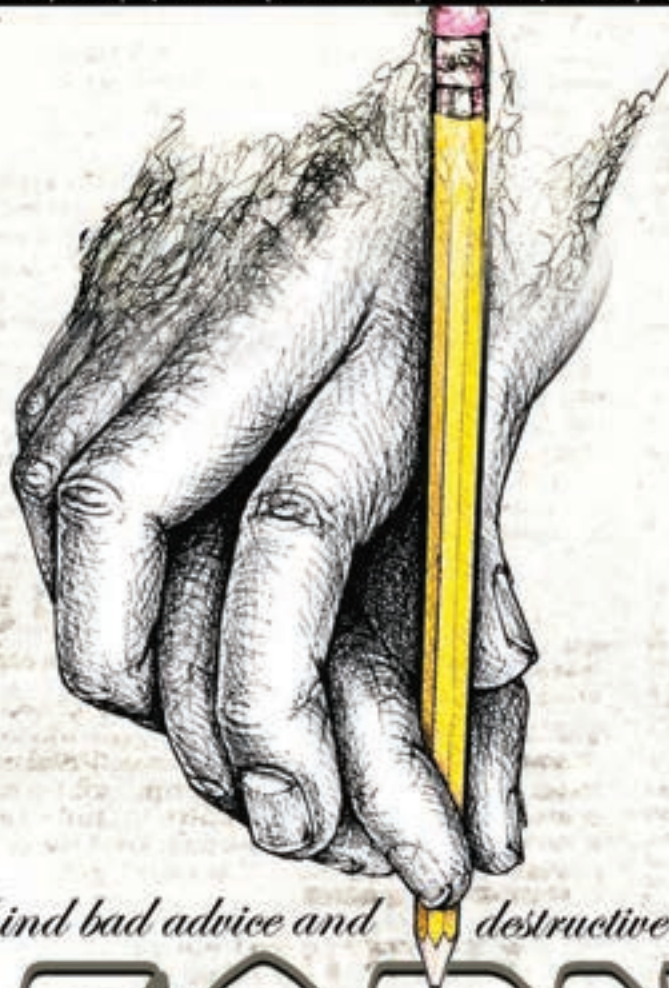

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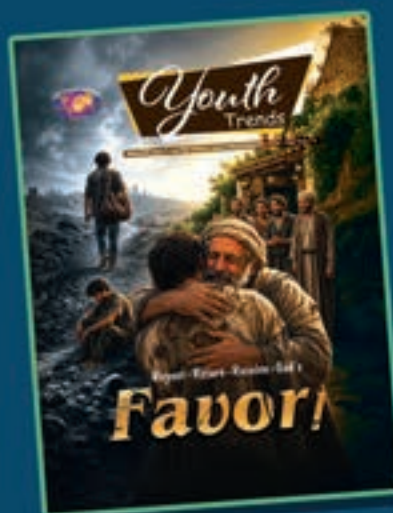

Testimony: Godwin

From the Brink of Death!!

Could you tell us about your family background and childhood?

My name is Dilani Monisha. I come from Pashar, a hill village in the Badulla District of Sri Lanka. Both of my parents are teachers, and I have a younger sister. I was raised in a Roman Catholic family. When I was eight years old, my parents separated, and my mother single-handedly raised and educated my sister and me. From my childhood, I had one dream—to become a Software Engineer in the IT industry. I pursued that dream with great passion, determination, and hard work.

You were doing well academically and had big dreams. What obstacle stood in your way?

In 2016, while I was studying in Grade 11, I began suffering from memory loss and a urinary tract infection. The following year, during Grade 12, I started experiencing severe pain on the right side of my abdomen, frequent vomiting, swelling in my legs, and extreme fatigue. The pain became unbearable, and my studies were severely affected. After conducting scans, the

doctors informed me that one of my kidneys had been underdeveloped since birth and was no longer functioning properly. They also discovered that it was significantly smaller than my other kidney.

How did you feel when you heard that? What happened next?

