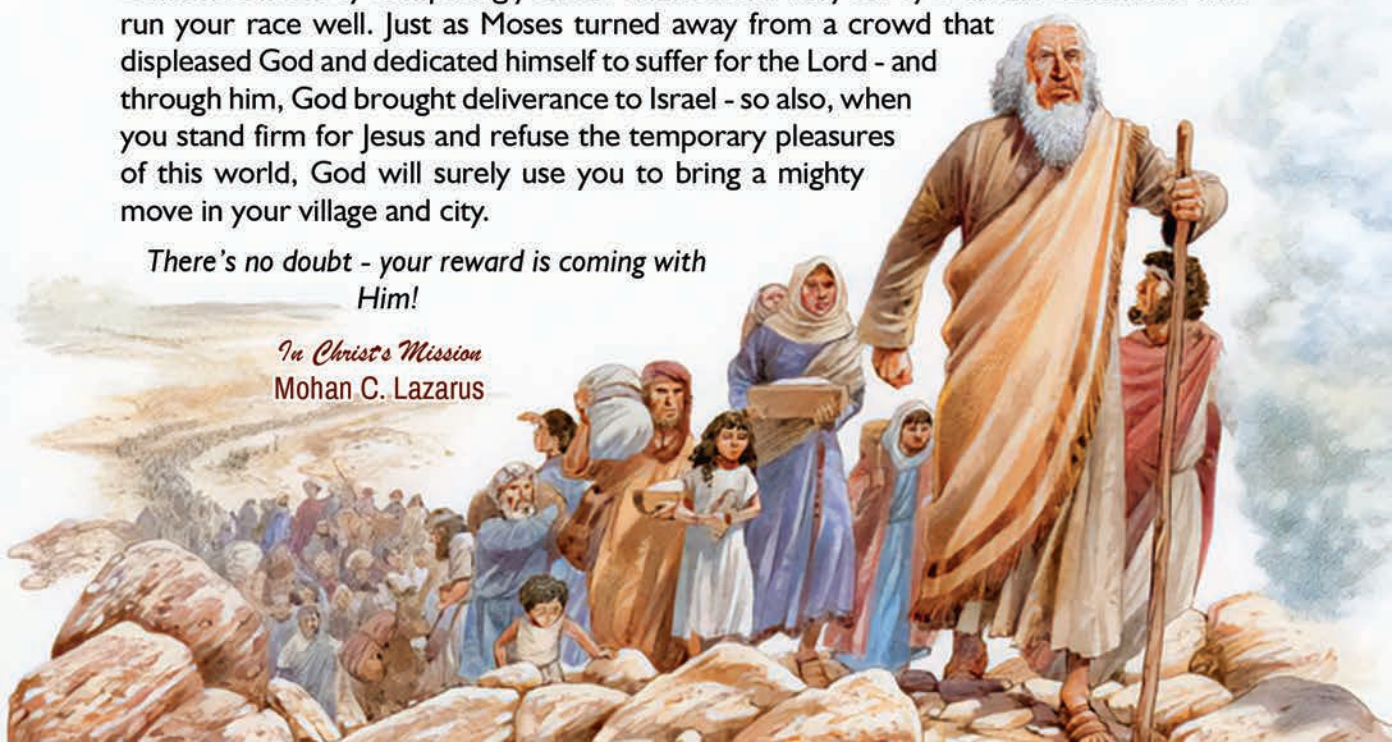

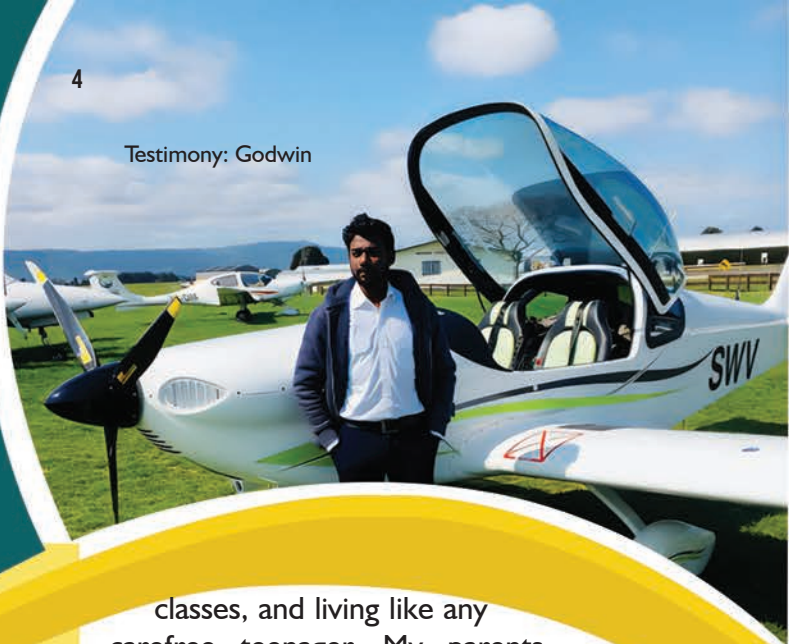
There’s no doubt - your reward is coming with Him!

The Flight of Faith



An inspiring journey of Brother Giani Samuel, Founder of ARK 27 Aviation Academy Born and raised in the small town of Kovilpatti, Brother Giani Samuel grew up with one dream—to become a pilot. Today, after walking through countless challenges, he runs his own Pilot Academy – ARK 27 Aviation. Let's hear his inspiring journey in his own words.

Hi Brother, could you tell us about your family and childhood?

I was born into a Christian family in Kovilpatti, Thoothukudi district. My father worked as a public prosecutor, and my mother retired as a school headmistress. I have one elder sister who is a doctor. From childhood, my only goal was to become a pilot. Whenever someone asked me, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" my answer was always the same—"I want to be a pilot!" That dream shaped my entire outlook on life.

How was your student life and what was the turning point in your youth?

As a child, I was regular to church and obedient to my parents. But from 8th to 10th grade, I became mischievous—spending time with friends, roaming around, skipping tuition

classes, and living like any carefree teenager. My parents provided everything I needed; I lacked nothing. I studied well but had no clear vision beyond following what everyone else did.

Then came a major accident while I was in 10th grade—so severe that the right side of my face was completely damaged. I was bedridden for many days and couldn't attend school. During that recovery period, I began thinking seriously about my future for the first time. I wondered, "If I fail my exams, what will happen to my life?" Fear gripped me—but it also led me closer to God.

I started reading the Bible regularly and developed a hunger to know more about Jesus. I began joining our family prayers and slowly returned to a disciplined lifestyle. That was when I realized how essential prayer was and how important it is to live close to Christ. That experience became the turning point of my life.

