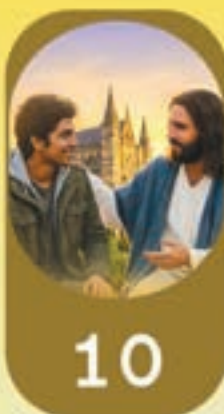

Testimony: William



Today, we are going to meet Ebenezer, a young student from an ordinary family who chose to use the wisdom God gave her from a young age for His glory. As a result, she has excelled academically and is now preparing for the NEET examination with the dream of pursuing a medical career.

I live with my family in my hometown, Pavoorchatram, in Tenkasi district. I am the only daughter of Mr. Asir Jayakumar and Mrs. Jansi Rani. Although my parents came from a traditional Christian background, they did not have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ at that time. However, they raised me with Christian values from my childhood. From a young age, I loved reading Bible verses and singing Christian songs. I actively participated in Bible competitions conducted by churches and won several medals and certificates. By God's grace, I have consistently secured top ranks throughout my academic journey.

You mentioned that your parents came from a Christian background but did not truly know Jesus. Were you Christians only in name?

Yes, you could say that. Because of my father's job, we lived as a family in Tiruppur. We regularly attended a good spiritual church there. However, none of us had experienced true salvation. Later, my mother was the first person in our family to receive the assurance of salvation. From that day onward, she would place her hands on my head and my father's head every





day and pray for us. Through her prayers, we gradually began to understand who Jesus truly is.

Did you accept Jesus immediately after that?

Not immediately. A few months later, my father lost his job due to problems in the company where he was working. As a result, our family had to return to our native village. My mother was deeply saddened because we had to leave both our spiritually strong church and the reputed school where I was studying. But after returning home, God provided us with another good church. But things didn't go as we expected regarding my education. I had to join a local school in our village, which disappointed my mother. However, God spoke to her and said, "I will raise your daughter from a place where nothing seems possible." Believing it was God's will, my parents enrolled me in that school. It was during this season



that my father also accepted Jesus as his personal Saviour. After that, he began working as a daily wage labourer in our hometown.

How was your family situation after accepting Jesus?

We experienced peace in our family, but financially things were very difficult.

My parents struggled to pay my school fees. Once, because the fees had not been paid, I was severely reprimanded at school. I came home heartbroken and cried before God in prayer.

The Lord miraculously provided the money we needed for the fees. That experience strengthened my faith tremendously and taught me to trust God more deeply.

Tell us about your spiritual journey.

During the lockdown period, I began watching the "Come Let's Pray" program and learned the importance of interceding for the nation. I joined the 21-Day Daniel Fasting prayer and spent time seeking God through fasting and prayer. During that period, my friends and I were also involved in Gospel ministry, sharing God's message with others by handing out tracts.





What would you like to say to young people?

Tell us about your academic journey.

I've always loved studying and worked hard in academics. When I was in the eighth grade, I secured first place at the district level in an essay-writing competition. For many years, I struggled with physical health issues and had to take medication regularly. During a prayer meeting held at Nalumavadi, I experienced God's healing touch and received complete deliverance. While studying in the tenth grade, I suffered from low haemoglobin levels. Even climbing up and down stairs would leave me breathless, and I frequently battled fever. It was during that difficult season that I attended the Achievers Meeting held at Prayer Mountain in 2024. There, God spoke to me personally and removed my fears. From then on, I would pray daily, declaring:

"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." During my Tamil and English board examinations, I was severely affected by fever. I had to take tablets and go directly to the examination hall. Yet, even in that situation, God strengthened me and enabled me to score 496 marks in Class 10, securing second place at the district level. By God's grace, I later chose the Maths-Biology group in higher secondary school. During my Class 12 public examinations, I suffered from continuous coughing for nearly two months and struggled to sleep at night. But Jesus delivered me from that as well.

As a result, by God's grace, I scored 564 marks in the Class 12 board examinations in 2026. I am now preparing for the NEET examination and trusting God for the next chapter of my journey.

When we discover God's will and choose to walk in it, the Lord stands with us and grants success in every area of life. Don't allow problems, disappointments, or sickness to discourage you. When you stand passionately for God, He will stand passionately for you during your most difficult moments.

Dedicate yourself wholeheartedly to God and rise up with zeal for His Kingdom!

God's FAVOR *and His Discipline!!*

In today's Christian world, we often tend to focus only on one side of God—His love and compassion. We love to see Him as the loving, merciful Father. Yes, God's love is absolutely real—but so are His discipline and justice.