It felt as though all my dreams had collapsed before my eyes. The doctors explained that my healthy kidney had also begun to deteriorate. They warned that unless the damaged kidney was removed and I underwent a kidney transplant, my life would be in danger. To save my life, my mother sold all her jewellery and every bit of savings she had to pay for my





treatment. Later, she even took out bank loans so that my medical care could continue. At that time, I had no personal knowledge of the true God. Following our Roman Catholic traditions, we performed many religious rituals. We even travelled to India in search of healing, trying every possible remedy. But nothing brought any improvement. After another scan on June 8, 2018, the doctors instructed us to prepare immediately for a kidney transplant. But what no one knew was that I had already decided that June 7 would be the last day of my life. I had made up my mind to end my life by suicide.

Why did you decide to take your own life? What happened on the day you had planned?

On June 6, one of our relatives invited us to attend a meeting conducted by Bro. Mohan C. Lazarus in the Badulla region. Having grown up in a Roman Catholic background, I had no interest in knowing God personally. I attended the meeting only because my mother insisted. Even while sitting in the meeting, my mind was occupied with only one thought—I would end my life the very next day. During the prayer for the nation, I assumed that no one would pray for us, so I tried to leave. But because of the large crowd, I couldn't get out. At that very moment, Bro. Mohan C. Lazarus said, "A young woman is bound by a spirit of suicide. Come forward. Today is your day of deliverance. Your life is going to change today." The moment I heard those words, I

don't know how it happened, but the very next second I found myself standing in front of the stage. While he was praying, I suddenly felt as though my heart had burst open and blood was gushing out. Alarmed, I looked around, but nothing had actually happened. It was simply a powerful sensation. After the meeting, we returned home.

That is unbelievable. What was your state of mind after returning home?

That entire night, not once did I think about suicide. Instead, my heart was filled with a deep





peace and indescribable joy unlike anything I had ever experienced before. The next day, we went to the hospital for a CT scan. A few days later, the senior doctors carefully reviewed the reports and were astonished.

They informed us that there was no trace of the abnormal cells that had previously been found in my damaged kidney. Everything they had identified in the earlier scan had completely disappeared. To this day, the Lord has kept me in perfect health.

You say such an incredible miracle happened. But you didn't even believe in God then. How did you come to know that Jesus Christ is the true God?

Even today, I cannot fully explain how it happened. A few days after the miracle, questions began filling my heart. "Who is the true God? Why did I not know Him all these years? Why did He allow me to experience such suffering before granting me this healing?" At that time, Isaiah 41:10 came to my mind. I only had a Roman Catholic Bible with me. As I began reading it, the words, "Do not fear, for I am

with you..." echoed within me as though someone was speaking directly to my heart. Then I sensed the Lord speaking to me: "I created the heavens and the earth. How long do you think it would take Me to create this small organ of yours anew?" I asked, "Who are You?" Deep within my heart, I sensed the answer: "I am the Lord Jesus Christ."

The peace and joy that filled my heart at that very moment are beyond anything words can describe.

That's amazing! Even though you had no faith in God, Jesus revealed Himself to you. Did you accept Him after that?

Yes. Only after that encounter did I truly become aware of my sinfulness. I began confessing all my sins before the Lord and praying sincerely. It was then that I understood that forgiveness of sins is found only through Jesus Christ. From that moment onward, I developed a deep desire to know the ways of the Lord. Through the messages preached by Bro. Mohan C. Lazarus, I learned how to build a life of prayer.

Later, I purchased a Holy Bible and began reading it faithfully. In 2018, the Lord also filled me with the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

You received healing and were filled with the Holy Spirit. Did you immediately begin serving the Lord?



Not immediately. My mother, relatives, and many others insisted, "Even if you've been healed, you must remain in our church." To prevent me from attending other meetings, they gave me various responsibilities. As a result, I faced intense opposition and many struggles. During that season, I found the Bible that had once belonged to my grandfather, who had already experienced salvation. The notes and Scriptures he had written helped me know the Lord more deeply. It was then that an unshakable conviction settled in my heart that Jesus Christ alone is the true God. From that time onward, I began serving the Lord in every way I could. Because of this, I faced rejection and opposition from my own family. Yet, even if people rejected me, Jesus Christ accepted me as His own child.

In 2019, both my mother and my younger sister experienced salvation. After that, the Lord graciously used me in various ministries, enabling me to become a blessing to many through the revelations He gave me.

In 2020, the Lord called me to Bible college. After completing my DTH studies in 2021, I served in a ministry in Sri Lanka. Later, as the Lord led me, I joined a charitable organization where I am currently privileged to be a blessing to 1,854 children. The Lord has also given me the opportunity to travel like a missionary to regions where less than 1% of the population has heard the Gospel, sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with those who have never heard His name.