What steps did you take to pursue your dream of becoming a pilot?

During my 10th grade, I completely surrendered my life to Jesus and made prayer a daily habit. As I prayed more, I began to understand what I should and shouldn't do. After finishing school, I started researching

how to become a pilot—but I had no one to guide me. No one in my family or among my friends had any connection with aviation.

So, I completed a Diploma in Electrical and Electronics Engineering (EEE) first. Then I told my father about my desire to pursue aviation. He began inquiring everywhere and finally found an institute in Chennai. I enrolled in a Flight Dispatch course, only to discover later that it wasn't a requirement for becoming a pilot. That was a huge disappointment—but I didn't give up.

I kept praying earnestly, seeking Jesus more passionately than before. And God opened the next door—an opportunity to join a Pilot Training Academy. Even there, I faced several challenges and setbacks. Every stage of my journey was marked by struggles, but I pressed on without quitting.

You didn't give up! Was the training enough to reach your goal?

As I drew closer to Jesus, I became firm in prayer—asking Him persistently to make me a pilot. God began showing me what steps to take and

what to avoid. Following His guidance, I went to New Zealand to study. Life there wasn't easy; I faced several difficulties abroad.

In the middle of my studies, I got shocking news—my father had fallen seriously ill. I was torn. Should I continue my course or return home? If I went back, my dream would end. With a heavy heart, I prayed earnestly. I also requested my church friends in New Zealand to pray for my father. Slowly, he began to recover! That built my faith even stronger, and I learned to depend completely on prayer. Through constant prayer and faith, God began doing amazing things. I successfully completed my studies and returned to India in 2019.

After so many struggles, you finally returned to India. Did you get a job right away?

