakh crore last month, while it stood at Rs 1.87 lakh crore in April 2023.

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in a post on X (formerly Twitter) lauded the efforts of tax officers for achieving the milestone. GST collection crosses Rs 2 lakh crore benchmark, thanks to the strong momentum in the economy and efficient tax collections," she said.

The total cess collection was Rs 13,260 crore, including Rs 1,008 crore collected on imported goods. "There are no dues pending on account of IGST settlement to the states," Sitharaman said in an X post. After accounting for refunds, the net GST revenue for April 2024 stood at Rs 1.92 lakh crore, a 15.5 per cent growth compared to the same period last year.

Investors lose over Rs 2 lakh crore as Sensex melts 733 pts.



Selling pressure in index heavyweights Reliance Industries (RIL) and HDFC Bank dragged Indian headline indices on Friday. While the S&P BSE Sensex crashed 1,143 points or 1.5% to the day's low of 73,467.73, the broader Nifty 50 plunged 300 points, hitting the day's low of 22,348.05. Most of the sectoral indices traded with cuts.

Sensex settled at 73,878.15, down by 733 points or 0.98% while the Nifty closed at 22,475.85, lower by 172 points or 0.76%. The market capitalisation of BSE-listed companies dropped by a whopping Rs 2.53 lakh crore. Fear gauge India VIX also surged 9% to almost 15, gaining for the 7th straight session.

"I feel geopolitical tension would make headlines again giving traders an option to go short on markets. Overall, Q4 earnings are neutral to positive and not so impressive. There are few reports that suggest that FIIs have reduced holding in large caps stocks like HDFC Bank and ITC. For the short term, the trend remains cautious and focus would be on fresh geopolitical headlines. Hence, we advise traders to remain light on positions," said Prashanth Tapse of Mehta Equities.