What message would you like to share through your testimony?

My life was once filled with dreams. But when sickness struck, I believed everything was over. The doctors' diagnosis, astrological predictions, and the words spoken by fortune tellers all convinced me that I would not live beyond the age of twenty. Those frightening words drove me to the point of suicide. But at the very place where people declared that my life had come to an end, the Lord Jesus Christ gave

me a brand-new beginning. Today, I am alive, healthy, and serving the Lord only because of His amazing grace.

If anyone reading this testimony feels that "everything is over," don't lose heart. The same Lord who transformed my life is able to transform yours. God's Word is greater than human opinions. It is greater than every medical report. When He speaks, the impossible becomes possible. What has been lost can be restored. Even a life standing on the brink of death can receive a brand-new beginning. So, never lose hope, no matter what you are facing. Trust wholeheartedly in the Lord Jesus Christ. He will never leave you nor forsake you. He is able to begin a new chapter in your life as well.

"Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand" (Isaiah 41:10).

Sadly, he rejected the wise counsel of the elders and chose to follow the advice of his youthful friends. He responded to the people with arrogance and harshness. As a result, the united kingdom of Israel was divided into **the ten tribes of Northern Israel and the two tribes of Judah in the south.**

Because Rehoboam listened to the wrong voices, Judah became weakened. Friends your own age may understand your emotions, but the wisdom of experienced people provides the guidance that keeps you from taking the wrong path. Therefore, instead of ignoring the correction and counsel of elders like Rehoboam did, true wisdom is found in accepting it with humility.

Every decision we make in life matters. That is why the guidance of experienced people is invaluable. When we listen to wise counsel, we can avoid many mistakes and unnecessary hardships.

“Discretion will protect you, and understanding will guard you.” (Proverbs 2:11)

Timothy wholeheartedly accepted the wise counsel and loving correction that Paul gave him during his younger years. As a result, he guarded himself against false teachings and youthful passions and became an outstanding example to other believers.

He lived according to Paul’s instruction: *“And the Lord’s servant must not be quarrelsome but must be kind to everyone, able to teach, and patient when wronged.” (2 Timothy 2:24)*



Because Timothy embraced Paul’s guidance during his youth, he later became a wise leader entrusted with shepherding the church. Naturally timid by temperament, Timothy faced many challenges and opposition when he was given the responsibility of leading the church in Ephesus.

Even now, I have chosen the science stream in college and continue to perform well academically. My family is not financially well-off. Because of this, my clothes are much simpler than those of my classmates. Most of my friends come from wealthy families. They usually arrive at college in cars, while I travel by bus wearing simple clothes. Unfortunately, because of my background, one of my lecturers constantly looks down on me and humiliates me in front of others. This has deeply hurt me and affected my ability to concentrate on my studies.

The lecturer who dislikes and isolates me has even failed me in the subject they teach. On one hand, I feel discouraged; on the other, I carry deep emotional pain. The situation has become so overwhelming that I have stopped going to college altogether.

I have two dreams in life: To transform our small hut into a proper two-storey house. To take my father and mother on an airplane journey at least once in their lifetime. But because of my lecturer's attitude, it feels as though all my dreams have been shattered. What should I do?

Dear Sister Subi,

From your letter, I can clearly sense the pain and emotional burden you are carrying. Sadly, the insensitive behaviour of a few teachers has emotionally wounded many talented students. Subi, I can understand the humiliation and rejection you are experiencing.

In dealing with this painful situation, you have two choices before you. One is to remain trapped in your pain. The other is to rise above it and move forward. Right now, you have two options.

Option - 1

You can allow your teacher's hurtful words to break your spirit, believing, "This education has brought me nothing but pain and humiliation," and decide to stay home.

Option - 2

You can choose to turn these temporary setbacks and painful words into stepping stones for your future. You can excel in your studies, fulfil your dream of building a better home for your family, and one day take your parents on the airplane trip you've always dreamed of.

If you choose Option 1...

Staying away from college may give you temporary peace of mind. It may even feel like you've escaped the problem. But education is one of the greatest investments in your future. If you neglect it now, it could leave a lasting impact on the rest of your life. Choosing to stay home simply to avoid humiliation may help you escape today's problem, but it will never become a permanent solution.