(Smiling) No, not at all! I had made a firm decision—I would only work if it was as a pilot. I prayed persistently, but months passed without any answers. Those months were filled with hardships. Then, another tragedy struck—my father passed away in August 2019. I was shattered. My sister was still unmarried, and I didn't know what to do next. Though I had finished my studies, I was unemployed and confused. As the only son, I had to take responsibility for the family and move us forward. Through continuous prayer, God helped me arrange my sister's wedding successfully in 2022. That was purely by God's grace—it happened because of prayer alone!

How did your career and calling take shape after that?

During that season, I visited Nalumavadi, where I met Mohan Uncle and Panneer



Selvam Uncle. While talking to them, they advised me, “You shouldn’t just sit idle after finishing your studies. Whatever opportunity God gives, take it. Keep moving forward.” Their words really struck me. After praying about it, I felt peace in my heart. Following God’s guidance, I began working at an Aviation College in Chennai as an Administrative Officer and Assistant Professor for two years. Before starting work, I had already planned several projects. When I presented one of them to a few companies, a group of people approached me to start a new business together. That’s how ARK 27 Aviation Academy was born—‘ARK’ referring to Noah’s Ark.

That’s amazing! So, what exactly is ARK 27 Aviation Academy, and how is it doing now?

ARK 27 Aviation Academy is a pilot training academy designed to help aspiring pilots. When I was studying, I had no mentor to guide me, and I faced countless difficulties. My goal is to ensure that the next generation doesn’t face the same struggles I did.



Today, the academy supports students in pursuing their dreams in aviation. God, who once found me stubbornly chasing after the dream of becoming a pilot, has now lifted me to a place where I work with a team that even owns aircrafts! It’s purely the Lord’s doing.

Finally, what would you like to tell today’s youth?

Dear young people, whenever you make a decision, put God first. When you do that, He will perform wonders in your life. Never be lazy or give up easily. When failure comes, don’t stop there—move forward with determination.

God will surely lift you up when you keep working hard and stay humble in His hands. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom—and that’s the verse I still hold on to.

When you give God the first place, He will exalt you in your studies, your career, and every area of your life!

I Come Quickly!

Just as He turned bitter water into sweet, He can turn your pain into peace today.

A True Story

How Do You Receive This Miracle?

Look at the tree! When the water at Marah was bitter, Moses cried out to God. God showed him a tree. Moses threw the tree into the water — and the water became sweet! That tree had the power to transform bitterness into sweetness. That same "tree" stands near your life today. Look at it — and your bitterness will change! That tree represents the cross of Jesus Christ — the cross on which He shed His blood for you. Look to the cross, and your bitterness will turn to sweetness!

Dear Young Friend,

When life feels bitter and painful, when disappointment clouds your heart - look to the Cross. Jesus tasted bitterness on that Cross so your life could be filled with sweetness. Are you thinking, "Why should I live? It would be better if I died?" Then look at the Cross! There you'll find your answer.

I Am a Prayer Warrior!

The Prayer Life of Jesus

Jesus Christ — though equal with the Father in heaven - when He came to earth in human form, was constantly found in prayer. Just as He set an example in everything, He also left us a powerful model for a life of prayer. Let's explore how Jesus prayed and how His prayer life became our ultimate example.

1. Evening Prayer

“After sending the crowds away, He went up on a mountainside by Himself to pray. When evening came, He was there alone.” (Matthew 14:23)

Even after spending the whole day ministering among people, Jesus intentionally chose moments of solitude — to commune deeply with His Father. What a model for us to follow!

2. Early Morning Prayer

“Before daybreak the next morning, Jesus got up and went out to an isolated place to pray.” (Mark 1:35)

He obeyed the Word that says, **“Those who seek Me early will find Me”** (Proverbs 8:17). Spending the first moments of His day with the Father was His daily habit.

3. All-Night Prayer

“One day, Jesus went up on a mountain to pray, and He prayed to God all night.” (Luke 6:12)

Before choosing His twelve disciples, Jesus spent the entire night in prayer — showing us that major decisions must always be soaked in prayer.

4. Prayer on the Mountain

“After leaving the crowds, He went up on the mountain to pray.” (Mark 6:46)



Even after performing the great miracle of feeding five thousand, Jesus didn't stay satisfied with success — He withdrew to pray. Solitude strengthens our connection with God.