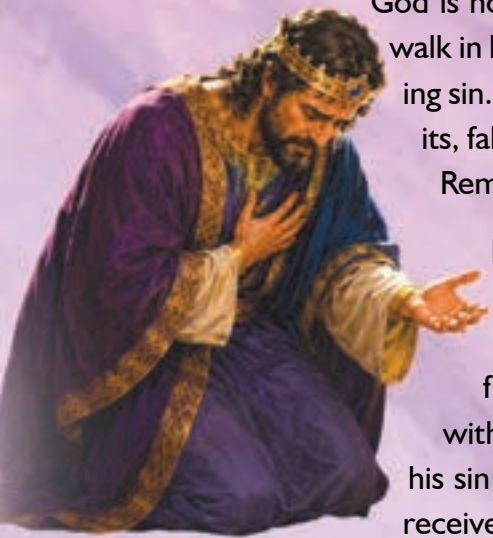
God's unmerited love toward those who are undeserving is what we call His grace. But God being loving does not mean He tolerates sin. God is light, and in Him there is no darkness at all (1 John 1:5). Just as darkness cannot stand before light, sin cannot stand in the presence of holiness. When His grace is misused and people continue to live in sin, His discipline is revealed.



When David was rejected and forgotten by his own family, it was the grace of God that lifted him from tending sheep to sitting on the throne as a king. By the Lord's favor, even when many rose against him, God protected and delivered him in every situation. Though God testified about him saying, **"I have found David son of Jesse, a man**

after **My own heart; he will do everything I want him to do**" (Acts 12:22), when David sinned, God did not overlook it silently. He sent the prophet Nathan to confront him. **"Now, therefore, the sword will never depart from your house, because you despised Me and took the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be your own..."** (2 Samuel 12:10). Because of God's discipline, David's household was never free from conflict, and even his own sons rose against him, bringing deep suffering into his life.

Today, many young people drift away spiritually because they know only one side of God. From childhood, they are taught only about God's love, and slowly a careless mindset grows—"Whatever I do, God will forgive me anyway." But when we truly understand that God is not only gracious but also a righteous Judge, we will learn to walk in holiness. God does not ignore your devotion while overlooking sin. No matter how close you think you are to Him, hidden habits, false relationships, and secret sins will still bring His correction. Remember, He is not a respecter of persons.



Even David, after his sin was exposed, was deeply broken and confessed to Nathan, **"I have sinned against the Lord"** (2 Samuel 12:13). Usually, when people are confronted about their mistakes, they try to defend themselves with excuses. But David, though he was a king, did not hide his sin or justify himself. He simply confessed. Because of that, he received mercy—**"The Lord has taken away your sin; you are not going to die"** (2 Samuel 12:13). You may hide your sins from people, but nothing can be hidden before God. **"Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy"** (Proverbs 28:13).

Dear young friends!
If you think, "Jesus loves me, I am serving Him, so even if I sin secretly, it doesn't matter," then you are deceiving yourself. No matter how great your sin may be, do not harden your heart. Like David, if you humbly confess and turn back in repentance, you will remain in God's grace. But if not, you will face His discipline.



Under Pressure

Hi Friends, How are you all doing? I'm delighted to meet you once again through this month's article.
First of all, Happy World Youth Day!

God has blessed each one of us with unique talents and abilities. Many of us discover those gifts and actively use them, while others struggle with feelings of inadequacy, believing they have no special talent at all. But God desires that every one of us discover the gifts He has placed within us and use them for His glory.

Now, let's take a look at a fascinating and highly respected art form—stone sculpting. Have you ever admired a stone sculpture? In many places, you'll find statues of leaders, animals, birds, and other remarkable figures carved out of stone. But have you ever wondered how a rough stone becomes a masterpiece?

1. Choosing the Stone

The process begins with selecting the right stone. It must be strong and free from cracks or flaws.

Granite and other durable stones are often chosen because they can withstand the test of time.

2. Designing the Sculpture

Before carving begins, the sculptor sketches the design on paper from different angles—front, side, and top views. Then, key outlines are marked onto the stone, indicating where the head, hands, feet, and other features will be formed.



3. The First Cut – Removing the Excess

This stage is often called “knocking out.”

Using a hammer and chisel, the sculptor chips away the unnecessary portions of the stone. Strong, forceful blows remove what doesn't belong, gradually revealing the basic shape hidden within.

4. Shaping the Form

Different types of chisels are then used to shape the sculpture more accurately. The hands, feet, face, and body begin to take form as the sculptor carefully refines the structure.

5. Fine Detailing

This is where the beauty truly emerges.

Small chisels are used to carve intricate details such as the eyes, nose, mouth, ears, and even the folds of clothing. Every delicate touch adds character and life to the sculpture.



6. Smoothing and Polishing

Even after carving is complete, the sculpture still appears rough.