If You Choose Option 2...

If you ever get an opportunity, speak to your lecturer respectfully and calmly. Share your feelings with humility. There is a possibility that they may begin to understand your situation.

Also, focus even more on the very subject in which you were failed. When your hard work produces excellent results, it can gradually change your teacher's perception of you.

A teacher is meant to be like a ladder that helps us climb higher. Sometimes, sadly, that very ladder may seem to become an obstacle. But whether those obstacles become stumbling blocks or stepping stones is ultimately your choice.



If you work harder than your teacher expects and dedicate yourself to that subject, you can certainly achieve outstanding marks.

Remember, both of your dreams—building a better home and taking your parents on an airplane journey—depend greatly on your education. Seek help from trusted friends whenever necessary, and focus on changing the things that are within your control. Over time, even your teacher's attitude may change.

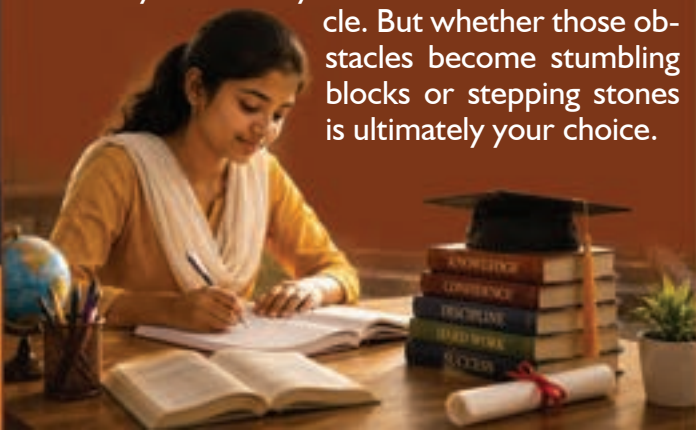

Ecclesiastes (The Book of Wisdom)

The Book of Ecclesiastes is traditionally attributed to King Solomon. However, the author introduces himself as "the Preacher" (Qoheleth).

Under Pressure



Hi Friends! How are you all doing? I'm delighted to meet you once again this month. I hope this series has been both meaningful and enriching for you.

This month, we're going to discover how a diamond is formed under immense pressure—and what that teaches us about our own lives. Let's dive in!

A diamond is a natural mineral made entirely of carbon atoms. It forms deep within the earth—approximately 150 to 200 kilometres below the surface—where it is subjected to extreme temperatures (900–1,300°C) and enormous pressure (45,000–60,000 times atmospheric pressure). Under these extraordinary conditions, the carbon atoms are transformed into an incredibly strong crystal structure, creating one of the hardest and most valuable substances on earth.

How Diamonds Are Mined

1. OPEN-PIT MINING

When diamonds are found close to the earth's surface, large machines and controlled explosives are used to remove the layers of rock above them, allowing the diamonds to be extracted.



2. UNDERGROUND MINING

When diamonds lie much deeper underground, tunnels are constructed so they can be safely mined from beneath the earth's surface.



3. ALLUVIAL MINING

Diamonds that have been carried by rivers and deposited in riverbeds or along coastlines are recovered through alluvial mining.



The Stages of Diamond Refining

1. CRUSHING

Large rocks containing diamonds are first crushed into smaller pieces using heavy machinery.

2. SCREENING

The crushed material is then passed through a series of screens to separate it according to size.

3. DENSITY SEPARATION AND X-RAY/LASER TECHNOLOGY

Because diamonds are denser than most surrounding rocks, they can be separated more easily. In addition, diamonds reflect light in a unique way, enabling sophisticated X-ray and laser technologies to identify them with remarkable precision.

4. CUTTING AND POLISHING

A diamond fresh from the mine does not sparkle. In fact, it often looks like an ordinary stone.

To reveal its true beauty, skilled craftsmen carefully cut the diamond using specialized saws coated with diamond particles. Every cut must be made with absolute precision because even a single mistake can significantly reduce the diamond's value.

Even after cutting, the diamond still does not display its full brilliance. It is then polished on a polishing wheel using diamond dust until it reflects light with breath-taking beauty.

5. GRADING

Finally, each diamond is graded based on its weight, cut quality, colour, and internal clarity.