5. Prayer in the Wilderness

“But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed.” (Luke 5:16)

Before facing Satan's temptations, He fasted and prayed for forty days. Prayer in solitude refuels spiritual strength.

6. Prayer with His Disciples

“Once, when Jesus was praying in private and His disciples were with Him...” (Luke 9:18)

Before going to the cross, He prayed for His disciples — asking that their faith would remain strong. He valued praying with them as much as for them

7. Fervent Prayer

“Being in agony, He prayed more earnestly, and His sweat was like drops of blood falling to the ground” (Luke 22:44). In Gethsemane, even while facing the agony of the cross, Jesus surrendered to the Father's will through passionate, heartfelt prayer.

8. Persistent Prayer

“My Father, if this cup cannot be taken away unless I drink it, may Your will be done.” He prayed the same thing three times” (Matthew 26:42, 44). Jesus prayed repeatedly for the same matter, teaching us that persistence in prayer reflects our submission to God's will.

9. Prayer in Total Surrender

“He fell with His face to the ground and prayed, ‘Not my will, but Yours be done’” (Matthew 26:39).

By falling face down, Jesus displayed complete surrender — emptying Himself before the Father.

10. Prayer with Tears and Crying Out

“During His life on earth, Jesus offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears.” (Hebrews 5:7)

He wept as He prayed for Lazarus' death and Jerusalem's coming destruction — showing how deeply He carried others in prayer.

Dear Young Friends,

When we look closely at the life of Jesus, we realize that the secret behind His power was His prayer life!

He preached to crowds, performed miracles, and fed thousands — yet, through it all, He spent His best moments in prayer, aligning every step with the Father's will.

☞ Before you grab your phone in the morning — will you reach out to God first?

☞ Before making big decisions — are you ready to pray through the night?

☞ Will you turn your worries and tears into powerful prayers?

☞ Will you build the habit of talking to God in solitude?

Jesus once asked His disciples, “Couldnt you stay awake with Me for even one hour?”* (Matthew 26:40). Today, that same question is directed at you and me. From today, dedicate yourself to take your prayer life to the next level.

☞ Turn your room into a prayer room.

☞ Turn your lonely moments into God moments.

☞ Turn your tears into powerful prayers.

Then, like Jesus, you too will stand strong in God's will — living every day with divine strength and victory!

THE TABERNACLE

Acacia Wood (Shittim Wood)

The Lord specifically commanded that Shittim (Acacia) wood be used in constructing the Tabernacle. In Exodus chapters 37 and 38, we read that the Ark of the Covenant, the table, the poles, the upright boards of the dwelling place, the pillars, the altar, and the incense altar were all made of this wood. Acacia wood is incredibly durable—it can last for more than 4,000 years without decaying or being affected by insects or rust.

The Acacia tree grows up to 12 feet tall and has thorns on every part—its leaves, branches, and trunk. These aren't small thorns; each one can grow up to six inches long. When the wind blows, the tree's own thorns scratch and tear its bark. In the desert, where water is scarce, this wounding releases a small amount of liquid sap, helping the tree survive. Over time, this process makes the tree's wood extremely strong and hard—the more the thorns break, the stronger it becomes.

If your life right now feels like that tree—surrounded by pain, thorns, struggles, and curses—don't be discouraged. The Lord is preparing you to be used for something special and sacred.

Gold, Silver, and Bronze

The Tabernacle's furniture was made using gold, silver, and bronze.

The Tabernacle was built for the Lord to dwell among His people and for the priests to serve Him. Both the Tabernacle and the priests belonged entirely to God. The Lord Himself gave Moses detailed instructions on how to build the Tabernacle and what materials to use. This month, let's look at some of those materials and their spiritual significance.



Gold was mainly used for the furnishings inside the Holy Place. Over one ton of gold was freely given by the people. Gold is formed from ordinary earth—purified and refined by intense heat. In Scripture, gold represents purity and holiness. Only what has been cleansed and purified is fit to be used for God's purpose.



Pure Gold

Pure gold (or refined gold) is even more valuable than ordinary gold. Because of its superior quality, God commanded that pure gold be used for making the Ark of the Covenant, the Mercy Seat, the Cherubim, the lampstand, the incense utensils, the ash pans, bowls, cups, pitchers for drink offerings, and tongs.

