
My dear young son/daughter, if you ask, God is able to give you even nations. You are the generation of Joshua—carry a heart that is ready to inherit every territory God has promised.

Lost, Found, and Fully Used!!

In a world where many ministers strive to gain popularity and recognition, it is rare to find those who passionately long for the fullness of God's presence to be revealed through their lives. Today, we are about to hear the powerful life testimony of one such servant—someone whose ministry allows God's presence to flow through the songs he carries. Songs are not merely written; they are divinely inspired.

Beyond delivering these God-given songs to people, he also faithfully serves as a shepherd to the church. Let us now listen as Pastor David Sam Joyson himself shares his journey of faith, calling, and grace.

Tell us about your childhood and family background!

I was born as the fifth son to Pastor Joyson and Sister Lizzy Bai in the Kanyakumari (Nagercoil) district. I have three elder brothers and one elder sister. My second brother is Johnsam Joyson. Even before I was born, an angel appeared to my mother and told her that a child named David would be born—according to God's promise, I came into this world.

Being raised in a pastor's family, I was nurtured in spiritual disciplines from a very young age. I started playing the tabla when I was just four

years old. My parents bought me a tabla early on and encouraged me to play in church. Until the 10th grade, we were brought up with a healthy balance of both spiritual growth and worldly education.

Being from a pastor's family, people assume you were always very spiritual. How was your youth life really?

While I was studying in the 10th grade, all my friends were getting baptized. I thought, "If I don't get baptized, people will talk—after all, I'm a pastor's son." So, I joined them and got baptized, but I hadn't yet experienced true salvation.

After that, I slowly began to drift away spiritually. I couldn't focus on my studies. I spent money generously on food for friends, but I didn't have any serious bad habits.

I was active in church and did all the responsibilities assigned to me, yet there was no real relationship between God and me.

By the time



I reached the 12th grade, I had backslidden badly. I passed my board exams with very low marks—not because of my efforts, but purely because of my parents' prayers. Since I had switched to English medium only in the 11th grade, studies felt extremely difficult. As everyone in my family pursued engineering, I did the same and joined a BE course in a college I somehow managed to get into with my marks.

How did you experience true salvation during college?

Up until my third year of college, my life was still in a backslidden state. One day, a close friend sat me down and asked,

"David, do you even realize the path you're on? Do you know whose son you are? Do you understand what God has planned for your life?"

He had advised me many times before, but nothing ever moved me. That day was different. My heart broke. Tears began to flow uncontrollably. After speaking, he simply said, "David, take care of your life. God loves you," and walked away.

I couldn't stop crying. I went to my room, fell on my knees, and cried out, "Lord, forgive me." That day—when I fully surrendered my life to God—was the day I truly experienced salvation. I went to my parents and asked for their forgiveness.



Until my fifth semester, I had failed papers. But after surrendering my life to God, I passed all my subjects. From that moment, my spiritual life began to transform. Even before completing my final year, God called me into ministry.

Amazing! Did you immediately step into ministry after receiving the call?

No. Honestly, I wanted to work in a job first. During that season, while traveling to Kerala with my father, the Lord spoke to me clearly:

"I have chosen you, and I will be glorified through you."

On our way back, I asked God for a sign. I prayed that I would attend interviews, receive an appointment order, and then step into ministry. Just as I prayed, in an interview attended by 60 candidates—where only 5 were to be selected—I made it through all the rounds. Even though others were more skilled and fluent in English, I received the appointment order for a job in Bangalore.

The moment I held that letter in my hands, I surrendered it back to God, committed myself fully to ministry, and joined Bible college for three years.

Wonderful! Tell us about your ministry journey

In the beginning, I traveled with my father for ministry and occasionally sang songs. Later, I served alongside my brother. During the lockdown season, God began to use me in a



greater way. By His grace, I had opportunities to minister alongside well-known servants of God.