"I have refined you, though not as silver; I have tested you in the furnace of affliction" (Isaiah 48:10)

Just like this verse reminds us, a diamond is not naturally brilliant or beautiful. It is the refining and polishing process that transforms it into something radiant and priceless. The deeper a diamond lies beneath the earth, the more specialized the mining process must be. In the same way, the way God refines us depends on the depth of our relationship with Him and the purpose for which He is shaping our lives.

A diamond can only be formed under intense heat and immense pressure. Likewise, the trials, hardships, disappointments, and losses we experience are often essential parts of God's process of shaping us into spiritual diamonds that reflect His glory. Just as the surrounding rock must be broken apart before a diamond can be brought to the surface, our sinful nature must also be broken before the character of Christ can truly be revealed in us. A diamond reflects its greatest brilliance only after it has been cut and polished. In the same way, if we are to reflect the light of Christ to the world, we may have to pass through painful trials and difficult seasons.

Forming a diamond takes time, intense heat, and tremendous pressure. Likewise, the work God is doing in our lives requires patience. His refining process cannot be rushed.

Whatever trial you are facing today is not the end of your story. God is carefully shaping and refining you into a precious spiritual diamond of eternal value!

RAILWAY ACCIDENTS

The increasing number of railway accidents has become a growing concern across India. Investigations revealed that these drugs were being distributed to **young people, college students, and daily wage workers**.

Let us pray that criminal networks involved in the illegal manufacture, distribution, and sale of addictive medicines will be completely dismantled.





SYNTHETIC DRUGS

The use of synthetic drugs such as **LSD, Methamphetamine, and Ketamine** is rapidly increasing among young people. These substances severely damage both physical and mental health while leading many into addictions. Although the government and various organizations are creating awareness to combat this issue, let us pray that the production, trafficking, and sale of synthetic drugs will be completely eradicated, and that young people will be delivered from every form of substance abuse.



NEET EXAMINATION

This year, **more than 2.2 million students** appeared for the **NEET examination**. Following the release of the results, many students are facing challenges related to medical college admissions, counselling procedures, securing seats in government and private colleges, educational expenses, and future career decisions.

Some students are also struggling with disappointment and emotional stress because they did not achieve their expected scores or rankings.

Let us pray that every NEET aspirant will receive proper guidance in choosing the right college and course, that they will face the future with peace and confidence, and that God will open the right doors for those who desire to serve through the medical profession, blessing their educational journey.

HEATWAVE

From **April to June this year**, severe heatwaves affected many regions across **North, Central, and Northwest India**. In several places, temperatures reached between **45°C and 48°C**. It is estimated that **more than 3,400 people are affected every day** in India due to heat-related causes. The extreme temperatures have also led to heatstroke, drinking water shortages, increased electricity demand, and reduced agricultural productivity.

Let us pray that the impact of the severe heatwave will subside, that sufficient rainfall will refresh the land, and that farmers and daily wage workers will be protected from its devastating effects.



SUICIDES

Reports indicate that **more than 170,000 people** die by suicide in India each year. Approximately **70–75%** of those who die by suicide are men. In addition, around **10,000 to 13,000 students** lose their lives annually due to factors such as stress, loneliness, family problems, academic pressure, and financial difficulties.

Let us pray that students, young people, and the general public will grow stronger in their mental and emotional well-being, that suicide rates across the nation will decline, and that God will fill people's hearts with hope and the desire to live.

SOUL DETOX

In these last days, one of the enemy's most subtle and powerful weapons used to draw young people away from God is **music**. Satan is the father of lies, and music has a tremendous influence on our lives. The lyrics we listen to, the visuals we watch, the ideas we absorb, and the messages we repeatedly hear have the power to gradually shape our thoughts, emotions, habits, and lifestyle.

Much of today's **secular music** promotes profanity, immoral values, negative thinking, violence, lust, pride, revenge, and lifestyles that contradict God's Word and celebrate what He detests. Continually exposing ourselves to such music can slowly weaken and damage our spiritual lives.



Furthermore, many modern concerts openly display **satanic imagery** and **Antichrist symbols**. The Impact of Unhealthy Music

- It normalizes profanity, vulgar language, and immoral speech.
- Impure and negative lyrics gradually influence the way we think, speak, and respond to life.
- It stirs emotions such as **anger, hatred, lust, and a desire for revenge**.
- Constant exposure to things that displease God can make them seem normal, causing worldly culture to become more important to us than God's truth.
- It slowly reshapes our identity and values.
- Many people who consume such music simply because it seems **"trendy"** or **"cool"** often struggle with anxiety, loneliness, fear, sleeplessness, spiritual battles, and even suicidal thoughts, leaving them without true peace.