The surface is gradually smoothed using abrasive stones and sandpaper of different grades. Finally, it is polished until the stone shines brilliantly.

Did you notice, friends, how much pressure and pain a stone must endure before becoming a beautiful sculpture?

The very first step involves removing everything that does not belong. The hammer strikes hard. The chisel cuts deep. Yet those painful blows are not meant to destroy the stone—they are meant to transform it into the masterpiece the sculptor envisioned.

Just as a sculptor carefully chooses a particular stone capable of enduring the process, God has chosen us with a purpose. He knows that even through difficult circumstances, painful seasons, and intense pressure, we can persevere, overcome, and ultimately become the people He desires us to be.

Every challenge is shaping our character. Every trial is refining our faith. Every pressure point is preparing us for God's greater purpose.

So remember:

Pressure is not meant to break you—it is meant to build you.

A New Beginning for God's People – Ezra, Nehemiah & Esther

Bible Research: Joel Asir

These books cover the period between 538–430 BC, during the reign of the Persian Empire, following the Jewish exile in Babylon. Though Jerusalem had been destroyed and God's people scattered, the Lord remained faithful to His covenant and restored them in remarkable ways.

Ezra — Restoring Worship

The book of Ezra centers on the return of the Jewish exiles from Babylon to Jerusalem under the decree of King Cyrus. Led first by Zerubbabel and later by Ezra, the priest and scribe, the people rebuilt the Temple and renewed their commitment to God's Law.

Key Themes:

- Restoring true worship.
- Obedience to God's Word.
- Spiritual renewal.
- God's faithfulness in difficult circumstances.
- Ezra emphasizes that rebuilding the spiritual condition of God's people is even more important than rebuilding a city.

Nehemiah — Rebuilding the Walls

Before receiving permission to rebuild Jerusalem's broken walls, Nehemiah served as the cup-bearer to the Persian king. Despite opposition from enemies, discouragement, and constant threats, he led the people with prayer, wisdom, and unwavering determination.

Key Themes:

- Leadership and perseverance.
- Prayer and dependence on God.
- Unity among God's people.
- Rebuilding with a shared vision.
- The book demonstrates how God uses ordinary people with willing hearts to accomplish extraordinary things.

Esther — Passion for God's People in a Foreign Land

Unlike Ezra and Nehemiah, Esther's story unfolds in Persia rather than Jerusalem. An orphaned Jewish girl who became queen, Esther courageously risked her life to save her people from destruction during the reign of King Ahasuerus (Xerxes I). One fascinating feature of this book is that God's name is never explicitly mentioned, yet His divine guidance can be seen throughout every event.

Key Themes:

- God's unseen providence.
- Courage and faith.
- God's perfect timing.
- Deliverance of His people.
- Esther reminds believers that even when God seems silent, He is still at work behind the scenes.

Remember This

Together, Ezra, Nehemiah, and Esther reveal the mighty hand of God at work:

- Ezra rebuilt the Temple.
- Nehemiah rebuilt the Walls.
- Esther helped protect the People.

No matter how broken or chaotic circumstances may appear, these books beautifully demonstrate that God is able to restore worship, rebuild lives, and protect His people for His greater purpose.

When God steps in, ruins become restoration, fear becomes faith, and a scattered people become a testimony of His faithfulness.

Favor in Slavery

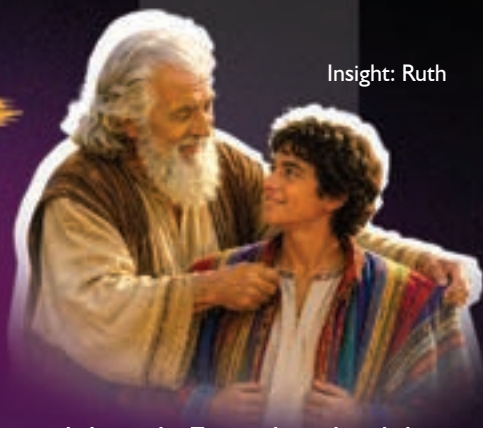

Favor Before Pharaoh

After wisely interpreting Pharaoh's dreams, Joseph was promoted to become the second-most powerful ruler in Egypt. A former slave and prisoner was elevated to govern a nation through the favor of God. (Genesis 41)



Daniel: A Man Who Found Favor

Favor with God

Daniel found grace and mercy before God. It was this divine favor that gave him extraordinary wisdom and understanding. (Daniel 1:9)

Favor in the Eyes of Ashpenaz

God caused Ashpenaz, the chief official of the king, to show favor toward Daniel. Because of this, Daniel was able to remain faithful to God without defiling himself with the king's food.