To make pure gold, it must be refined twice—heated to about 1,500°C and melted again and again until every impurity is removed. God does the same work in our lives. He doesn't just want us to be "gold"—He wants us to become pure gold. That's why He allows repeated trials, tests, and hardships in our life and ministry—not to destroy us, but to refine us.



So don't be troubled. God will never allow you to be tested beyond your strength. Every fire you walk through is shaping you into something precious in His sight.

Badger Skin (Protective Covering)

In Exodus 26:14, God instructed that the badger skin be used as an outer covering for the Tabernacle to protect it. Not a single drop of water could pass through it. Scholars say this material was made from the inner layer of dolphin skin—thick, coarse, and unattractive to look at.

In the same way, Jesus bore all shame and suffering on the Cross to protect us. As Isaiah 52:14 says, "His appearance was so disfigured

beyond that of any human being." He endured disgrace so that we could live under divine protection and not be harmed.

Blue and Scarlet Yarn

The blue and scarlet threads used in the Tabernacle came from a tiny sea creature—a kind of snail or shellfish found in the Red Sea. When both young and mature snails were boiled in water, they released a natural dye. The young snail produced a light blue color, while the mature one gave a deep scarlet shade. This small creature is extremely delicate—it dies if the salinity of the water increases or decreases even slightly. Though considered insignificant by human eyes, it produced something of great worth. Similarly, those who seem small or insignificant in the eyes of the world are precious and chosen in the eyes of God.

The Bible says in 1 Corinthians 1:27–28: "God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. God chose the lowly things of this world and the things that are despised—to nullify the things that are."

The Tabernacle wasn't just a structure—it was a message. Every piece, every color, every material told a story about God's holiness, His protection, His refining power, and His love. The same God who designed the Tabernacle is shaping you and me into living temples where His presence can dwell.

Let's allow Him to refine, cover, and strengthen us—until we, like the pure gold of the Tabernacle, reflect His glory.

I'm 30 years old, born and raised in a Christian family. My parents have been looking for a bride for me since I was 26. They run a business and we're fairly well-off, so they've been searching for someone who matches our status. But one day, at a youth meeting, I heard something that shook my heart. The preacher said, "A true Christian should never take dowry. Don't pray for wealth, beauty, or luxury — pray for a woman who loves Jesus, who prays, and who has experienced salvation." Those words pierced deep into me. Right there, I made a decision. I told my parents, "I don't want to marry for dowry. A godly, prayerful woman with a redeemed heart is far more precious than riches or beauty. Only such a woman can run a family with divine wisdom and live in a way that pleases God." But my parents disagreed. They said, "If we don't accept dowry, people will think something's wrong with our son. For our status, it's not a sin to take it." Their words hurt me deeply. It pains me that they think about money, status, and comfort every day while I long for something purer. My marriage plans keep getting delayed, and I honestly don't know what to do.

Dear brother Richard, I truly understand your pain and the burden of standing firm in your decision. I praise God for the beautiful conviction you've made.

When it comes to marriage, what God expects is very different from what people expect. God's plan is for a husband and wife to fulfill His purpose together — to be a Christ-centered family that blesses many others.

He desires that godly offspring arise, children who live out His will. For that, both the bride and groom must be saved, prayerful, and united in Jesus, building a joyful home with Him at the center.



Sadly, in our society, the focus has shifted. People chase a good job, high salary, a rich family background, physical beauty, and a certain amount of gold jewelry. These things may have their place, but when they become the main priority instead of godly character, marriages end up broken — in divorce courts, police stations, or tragic deaths due to dowry abuse and pride.

Every day, the news and TV channels report shocking stories — not just among poor or middle-class families, but even among the wealthy.

The dowry system continues to claim the lives of many young women. Society justifies it, saying, “We didn’t ask for dowry; her parents gave it out of respect.

If we refuse, it’ll look insulting.” But that’s a dangerous lie. Just like untouchability and caste discrimination, dowry is another social evil that needs to end — and only courageous decisions like yours can start the change.

***If you stand firm in your decision,
here’s what can happen:***

- ▶ Your family or relatives might mock or oppose you — but seeing your integrity, they’ll eventually understand and change their hearts.
- ▶ Many young men will be inspired by your stand and make the same commitment, bringing a real end to this dowry plague.
- ▶ The Christian community will awaken and free itself from this sinful practice.