How to Begin Your Detox

1. Pay Attention to the Lyrics

Before listening to any song, ask yourself: "Will this song purify my mind, or will it weaken my spiritual life?"

2. Remove the Negative and Fill Your Life with What Is Good

Detox is not simply about stopping unhealthy music. Unsubscribe the channel. Unfollow the artist. Delete your playlist. Then intentionally replace it with *songs of praise and worship that glorify God. (Even if someone writes beautiful songs or performs them exceptionally well, if their teachings contradict Scripture, their music should not automatically be considered music that glorifies God.)*

3. Hold Fast to What Is Good

Even when listening to Christians songs, evaluate the fruit of the artists and the doctrines they teach in the light of God's Word. Hold on only to what is biblically sound. "Test everything; hold fast what is good" (1 Thessalonians 5:21)

4. Give Priority to God's Voice

Fill your heart and mind with God's truth through Bible reading, prayer, and worship. As God's voice becomes louder in your life, the voices of the world will naturally grow weaker.

THE JUNGLE that met Jesus

In **1955**, a missionary challenge meeting was held at the renowned **Prairie Bible Institute** in Canada. During the gathering, a missionary passionately shared about the hundreds of tribal people living in **New Guinea, Indonesia**, who had never heard the Gospel of Jesus Christ. He spoke earnestly about the urgent need to take the Good News to them.

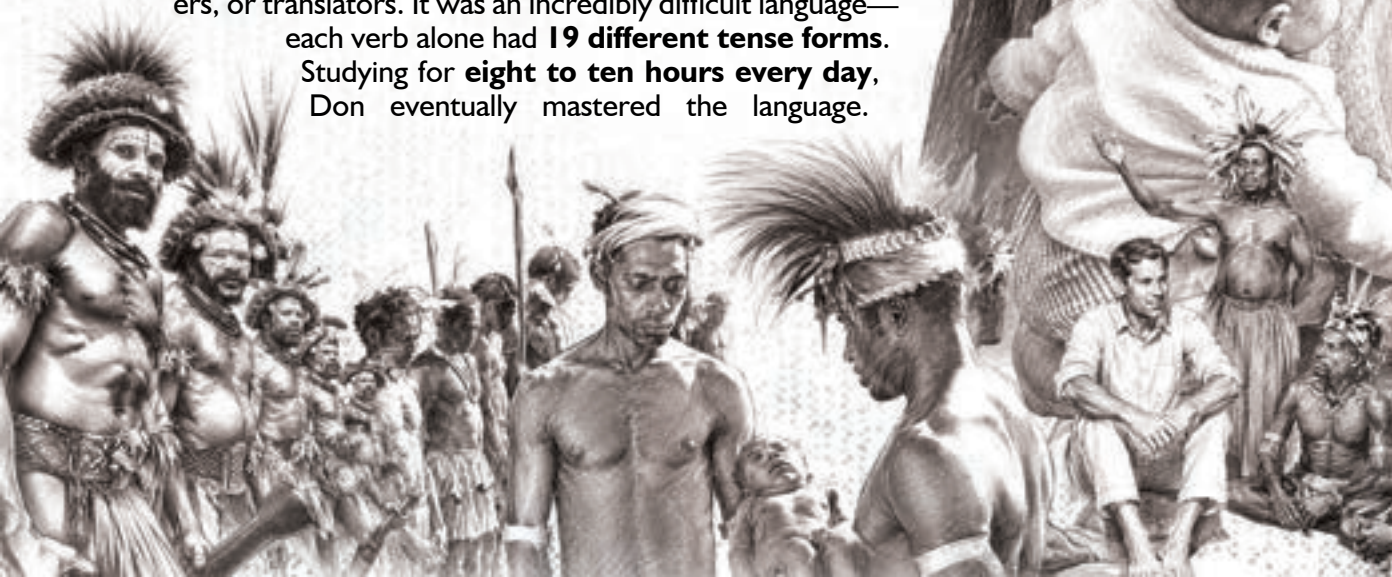
That message deeply touched the heart of a young man named **Don Richardson**. He clearly sensed God's call saying, **"I want you to go to those people."** Later, he married **Carol Richardson**, a young woman who had received the same missionary calling. In **1962**, Don and Carol, along with their young child, left for New Guinea to serve as missionaries among the **Sawi tribe**.