Currently, I serve as a pastor at Full Gospel Pentecostal Church. In 2016, God gave me the song “Vittuk Kodukkaadhavar” (The One Who Never Let Go). Songs like “I surrendered



myself saying I can do nothing—Lord, work miracles in our lives” followed. As testimonies began pouring in through these songs, my faith and strength grew even more. God’s name alone was glorified.

Please share about your married life!

Alice and I got married in 2016. For the first year, we didn’t think much about having children. Later, certain words spoken by people deeply hurt us—especially my wife. We were aware of our physical condition, but God’s promise, “I will bless your descendants,” strengthened us.


My wife prayed with unwavering faith. In July 2022, God blessed us with a baby boy, Isaac Sam Joyson, proving that He is faithful to His word. Today, we are blessed with two sons and one daughter. Just as He promised, God continues to bless our generation and use our family for His glory.

What message would you like to share with young people?

Youth is the most crucial season to spend quality time with God. When you surrender yourself completely to Him during this phase, He will use you powerfully.

If God could forgive, restore, and use someone like me—who lived a life displeasing to Him even as a pastor’s son—then no matter where you are today, no matter how far you’ve drifted, God is ready to forgive you, accept you, and use you.

Dear young friends, the same God who transformed David Sam through a friend’s word, called him into ministry, and made him a pastor and worship leader today, can do the same for you. If you feel broken, useless, or unqualified—surrender your life to Jesus. He will never hand you over to anyone else. He will take you into His hands and make your life count!

Since 2009,

Valibar Ulagam has been published as a **monthly youth magazine**, reaching young people through both print and digital platforms. Nearly **19,000** copies are printed every month in **Tamil, English, Hindi, and Malayalam** and delivered **through post** to the homes of youth.

The magazine is also made available online in **Telugu** and **Kannada**, with over **1,000** readers downloading and benefiting from it each month.

From **2025** onward, by God's grace, the magazine has also been uploaded in the **Bengali** language.

We are prayerfully planning to expand into two more languages this year, trusting God to help us reach even more young lives with His message.



Ask, Seek, Knock!

Promise Message:
Mohan C. Lazars

Whenever we pray holding on to the promise the Lord Jesus Christ gives us for a particular year, He remains eternally faithful to release the blessings of that promise into our lives.

For the year 2025, the Lord promised, "Do not be afraid! I, the Lord, will come to you and bless you" (Exodus 20:24). As I witnessed countless testimonies of how the Lord personally visited people and performed miracles exactly as He promised, my heart overflowed with praise to God.

As I waited in God's presence with fasting for the promise of the year 2026, the Lord spoke clearly: "If you ask Me, I will give it to you. If you seek Me with a thirsty heart, I will reveal Myself to you. If you knock on the door of My heart, it will be opened to you" (Matthew 7:7). Let us meditate on these three truths embedded in the promise God has given us for this year.

ASK – AND IT WILL BE GIVEN TO YOU

"Ask, and it will be given to you" (Matthew 7:7).

When some people come to me for prayer and I ask, "What should I pray for?", a few remain silent. If they do not speak, how can one know their need and pray? Others say, "God already knows everything." Yes, God knows your needs even before you ask—but He still desires that you ask Him.

When Jesus walked the earth doing good, a blind man named Bartimaeus sat by the roadside begging. Hearing that Jesus was passing by, he cried out loudly, "Jesus, Son of David!" Jesus stopped and asked, "What do you want Me to do for you?" When Bartimaeus replied, "Lord, I want to see," Jesus performed a miracle and restored his sight instantly (Mark 10:46–52).

God knows everything, yet He expects us to express the desires of our hearts before Him. That is why the Lord Himself says, "Ask, and it will be given to you."