▶ Countless young women, rich and poor alike, who are now suffering under this system, will finally get a chance to live with dignity and joy.

▶ Through young men like you, God will establish marriages that reflect His will - and not only will people on earth rejoice, but heaven itself will celebrate!

***Perhaps you compromise and
agree to take dowry...***

- ▶ You’ll carry guilt, knowing you acted against God’s will and your own conviction.
- ▶ Instead of a godly life partner, you might end up with someone who loves the world, money, and temporary pleasure - leading to conflict and confusion.
- ▶ Prioritizing worldly gain over divine purpose may cause your family to drift from God’s plan, facing unnecessary pain and hardship.

***As the Bible says,
“Do not conform to the pattern
of this world, but be transformed
by the renewing of your mind, that
you may discern what is the good,
pleasing, and perfect will of God”
(Romans 12:2).***

***So think and act wisely — will you go

Rocket Man!

My heartfelt greetings to all the young achievers! Most of the time, when we have some kind of weakness, disability, or sickness, we keep repeating it to ourselves until we convince our minds that success is impossible. But there are a few rare people who take their weaknesses as the starting point of victory—and rise far above them. Today, let's look at the incredible life of one such achiever.

THE BOY WHO REFUSED TO GIVE UP

Gabrielzinho was born in 2002, in Santa Rita do Sapucaí, Brazil. He was born with a rare congenital condition called Phocomelia. (Phocomelia is a rare birth defect in which the limbs—arms or legs—are extremely shortened and directly attached to the body, with the middle segments missing.) Because of this, Gabriel was born without arms, and his legs were very small and underdeveloped. Many who saw him thought, “This child can never live a normal life like others.”

He grew up facing the double challenge of poverty and physical disability. Even simple daily tasks were difficult for him. Yet, through all this, his mother never lost hope. She firmly believed, “My son will not only live a normal life—he will live an extraordinary one.” With that unshakable faith, she raised him with endless encouragement and love.

LEARNING TO SWIM WITHOUT ARMS

Though he had no arms, Gabriel learned to swim when he was just four or five years old. At thirteen, something surprising happened. Without telling him, his school's physical education teacher entered his name in a swimming competition. To everyone's astonishment—including his own—Gabriel won three gold medals in that competition! That was the first step in his journey to greatness. From that moment, his passion for swimming only grew. Even though it seemed impossible for someone without arms to swim, Gabriel found a unique way—using his waist and legs to glide through the water like a dolphin.



TRAINING LIKE A CHAMPION

Gabriel began training at the Cruzeiro Sports Club, one of Brazil's most famous clubs. The athletes and coaches there gave him incredible support and encouragement. He practiced for hours every day, six days a week, strengthening his body and perfecting his skills. Small victories boosted his confidence, while big dreams pushed him forward.

FROM LOCAL CHAMPION TO WORLD HERO

- ◀ In 2019, at the Parapan American Games held in Peru, Gabriel made his nation proud by winning gold, silver, and bronze medals for Brazil.
- ◀ Then, at the 2020 Tokyo Paralympics, he rose to international fame, winning two gold medals and one silver medal.
- ◀ By the 2024 Paris Paralympics, Gabriel was unstoppable. He won three gold medals and earned the nickname "Rocket Man." In the Men's S2 200m Freestyle, he completed the race in 3 minutes and 58.92 seconds, clinching the gold medal. He also dominated the 100m and 50m Backstroke events, adding more medals to his name.



Today, Gabrielzinho stands tall as a world-famous Paralympic star. Alongside his athletic career, he's also pursuing a degree in Journalism—proving that his hunger for achievement extends far beyond the swimming pool. His next goal? The 2028 Los Angeles Paralympics.

The True Definition of Strength

Dear friends, Remember this: a physical disability is not a barrier—lack of determination is. Gabriel couldn't perform even the simplest tasks that most of us take for granted. But instead of complaining, he chose courage. Instead of self-pity, he chose strength. Today, he's celebrated around the world as a symbol of motivation and resilience. So, think deeply for a moment — where is your limitation? Is it in your body... or in your mind?

LOT'S WIFE —THE ONE WHO WASN'T PREPARED!