The Sawi people were known for their extremely violent customs. They considered **head-hunting, cannibalism, and betraying trusted friends before killing them** as acts of bravery. They lived in a dangerous environment surrounded by dense jungles, swamps, malaria, crocodiles, and poisonous insects.

Many people asked them, **"How are you going to survive in a place like that?"** But Don held firmly to one conviction: **if God had called him, God would surely protect him.**

One day, while Don was travelling by boat with his wife and their two young children, the boat suddenly capsized. They were thrown into deep waters infested with crocodiles and began to sink. At that terrifying moment, Don cried out, **"Lord, help us!"** By God's grace, he was able to rescue his wife and children alive. That day, he experienced once again that **God never abandons those whom He calls into His service.**

After settling among the Sawi people, the Richardsons began learning the **Sawi language** without the help of books, teachers, or translators. It was an incredibly difficult language—each verb alone had **19 different tense forms**. Studying for **eight to ten hours every day**, Don eventually mastered the language.





Through their tireless dedication, the Sawi language was given a written form, and later, the **New Testament** was translated into their language. After years of faithful labour, Don finally began sharing the love and salvation of Jesus Christ with the Sawi people. However, a major challenge arose. When he told them the story of **Judas Iscariot** betraying Jesus, the people exclaimed, **“Judas is the real hero!”** In their culture, **deceiving someone in order to defeat them was considered an admirable act of courage.**

Seeing this, Don was deeply discouraged. He cried out to God, **“Lord, how can I ever explain the Gospel to these people?”** Around that time, Don witnessed an extraordinary peace agreement between two rival Sawi villages. The chief of one village handed over his own little child to the chief of the opposing village. In return, the other chief entrusted his own child to them. As long as those children remained alive, neither village would wage war against the other. These children were known as **“Peace Children.”**

The moment Don witnessed this remarkable tradition, a new understanding flooded his heart. The next time he spoke to the Sawi people, he explained: **“To bring peace between God and humanity, God sent His one and only Son, Jesus Christ, into this world. He is God’s true Peace Child.”** Immediately, their eyes were opened. For the first time, they understood the true meaning of Jesus’ sacrifice. They also realized the seriousness of Judas’ betrayal. Within a short time, many people accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour. They turned away from their former lifestyle of witchcraft, violence, and cannibalism.

In **1972**, a large church named **“Peace House”** was built among them. The obedience of **one man** to God’s call transformed the history of an entire people group.

Even today, millions of people around us have never truly known Christ. Like Don Richardson, who courageously went to the Sawi tribe, are we willing to take the Gospel of peace to those who have never heard it?

502 Lives Lost Every Day: Over 180,000 People Died in Road Accidents in 2025

According to statistics presented by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways in the Lok Sabha, more than 180,000 people lost their lives in road accidents across India during 2025—an average of 502 deaths every single day.

Among all the states, Uttar Pradesh recorded the highest increase in fatalities, with the death toll rising from 24,118 in 2024 to 27,550 in 2025. In contrast, Punjab witnessed a significant decline, with road accident deaths dropping from 4,759 in 2024 to 3,062 in 2025.

The total number of road accidents in 2025 increased by 5.3% compared to the previous year, crossing 510,000 cases nationwide. Road accident fatalities also rose by 3.5%, highlighting the growing need for safer roads and responsible driving.

12.7 Lakh Cybercrime Complaints Registered in India Within Six Months

India continues to witness a sharp rise in various forms of cybercrime, including digital arrest scams, online banking fraud, hacking, social media scams, online financial fraud, and malware attacks.

Between January 1 and June 30, a staggering 1.271 million (12.71 lakh) cybercrime complaints were registered across the country.

Of these, 286,000 complaints were related to online banking and fund transfer fraud. Overall, cybercriminals are estimated to have cheated victims of approximately ₹10,178 crore during this six-month period.

In Tamil Nadu alone, 63,116 cybercrime complaints were reported, resulting in financial losses of nearly ₹897.79 crore.