After interpreting the king's dreams, Daniel amazed Nebuchadnezzar with his wisdom. The king promoted him to positions of great authority and glorified the God of Israel.

Missionary Biography



John Vinson was born on 28th December 1880 in Winnsboro, into a devout Christian family. His father served as a church elder and also led a Mission Sunday School. From his early childhood, John was nurtured in an atmosphere of prayer, Bible reading, and active ministry.

Missionary Biography: Ruth

While studying in a nearby college, he was deeply impacted by witnessing students dedicating their lives as missionaries to countries like China and Africa. This experience planted a profound calling for God's service within his heart. After joining college, he became part of a student movement called "Let Us Evangelize the World," and fully surrendered his life to God's mission. Though he initially prepared to go to Africa, according to God's will he was later sent to China. On 4th February 1907, he arrived as a missionary in Sutsein, located in the North Kiangsue region of China. He learned the local language, culture, and lifestyle with great passion, and began his ministry despite many hardships.



He married Miss Jeanie deForest Junkin, a gentle-hearted American missionary who once said, "If all people in the world were like children, this world would become like heaven." They were blessed with six children, though only three survived into adulthood. Together, they traveled from village to village, planting churches and proclaiming the Gospel.

However, their life was far from easy. Both John and Jeanie faced severe health challenges. In 1923, Jeanie passed away after giving birth to a daughter. Even in the midst of losing his wife and children, John Vinson did not accuse God. Instead, he remained steadfast in faith.



Though weakness and loneliness surrounded him, his ministry in China never stopped. He traveled on foot, by boat, horse, and cart—preaching the Gospel in villages. He shared the Good News in small tents, mud houses, and under trees.

***His vision was simple yet powerful:

In 1931, while staying in a Christian church in Yangjiajie village in China, a group of around 600 bandits invaded the region and captured many people, including John Vinson. When government forces attempted to rescue him, he requested, “First release the Chinese prisoners.”



The bandit leader placed a gun to his head and asked, “Aren’t you afraid?”

John calmly replied, “No, I am not afraid.”

The leader asked again, “Even now, when I am about to kill you, are you not afraid?” This was not a fictional question but a real event that took place on 2nd November 1931 in North Kiangsu, China.

With unshakable peace, John Vinson answered, “No, I am not afraid. If you kill me, I will go straight to my God.”

Those words revealed his unbreakable faith and eternal hope. His testimony later became an inspiration across many nations. John Vinson was then shot, and his head was later severed.

Dear young readers, John Vinson’s death spoke even louder than his life. His journey stands as a living testimony of sacrifice, love, endurance, and unwavering faith. The Gospel he preached was not only in words but also through his life.

His steadfastness in God’s calling amidst suffering remains a powerful challenge and inspiration for this generation.

But let me tell you something important:

The world may judge based on appearance, but God never does.

Right now, it sounds like you've started seeing yourself through the lens of rejection. When

enough people say "No," we begin to believe something is wrong with us. But that's not the truth.

Let's Change the Narrative

Instead of asking: "Why am I not getting married?" Start asking: "Look how far God has already brought me!"

Think about it:

- You completed a Ph.D.
- You became a college professor.
- You're impacting students every day.
- You have dreams bigger than yourself.
- You want to help other women through education.



That's not failure. That's purpose.

What Does God Say About You?

Psalms 139:14 says: "I am fearfully and wonderfully made."

- ▶ God didn't accidentally create you.
- ▶ You are not a mistake.
- ▶ You are not less than others.

1.2 Billion People Worldwide Affected by Mental Health Disorders Cases Have Doubled Since 1990, Reveals Lancet Study!

A recent report published by the renowned British medical journal The Lancet has highlighted the alarming rise in mental health disorders across the globe. According to the study, approximately 1.2 billion people worldwide are currently living with some form of mental health condition—a figure that has doubled since 1990.

The findings indicate that mental health disorders are generally more prevalent among women. However, conditions such as Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), and certain personality disorders are reported more frequently among men.

Particularly concerning is the finding that mental health challenges reached their highest recorded levels in 2023, with ad-



olescents aged 15 to 19 years being among the most affected groups.

The report emphasizes that simply expanding medical services will not be sufficient to address the growing crisis. Researchers recommend a comprehensive approach that includes:

- Professional counselling and therapy
- Appropriate medication when needed
- Healthy nutrition
- Regular physical activity
- Adequate sleep
- Meaningful social connections and community engagement

These lifestyle factors, combined with proper clinical care, are considered essential for improving mental well-being.

Commenting on the findings, the study's lead author, Damian Santomauro, stated that he was genuinely shocked by the scale of the increase in mental health disorders worldwide. The research team analyzed 12 major categories of mental health conditions before publishing this comprehensive report.