Lot and his family lived together with Abraham in the land of Canaan. One day Abraham said,

"There isn't enough land here for both our herds to graze. If you go one way, I'll go the other." So Lot chose the lush plains of the Jordan, where water and grass were plenty, and later settled near the city of Sodom. But the people of Sodom were wicked, and Lot's heart was deeply troubled by the sin around him. Even God was grieved and decided to destroy the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah. He sent two angels to warn Lot and his family to leave immediately. But they lingered — wasting precious time. So the angels grabbed their hands and led them outside the city, saying, "Run for your lives! Don't look back!" Lot and his daughters obeyed and ran quickly - they were ready to move when God spoke. REVIVAL SEEDS

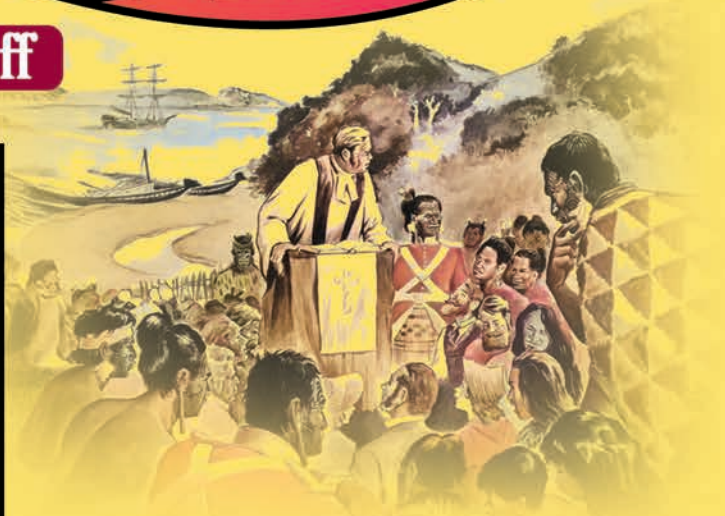
Alexander Duff

The people who sowed the seeds of revival long ago gave their very lives for the sake of souls—without expecting comfort, fame, or reward.

Most young people today may not even know their names. That's why, over the past nine months, under the theme "Seeds of Revival," we've been learning about men and women who dedicated their lives to Christ.

Last month, we studied the life of Robert Morrison, the missionary who bravely asked God for the most difficult field in the world. He served for 25 years in China—a land that strictly opposed the open preaching of the Gospel. There, he became the first to translate the Bible into

Chinese, placing the imperishable Word of Christ into the hands of the Chinese people. This month, let's look at another missionary who came to India in the 18th century with a divine vision—one who reached out to the high-caste communities and led them to listen to the Gospel — Alexander Duff.



Alexander Duff: A Vision for the Educated Elite

Alexander Duff was born on April 25, 1806, in Scotland. He earned degrees in both Biblical Studies and Science from St. Andrews University. Around 1820, a wave of revival and missionary passion swept across Scotland like wildfire. During this time, Duff encountered the Lord personally and, at just 23 years old, dedicated his life to missionary service. In 1829, the Church of Scotland appointed him as its first missionary. That same year, he married Anne Duff, and together they prepared to sail to India with a new vision—to reach the intellectual and high-caste communities of Calcutta with the message of Christ.

Unshaken by Loss

During their voyage to India in 1830, the couple faced two shipwrecks. In one of them, Duff lost all his books, certificates, and personal belongings—everything he had. But he refused

to give up. Strengthened by faith, he continued his journey to India undeterred. Once he arrived, Duff set out to fulfill his God-given vision: to blend Western education and Biblical truth, teaching English, science, and the Scriptures side by side. Through this method, he sought to open the eyes of India's intellectual elite—breaking the chains of superstition and showing them that Jesus Christ is the true Savior.