- **Two blind men cried out, "Son of David, have mercy on us!" and they received their sight (Matthew 9:27–30).**
- **A man afflicted with leprosy received miraculous healing (Matthew 8:2–3).**
- **A centurion's servant was healed (Matthew 8:5–13).**



- **A Canaanite woman's daughter was completely delivered from demonic bondage (Matthew 15:22–28).**
- **A boy tormented by an evil spirit was set free (Matthew 17:14–18). In the same way, when you ask in the name of Jesus Christ with faith, the Lord will surely perform miracles for you.**

There was a deeply religious man who did not know Jesus. For nearly 15 years, he and his wife lived without a child, crushed by ridicule, humiliation, and emotional pain. Despite spending vast amounts of money on treatments and placing their hope in many gods, nothing changed. When despair overtook them, they heard about Jesus and began watching the program “Come, Let Us Pray.”

One day, during a prayer for the fruit of the womb, the husband and wife wept together and prayed, “Jesus, give us a child whom we will raise for You.” The Lord heard their prayer and blessed them with a child. Their sorrow turned into joy; their shame, pain, and disappointment vanished, replaced by overwhelming happiness.

The same Lord is ready to perform miracles for you today. Ask Him in faith, for Jesus Himself has said, “Everyone who asks receives” (Matthew 7:8; Luke 11:10).

SEEK – AND YOU WILL FIND

“Seek, and you will find” (Matthew 7:7).

The Lord says, “You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all your heart... I will be found by you” (Jeremiah 29:13–14).

In 2 Chronicles 7:14, the Lord says, “Seek My face.” Often, we seek only God’s blessings—what His hands can give. But more than the blessings, we must seek the Lord Himself, the One who gives them.

Daniel testified, “I turned to the Lord God and pleaded with Him in prayer and fasting” (Daniel 9:3).

It is true that God meets people. When we seek Him with our whole heart, He reveals Himself. But this requires preparation—a thirsty heart, sincere longing, and a selfless pursuit of God. Then the Lord will surely make Himself known.

A young man from Ramanathapuram in Tamil Nadu, though born into a Christian family, lived without faith and joined an atheistic movement. His life was consumed by alcohol and smoking. One day, Jesus Christ encountered him and revealed Himself personally. Instantly, the joy of salvation filled his heart, and he received permanent deliverance from sinful habits.

One day, the young man shut himself inside a room and cried out with deep longing, “No matter how long it takes, I must see the Lord!” With fasting and hours of prayer, he sought God with all his heart.

Suddenly, a brilliant light filled the room. In the midst of the light stood a radiant figure like lightning. As he gazed intently, Jesus Christ appeared to him in a vision, revealed Himself, and even anointed him as a prophet. That young man is today our beloved brother, Prophet Vincent Selvakumar, powerfully serving the Lord.

If we too seek the Lord with all our heart, we will find Him. Jesus Christ came to this earth to reveal God the Father to us. Therefore, we can see Him, encounter Him, and even hear His voice.



KNOCK – AND THE DOOR WILL BE OPENED

“Knock, and it will be opened to you” (Matthew 7:7).

Today the Lord says to you, “My child, if you knock, it will be opened to you.”

Jesus illustrated this truth with a parable. A man went to his friend’s house at midnight and knocked on the door, saying, “A friend of mine has arrived hungry, and I have nothing to give him. Please lend me three loaves of bread.”

Though the friend replied, “Do not disturb me. The door is locked, my children are asleep, and I cannot get up,” yet because of the man’s persistent pleading, he got up and gave him what he needed (Luke 11:5–8).

In the same way, if you knock, the door will be opened—not only for you, but for your friends, relatives, neighbors, village, city, and even your nation. Interceding for others is a great privilege and deeply pleasing to the Lord.

The Word of God says, “I urge that petitions, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgiving be made for all people... This is good and pleases God our Savior” (1 Timothy 2:1–3). When we carry the burdens of others and knock on heaven’s door on their behalf, the Lord will surely answer.

Today, the Lord is waiting for your prayer.

When we knock with our whole heart, closed doors will open. As we daily confess God’s promise and pray with thanksgiving, we will experience miracles day after day.

Revival Missionaries

The states of Tamil Nadu and Karnataka have been divided into seven zones, where 38 Revival Missionaries are actively serving. Through their ministry, God is raising many living testimonies.

From February to June 2024, these missionaries were trained, and from July 2024 to November 2025, they visited 180 villages across seven zones, sharing the Gospel with 71,536 people. 




Come, Let Us Pray!

Two months ago, 25 Christians were killed by terrorists in Nigeria. Let us cry out to God that the persecution and killing of Christians in Nigeria may come to an end.

Over the past **10 years**, nearly **1,841,84 lakh children** have gone missing in **Delhi**, and about **50,771 children** are yet to be traced. Children aged **12–18** are the most affected, with **girls accounting for a higher number of missing cases**. Between **January and October 2025 alone**, **14,828 children** were reported missing. Let us pray with burdened hearts for the **safe recovery of these children**.



New Delhi is the most air-polluted city in India. Air pollution in India is caused by **50% industrial emissions, 27% vehicle emissions, 17% crop residue burning, and 7% cooking fuels**. Nearly **1.7 million people** die every year in India due to air pollution. Let us pray for protection from air pollution and for the government to take firm action against industries that emit excessive pollutants.



In a world of **8.2 billion people**, about **1.35 million lives** are lost each year due to **road traffic accidents**, with **India ranking first** in the number of fatalities. Let us pray that road accidents may be completely prevented and that lives may be safeguarded.




In **2025**, earthquakes and natural disasters claimed thousands of lives—**126 in Tibet, 5,456 in Myanmar, over 600 in Afghanistan, 6 in Bangladesh, and 31 in the Philippines**. Let us pray that **God may protect us from such natural calamities this year**.

INTER-STATE MINISTRIES

Juvenile Crime Cases:

Justice Delayed Must Not Become Justice Denied

Shocking data released by the India Justice Report reveals that, as of **October 31, 2023**, more than **50% of over one lakh cases** pending before the **302 Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs)** across India remain unresolved. This information was obtained through nearly **250 Right to Information (RTI) applications** filed with **21 states**. The report highlights serious shortcomings in how the four pillars of the justice system—the **police, prisons, courts, and legal services**—function in matters concerning **child welfare**.



Since children below the age of 18 cannot be imprisoned like adults, **Observation Homes** were established for juveniles in conflict with the law. In the infamous **2012 Nirbhaya gang-rape case**, one of the accused was a juvenile and was sent to an Observation Home before being released, triggering widespread public outrage. This led to significant reforms and the enactment of the **Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015**. The law mandated the establishment of **Juvenile Justice Boards in every district** to ensure speedy trials and timely justice for juvenile offenders. However, even a **decade after the law came into force**, the fact that many children continue to suffer without timely justice demands serious scrutiny. Although **92% of India's 765 districts** now have Juvenile Justice Boards, **disparities in justice delivery** persist. Case pendency is alarmingly high in certain states—**83% in Odisha and 35% in Karnataka**. The report further states that one in four JJBs does not have the full required number of members, and **30% lack proper legal aid arrangements**. As a result, each JJB carries an **average backlog of 154 cases annually**. Inadequate data documentation and **chronic funding shortages** further complicate access to justice for children.

Under the law, juveniles aged **above 16** who are accused of **heinous crimes such as murder or sexual assault** may be tried as adults—but only if the Juvenile Justice Board decides so after due assessment. According to **2023 crime data**, cases were registered against **40,036 juveniles in 31,365 cases** under the Indian Penal Code and special local laws. More than **three-fourths of these juveniles** fall within the **16–18 age group**. With cases piling up before JJBs, the waiting period for justice for these children continues to grow longer. The lack of coordination among justice delivery institutions and negligence in maintaining proper records have severely undermined **juvenile justice**. Addressing these systemic failures without delay—and ensuring **uncompromising standards of child protection and care**—is a paramount responsibility of both the **Union and State governments**. — *November 27, The Hindu Tamil Thisai*.