A Revolutionary Method

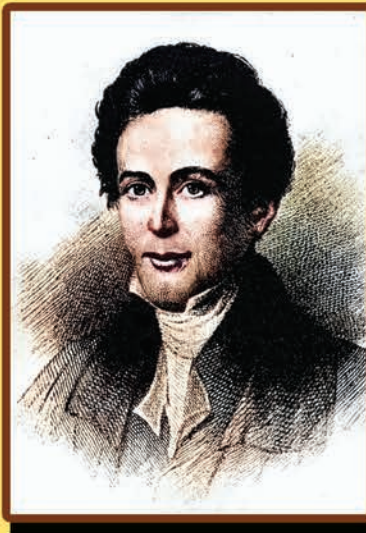
Before Duff's arrival, the upper-caste and wealthy classes in India showed little interest in the Gospel. While the poor and lower-caste people of rural villages were open and responsive, the educated elite remained distant and sceptical. Duff firmly believed that Christianity could take deep root in India only when it reached the hearts and minds of these influential groups. Even though many missionaries and educational leaders of his time criticized his vision, Duff remained steadfast. Within just a few months of arriving in India, he opened a small English school under a banyan tree—starting with only five students. Within one week, the number grew to 300 students! Many young men from upper-caste Bengali families showed great enthusiasm to learn.

Although the curriculum included Western arts, science, and English, Christian teaching was the foundation and focus of the entire program. Each day began with prayer, Bible reading, and explanation of Scripture. The Bible itself was included as a core subject in the school's syllabus. Within just three years, four students openly accepted Christ and were baptized.

From One School to a Movement

Some students, frightened by these conversions, left the school—but many others came seeking

truth. God Himself brought earnest learners to Duff's institution. By the tenth year, the school had over 800 students. In a time when people asked, "Why should women study?" Duff boldly opened a separate school for high-caste women. This pioneering move attracted several wealthy young ladies to education and to faith. Over the years, thousands of students passed through his schools. Among the educated and influential who came under his ministry, 33 high-caste individuals publicly accepted Christ and followed Him. Though small in number, this group had an enormous impact on Indian society. Many became missionaries, pastors, and strong pillars of the Church. This was the lasting fruit of Alexander Duff's ministry.



A Legacy That Sparked a Movement

Duff became one of the most successful and eloquent missionaries of his century—a true Missionary Orator. He traveled extensively across England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales, and America, passionately raising prayer and financial support for the mission field. His pioneering approach of combining education with evangelism became a model that spread across the entire world. Inspired by his work, over 100 young people dedicated themselves to serve overseas as missionaries.

A Call to Our Generation

Dear young friends, Alexander Duff followed the vision God gave him—to share the Gospel among the rich and the educated, leading many to Christ. Today, as urbanization continues to rise and education becomes a central focus for modern parents and students, what is our mission strategy?

If God were to call us—like Alexander Duff—to reach the educated, the urban, and the influential with the Gospel, would we be willing to answer His call?

Cancer Cases in India Have Risen by 26% Since 1990!

The rate of cancer cases in India has increased by 26% since 1990, according to a study published in the medical journal *The Lancet*. The findings reveal that cancer incidence in India has risen over the past 33 years.

In 1990, the number of cancer cases was **84.8 per 100,000 people**, while in 2023 it has climbed to 107.2 per **100,000**. Similarly, deaths caused by cancer have also risen by **21%** during this period. In contrast, both **the United States and China** have witnessed a significant decline in cancer incidence and mortality over the same 33-year span.

Commenting on this, **Dr. Abhishek Shankar**, a cancer specialist at **AIIMS, New Delhi**, stated:

“The key reason for the decline in cancer cases and deaths in the U.S. and China is their strong tobacco control laws, universal vaccination, and well-organized cancer screening programs.” He further explained that India faces greater risk factors, including **high tobacco consumption, obesity, and infectious diseases**, while **early detection of cancer** remains considerably low.

“Therefore, India must urgently strengthen its strategies to prevent and control cancer,” he emphasized.

TCS to Offer Up to Two Years' Salary for Employees Laid Off!

Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) currently employs around **613,000** people. Recently, the company announced that by 2026, it plans to reduce its workforce by **2%**, which amounts to approximately **12,000** employees. Reports indicate that employees affected by the layoffs will receive **advance notice**, and depending on their years of service, they will be offered **compensation ranging from six months to two years of salary**.

Those who have been **without a project for more than eight months** will receive a **smaller compensation package**, while employees with **10 to 15 years of service** will receive **18 months' salary**. Those who have worked for **over 15 years** may receive **up to 24 months' salary** as compensation. In addition, TCS has announced that it will **assist laid-off employees in finding new job opportunities**. For those nearing retirement age, the company will facilitate **voluntary retirement schemes (VRS)** to ensure a smoother transition.
